No one is immune from them and when they hit they are unexpected, they are scary and they point to a God greater than ourselves. Our God is with us in the midst of our storms. The timing of our study in the Book of Job could not have been more perfect for me. This is the book of the Bible I need right now! This alone shows me how intimately involved our Lord is in our lives. His tender care "to lead me through Job" reminds me of Psalm If you are in the midst of a storm today "reflect on Psalm 23 with me. Psalm 23 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He leads me beside still waters. Perhaps you are exhausted with unanswered prayers and you are scared, lonely, heartbroken, or depressed. What ever you are facing today! Remember this: The Lord is our good shepherd and He never leaves our side. He walks with us through the valleys. He restores our soul when we are weary. He leads us to the path of righteousness when we have lost our way. He gives us courage when we are scared and he comforts us when we are hurting. Our God is the God of the storm. He is mighty and powerful and the enemy trembles at His name. There is no one like our God. God is clothed with awesome majesty. Our God is mighty "He can be trusted! He sees and knows all the details of your private storms. He will take care of you. He loves you so. How has God taken care of you in the midst of your storm?

The following is a copy of one of my first sermons I did while filling various pulpits around my area. I believe these words speak very clearly about where my life is today. We all go through various storms in our lives. All the psalms are in my opinion. Going through life's facing challenges. Then, we turn our fears around, we remember what God has done for us in the past, and we offer praise to God knowing that He is with us always and will give us guidance to any hardship we would face. The seventy-seventh psalm shows us how Asaph does exactly that. He is laying on his bed. Cry out to God pleading. We experience something overwhelming in our lives and it shakes the very foundation of our faith. We start with our memories!! He begins recalling what God had done previously within his life within his world and how things were then. Then my nights were filled with joyous songs. I search my soul and meditate upon the difference now. What is different now?? Why do I feel so alone?? God is with him and we will soon see how Asaph realizes that. How is your memory?? What kind of blessings can you recall that have been received in the past few weeks. Are we like Asaph and any former blessings seem so far back in the past that they do not have any bearing on our troubles today. Why did he give me so much then only to abandon me now?? When we take time to stop. We are blessed each day in some form or another. Think about it for a minute start the habit of remembering blessings every day; keep a journal of your daily life it will amaze you to look back through it in the months ahead. Too often we forget and need to refresh our brains a little to recall just how fortunate we really are. While at the coffee shop or even when eating dinner with your family. This helps you to think of other blessings and others and others. When you retire for the night while lying in bed waiting for sleep to come start your mind working at recalling blessings you have received that day. This will prevent the agony of restless nights and run-away thoughts. Try it it works much better and is better for you, than any sleeping medication on the market. You can say you saw it here first. Verse So, now what do we do? We still feel that God has turned His back on us to a point and we start asking questions difficult questions that we may be a little fearful of asking! Asaph cried out into the night with questions: Will he never again be favorable? Is His loving kindness gone forever? Has His promise failed? Has He forgotten to be kind to one so undeserving? Has he slammed the door in anger on His love? But, how many times have we asked questions like this in our own periods of trial and tribulation?? After a deadly storm or a violent crime we often ask questions. This is okay there is nothing wrong with asking questions as long as we wait. God is with us always in war times, in struggles, in heartache and sorrow, in natural disasters, in fears, in hardships God is there waiting for us to ask. God will not go where He is not wanted. He is always ready to forgive and help us start a new pathway through life all we have to do is pose our questions. Verse So, how do we get into the mind-set of re-building our faith in God?? Asaph begins thinking and remembering in verse Those wonderful deeds are constantly in my thoughts. The mind is a wondrous, powerful, but mysterious, piece of machinery. Our faith and beliefs are the same way. God does not love us any longer. We must re-direct our thoughts to bring forth the memories of all those blessings of which our mind is trying to convince us to forget. We must not let our foundation of faith crack and crumble as it has surely started doing. We can not carry our burdens alone. Have you ever had the P. It comes on when you feel that God is ignoring you. The cure for that?? Just look around awhile there are many folks who are suffering horribly around us every day. Give thanks to God that you are where you are at today!! But that is exactly what we must do. All we have to do is ask!! Verse How do we praise God when the world is in total turmoil around us??? Why say grace at a meal you may not like?? A prayer that I grew up with. That is how we offer praise to God. In verse; Asaph cries out in triumph: Where is there any other as mighty as you? You are the God of miracles and wonders! You still demonstrate your awesome power!! We must offer

our praise and make Him make GOD.. We can get through anything. He is our keeper our giver of hope our salvation. I have a wonderful, old dog. Tuffy is her name. She knows when I am having heart problems she knows when I have over extended myself outdoors she knows when I am happy or sad she knows me period!!! However, she is scared to death of thunder and lightning and you know we have had plenty of that lately!! When a thunderstorm is within ten or fifteen miles of my home I know it. Although this dog is always loving and always at my side. I can not move without this dog moving with me she looks at me and you can see the fear of the storm in her eyes. That is what we must do, friends. Even though we cry out in fear even though the storms of life may frighten us even though we tremble. No matter what we face. God is with us. Verse I leave you with the lyrics from a song in the musical Carousel, by Rogers and Hammerstein. It speaks of keeping faith through the storms of life. I remember my older siblings singing it and I sang it as well in high school. But this bit of music is a wonderful example of reminding us that there is hope.
