Whenever a task comes up that I need to make sure gets done, I simply enter it into Omnifocus and schedule it. Holding myself accountable This is a big one for me. It can be hard for me to stay focused on what I really intend to do, and accountability helps with that a lot. Without accountability, fear, uncertainty and procrastination can get in the way. There are two ways I hold myself accountable: Both help me stay focused and more importantly, follow through on what I intend to do. Community means everything to me. Clearly defined tasks I need to know what needs to be done, right now. The clearer the path is, the easier it is to get moving. I find this to be true for myself. Whatever it is, I define it and then get started. Firewalling Every now and then I need to take drastic measures to ensure that I stay focused. Sometimes the battle for my attention is too much, and I need to admit my own weakness. When that happens two things help me: Usually a coffee shop or even moving to another room in the house does the trick. I use an App called Focus that allows me to block social media websites and other distractions for a set period of time. It helps limit my number of choices so I can buckle down and do the work. Think About Why You should have a really good reason. Otherwise, pause, take a break and figure it out. But you need to quit the right things – not everything. If you quit everything, you either need to get better at choosing what to start or learn to adapt and persevere more. If you quit something, do it because you need to focus on something else or do something better. When that happens, I start counting trees. How it works is that while running, you pick out a tree 50 yards in front of you. You tell yourself to keep going until that tree. As soon as you hit that next tree, pick another tree out and keep going. Forget About It You got rejected, turned down or met some other minor setback? Literally just forget about it. Move on to something else instead and put that out of your mind. In my mind sometimes, I think things were really, really easy, because looking back on things I tend to forget all the hard parts. But there were a ton of times along the way that things were difficult, but I just put them out of my head. So I quit, packed up my laptop ran to my room, cried for a few months and never wrote another thing again, right? Well, actually I just made my own site and started writing. I still get rejected all the time, but I just keep going. Reframe Your Story Reframing your story is one of the most powerful things you can do. Your current circumstances are not final outcomes. Your circumstances define the conflict, but not the final result. The harder the struggle, the greater the story. The more triumphant it is in the end when you overcome the conflict you find yourself immersed in. Keep Your Head Up. Keeping your head up allows you to see the simple solution to the problem that you used to think was ridiculously complex. To be able to change your life, try something impossible and actually do it. This is so effective, and so simple, but hardly anyone does it. If you get punched in the face. If you go bankrupt. Suck it back up and keep going. If you get laughed at, mocked or pushed down. Just get back up. Get back at it and keep going. Fall down seven times. Did I miss anything?
