Americans eat close to sandwiches per year on average, so chances are you have a favorite of your own. Whatever sandwich happens to float your boat, the basic components are bound to be the same. So, who came up with this innovative way of serving food? Most of us have heard of the fourth Earl of Sandwich, otherwise known as John Montagu. In the book, a few lines were written that forever tied this food invention to the Earl of Sandwich: A minister of state passed four and twenty hours at a public gaming-table, so absorpt in play, that, during the whole time, he had no subsistence but a piece of beef, between two slices of toasted bread, which he eat without ever quitting the game. This new dish grew highly in vogue, during my residence in London; it was called by the name of the minister who invented it. While it is not clear if this anecdote is completely true, the book gained popularity and the story took hold. On November 24, , he wrote in his journal: That respectable body, of which I have the honour of being a member, affords every evening a sight truly English. Twenty or thirty, perhaps, of the first men in the kingdom, in point of fashion and fortune, supping at little tables covered with a napkin, in the middle of a coffee-room, upon a bit of cold meat, or a sandwich, and drinking a glass of punch. During the time this journal entry was written, Gibbon was First Lord of the Admiralty. Though the Earl of Sandwich or, perhaps, his cook deserves credit for helping sandwiches gain a name and popularity, variations of the concept have been around for centuries. Farm laborers in rural France had been eating meat between sliced bread long before it had a name, though the sandwich likely started even earlier than that. Hillel the Elder, a Jewish leader and rabbi who lived in Jerusalem during the time of King Herod circa BC , first suggested eating bitter herbs inside unleavened matzo bread. The herbs symbolized the bitterness of slavery, and the bread resembled the flatbreads made in haste by the ancient Israelites as they fled Egypt. Sandwiches first appeared in American cookbooks in The fillings were no longer limited to cold meat, as recipes called for a variety of things, including cheese, fruit, shellfish, nuts and mushrooms. The years following the Civil War saw an increase in sandwich consumption, and they could be found anywhere from high-class luncheons to the taverns of the working class. Mothers could easily assemble a sandwich without the need to slice their bread, and children could safely make their own lunches without the use of a knife. The portability and ease of sandwiches caught on with families, and the sandwich became a lunchroom staple. Sandwiches are now popular all over the world, and it seems like every region has their own take on the concept. In Cuba, restaurants serve ham and cheese on Cuban bread. In the Middle East, falafel or shawarma in a pita pocket is the fast food of choice. In Italy, simple and rustic panino sandwiches are the norm. In New York, pastrami on rye is king, though the Reuben takes a close second. Sandwiches come in endless varieties, making them one of the most popular foods worldwide. So come on, fess up! There are several effective explicit intentional, planned instruction and implicit spontaneous instruction as a child comes to new words in a text strategies that adults can employ with readers of any age. Explicit Vocabulary Instruction Pre-teaching Vocabulary Words One of the most effective methods of helping children learn new vocabulary words is to teach unfamiliar words used in a text prior to the reading experience. Adults either alone or with the child ren should preview reading materials to determine which words are unfamiliar. Then these words should be defined and discussed. It is important for the adult to not only tell the child ren what the word means, but also to discuss its meaning. Also, discussion provides the adult with feedback about how well the child ren understands the word. After pre-teaching vocabulary words, the child ren should read the text. Repeated Exposure to Words It may seem common sense that the more times we are exposed to a word, the stronger our understanding becomes. However, repeated exposure to new vocabulary words is often ignored. Adults often forget a person especially a child needs to hear and use a word several times before it truly becomes a part of her vocabulary. Providing multiple opportunities to use a new word in its written and spoken form helps children solidify their understanding of it. Keyword Method Like pre-teaching, the keyword method occurs before a child reads a particular text. In this method, unfamiliar words are introduced prior to reading. Like the other explicit instructional methods, the adult either alone or with the child ren should preview reading materials to determine which words are unfamiliar. For each of these new vocabulary words the child with the support of the adult creates a graphic organizer for the word. At the top or center of the organizer is the vocabulary word. Branching off of the word are three categories: Using prior knowledge the child fills in each of these three categories. Word maps help readers develop complete understandings of words. This strategy is best used with children in grades Root Analysis While root analysis is taught explicitly, the ultimate goal is for readers to use this strategy independently. Many of the words in the English language are derived from Latin or Greek roots. Adults should focus on teaching children the most commonly occurring roots, prefixes and suffixes. As each is taught examples of its use in common word should be shared and examined. Children should then be given practice analyzing words to determine their roots and definitions. When a reader is able to break down unfamiliar words into their prefixes, suffixes and roots they can begin to determine their meanings. Restructuring Reading Materials This strategy is particularly effective for helping struggling readers improve their vocabularies. Sometimes grade level materials are inaccessible to readers because there are too many unfamiliar words in them. Adults can restructure the materials in several different ways to help readers comprehend them more easily. An accompanying vocabulary guide can be provided for the text. Words that are included in the guide should be highlighted or printed in bold text to direct the reader to check the vocabulary guide if the word or its meaning is unfamiliar. Implicit Vocabulary Instruction Incidental Learning Incidental vocabulary learning occurs all of the time when we read. Based on the way a word is used in a text we are able to determine its meaning. While you may not know what a specific word means, many times you can determine its meaning based on what the rest of the sentence focuses on. Adults should model this sort of incidental vocabulary learning for children to help them develop their own skills. Context Skills Context skills are the strategies that a reader uses for incidental vocabulary learning. Other words in a sentence or paragraph, captions, illustrations and titles provide readers with information about the text that they can use to determine the meanings of unfamiliar words. Young readers should be taught to find and use context clues for learning new vocabulary words. Adult modeling and practice are key for helping children develop this important reading skill.

Lightly toasted sandwich bread is layered with thick sliced garden-ripe tomatoes, fresh lettuce leaves and crisp bacon. Step by step instructions for how to make the best BLT sandwich on the planet! Bring on the fresh garden tomatoes. And bring on the fabulous BLT. I recently realized just how important the humble BLT is to me. We dropped by a great pancake joint and I ordered a BLT. When I veered from the signature menu item, all my troubles began. The bread was thin and dry. The mayo was nearly non-existent, and on one slice of the bread only. The single sliver of grocery store tomato was barely pink and so thin it was nearly translucent. The lettuce if you call it that was limp and wilted. There was just one slice of bacon in the whole sandwich. In my book anyway. Everyone should know how to make a great BLT. Hope you adore this sandwich as much as I do!!! Garden fresh tomatoes are the bomb! Ours started ripening up in our NH garden last week. Around here, that signals many scrumptious BLT sandwiches to come all the way through October. You must have excellent tomatoes for an excellent BLT. Thickly sliced, fresh garden tomatoes are crucial to a great BLT sandwich. Use your favorite kind of lettuce: Romaine, butter lettuce, curly green leaf and red leaf lettuce are all excellent choices. Leaves should be clean, dry, and fresh. Not limp or wilted. A sharp slicing knife to slice the tomato. I always sharpen my butcher knife before slicing tomatoes. That way I get nice, clean slices and can easily control the thickness. A sharp, serrated bread knife cuts through a BLT sandwich cleanly, without smushing it. Many people like white bread for their BLTs because it toasts so nicely. Sour dough bread is also a great choice. I used honey wheat store bought sandwich bread for this BLT. Make sure your bread is lightly toasted, but is cooled completely before spreading on the mayo. Now is not the time or place to be skimpy with the mayo! Cooling the toasted bread before spreading the mayo keeps the mayo from melting, and helps your sandwich bread stay crisp. A BLT should not have limp, floppy sandwich bread. For a fun twist, try a flavored mayo like this fresh Basil Pesto Mayonnaise. You can also fry your bacon in a skillet. Microwaving the bacon according to package instructions is also an option, but not quite as good. When I cook bacon in the microwave it tends to be dry and more unevenly cooked. However you cook it, be sure to drain your bacon well on paper towels before adding it to your BLT sandwich. How you layer your BLT is very important. Lettuce that is clean and dry goes on top of the bread. THEN the garden tomato slices. Putting the tomato slices in the between the lettuce and bacon keeps the toasted sandwich bread from getting soggy. Generously salt and pepper the tomato slices. Next, add your crisp bacon slices on top. Oh yes, this BLT sandwich is almost ready!!! My mouth is watering. Add the second slice of bread on top and carefully cut in half with a serrated bread knife or electric knife. Enjoy every delicious bite!

The South Sandwich Islands are a group of volcanic islands in the southern ocean. The most northerly island, Zavodovski, is km southeast of South Georgia. The most southerly, Thule sometimes called Morrell , is km further south, and km north of Antarctica. Lighter material then rises up through the overlying South Sandwich Plate, where it is extruded at the surface, forming basalt volcanoes. The South Sandwich Plate. There are a number of previously recorded volcanoes in the South Sandwich Islands. Protector Shoal is a submarine volcano 56 km northwest of Zavodovski Island; its highest point is 27 m bellow sea level in an area where the sea floor is an average of m deep. Protector Shoal last erupted in Mount Curry is on Zavodovski Island and rises m above sea level. Its last recorded eruption was in about , but it has probably erupted since then - due to its remote location it has not been monitored closely due to its remote location the eruption was only detected by new lava flows , it is suspected that there were eruptions in , and With modern seismic monitoring and satellite technology any future eruptions are likely to be recorded. Leskov island is 51 km to the southeast of Zavodovski Island, and the easternmost of the South Sandwich Islands. It reaches m above sea level, and has a semicircular shape, being part of the rim of a collapsed volcanic caldera. The island is made up of andersitic lava, rather than basaltic as is found on the majority of the islands. Plumes were seen above the volcano in and Candlemas Island is 43 km southeast of Visokoi Island, and is the cone of another submerged volcano. It has not been seen erupting since its discovery in , though there were reports of steam issuing from the summit in and , and some of the lava flows on the north flank may have formed within the last couple of hundred years. Its highest point is m above sea-level. It rises m above sea-level and has a m wide caldera. It has been more-or-less constantly active since , when satellite images became available, and has probably been erupting since some time in the s. Mount Belinda is a shield volcano a volcano made from successive lava flows, giving it a lower profile than the more cone-shaped stratovolcanoes, which are formed from a combination of lava and ash deposits which reaches m above sea-level, and has a caldera 6 km in diameter. On the southeastern point of Montagu Island lies Mount Oceanite, an ice covered extinct volcano, reaching m above sea-level. Smoke was seen issuing from Bellingshausen in , and , and an explosive crater was formed on the island some time between and It stands m above sea level and has a lake in its crater which is kept from freezing by geothermal heat. Steam was seen coming from the crater in , and fresh ash reported on the flank of the volcano. It is thought that Cook Island was once part of the same island as Thule, and there may be a submerged crater between the two. Some of the new volcanoes have been described as similar in size to Mount Fuji in Japan, rising from a sea-floor m deep to within 70 m of the surface. Undersea volcanoes around Saunders Island.
