Because many of the solutions are OS-dependent, most iPad printing solutions are similar to, and in many cases identical to, the solutions for printing from iPhones. All iPad models support AirPrint. The utility has a limited selection of print options, letting you choose the number of copies, plus a few other details. The good news is that most recent wireless printers support AirPrint. When you open a document in an AirPrint-compatible program, you can access the Share button through an icon usually a forward arrow at the top or bottom of the screen. It should reveal a print option as well as social media sharing options. Press Print, and the Printer Options screen should appear. These programs function as print servers and can be installed on a computer on your network. With Printopia, for instance, you need to install the software on a Mac. Printing Apps Nearly all of the major printer manufacturers now offer apps that let you print from your iPad or other iOS device to their brand of printers that support Wi-Fi connectivity. These apps tend to offer a much wider range of features and printing options than AirPrint does. The iPhone and printer must be on the same Wi-Fi network; if the printer is compatible, the app should readily detect it. These apps generally let you print a variety of document types, and in many cases they have their own browser with limited features for loading and printing web pages. Some of these apps are rather bare-bones, while others, such as Samsung Mobile Print and Epson iPrint, let you initiate scans from your iPad, and offer a variety of printing functions. Many of these apps integrate with various cloud services to allow printing from them, as well. Third-party app makers have also gotten in on the fun. Thinxstream Technologies, for instance, offers the PrintJinni app, which lets you print from an iPad to compatible printers from a number of manufacturers. Another is that you can print to it from multiple platforms: Email Printing Three of the major printer makers offer a nifty printing solution: When you sign up for one of these services, your printer is assigned a unique email address. When you email a document to that address from your iPad or any other device, from anywhere in the world, the printer will automatically print them out. Strength in Numbers As iPads have proliferated, so have the methods available to print from them. Which of these is the best solution depends on your needs. AirPrint offers quick, easy Wi-Fi printing, but not all printers are compatible with it. Printing apps generally offer more features than the other methods, but they are supported only by specific branded printers. Email printing is a great method, but only select printers support it. Cloud printing services are best suited to offices, or to people who use the productivity apps they tend to support. In most cases, if need be, you can combine several of these methods to increase your ability to print to multiple printers, and to print different document types. Disconnect the USB or Ethernet cable. When an Ethernet cable is connected to the printer, the printer cannot connect wirelessly. Connect the printer to the network: Printers with control panel displays: On the printer, select the Setup, Network, or Wireless menu, select Wireless Setup Wizard, and then follow the on-screen instructions. Printers without control panel displays: Press and hold the Wireless button for three seconds until the wireless light blinks. Press the WPS button on your router, and then wait while the printer connects to the network. If you are still not connected, continue to the next section to print with Wi-Fi Direct or HP wireless direct. Under the Choose a network menu, select your printer. If prompted, type a password. The default password is Turn the printer on or press the power button to wake it from sleep mode. Open the document, photo, email, or webpage you want to print, and then tap the Share icon or Tap Print or the Print icon. On the Printer Options menu, tap Select Printer, and then select your printer from the list. FAQ for more information. Tap Options to change other settings. Some options, such as paper size, might not be adjustable and must be changed from the printer. The Options menu might not display if your printer is black ink only. Select the number of copies to print, and then tap Print. To resolve the issue, restart the printer and iOS device, and then make sure they are connected to the same network. Turn on your Apple iOS device. Tap the Settings icon. Make sure Wi-Fi is turned on and there is a checkmark next to your wireless network name. Return to the Settings menu, and then make sure Bluetooth is turned off. If the issue persists, continue to the next step. Update the printer firmware Go to Updating or Upgrading Printer Firmware to download and install the latest printer firmware. Find the printer IP address on the Network Configuration page. Type the printer IP address in the browser address bar, and then tap Go. If a website security certificate displays in the Internet browser, tap Continue. The EWS information page for the printer opens. Tap the Settings tab. Tap Security, and then tap Administrator Settings. Since Bonjour is the default method for discovering printers on a network, make sure your wireless router supports Bonjour, and then turn the Apple device off and on. Check the specifications or support documentation for your router or contact the router manufacturer to make sure your router supports Bonjour. It must also support forwarding

Bonjour packets. If your router supports Bonjour, skip to the next step. If your router does not support Bonjour, add the printer to your printer list using the IP tab and the printer IP address. Try to print from another device or computer. Try to print from another networked device to the HP printer. Examples of networked devices include your computer and another Apple device. If the printer is found, continue to the next step. If the printer is not found, go to Wireless Troubleshooting. Reset the HP printer. Reset the printer, and then try to print again. Turn the printer on, if it is not already on. Wait until the printer is idle and silent before you continue. With the printer turned on, disconnect the power cord from the rear of the printer. Unplug the power cord from the wall outlet. Wait at least 60 seconds. Plug the power cord back into the wall outlet. HP recommends connecting the printer power cord directly to the wall outlet. Reconnect the power cord to the rear of the printer. Turn on the printer, if it does not automatically turn on. Wait until the printer is idle and silent before you proceed. How do I change the paper size? AirPrint does not have the option to change the paper size. If your printer has a paper sensor, AirPrint automatically adjusts the print size to the detected paper. If your printer has a control panel with the option to change paper sizes, you can change the paper size and the iOS device detects the new size. The printout is then scaled accordingly. If the paper size selected and the paper size loaded are not the same, an error might display on both the printer and device, asking for confirmation that the correct paper is loaded. What other mobile printing solutions can I use with my Apple iOS device? What if I experience problems when I try to use AirPrint? If you are unable to print to a local HP printer with AirPrint, follow these troubleshooting tips: Turn the printer off, and then on. Make sure the printer is connected to the same wireless network subnet as your iOS device. Make sure the printer has the latest firmware version installed. Make sure the printer has paper in the tray, and that ink or toner is not empty. Make sure there are no error messages on the printer control panel. Wi-Fi printers can take several minutes to join a Wi-Fi network after they turn on. Make sure your printer is connected to the Wi-Fi network before you print. AirPrint works over your private wireless network to print directly from supported apps on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch running iOS 4. It requires no additional software or print driver downloads. How do I select or change print options? AirPrint allows you to print web pages, documents, emails, photos, and content from apps that support AirPrint. Print options vary depending on the print app that you use to print with the HP printer.
