A few years ago, someone suggested, "Wake up, pray, read, listen, and then write. Worshiping, and having dinner in Waldorf with my daughter and friends from Germany had been so lovely. When I got home I was a little tired, but in a good mood. I went inside, grabbed the and some paper towels, and went back to the stairwell to clean it up. When I finished, I decided to just shower and turn in early--but not before I checked my e-mail. With emotion usually reserved for a close family member, I shared, "Walter Hawkins died. My mind went back to an April evening. There were a few people seated in the darkened Kennedy Center concert hall as we went on stage to rehearse. I was a terrified 15 year old who had only joined the youth choir because my mother insisted I find something to do at church. I had no aspirations to sing alone or professionally, but in my heart, I wanted so badly to sing like Tramaine--even if only in the shower. I had never heard a voice so lovely and powerful. That day back in I was going to get my chance to sing the words she sang, but it was not my idea. Since , and thanks to Richard Smallwood my chance to actually meet and sing with the Hawkins family was realized. Bishop Hawkins was always gracious and kind. Thirty-five years later, I found myself standing on stage with some of the finest soloists and musicians in the area. Someone decided that the music of Walter Hawkins deserved to be honored at one of the most prestigious musical venues in the world. Someone decided that his songbook was a vital part of the fabric of American music. Someone thought it should be showcased in a place where excellence is the standard, and mediocrity has no seat. Unlike the first time, I had a sober grasp of pain, heartache, grace, and the priceless basis of my faith. As we faced the nearly empty seats of the concert hall, a man waved. I waved back, not knowing who he was. We rehearsed the medley a few times, and I was suddenly transported back to the choir stand of Bethlehem Baptist Church. After we were done, we went to greet the man who waved at us. It was Bishop Hawkins. He took both of my hands and smiled at me. As I hugged him I realized how fragile he was. His eyes sparkled, and he smiled. I felt like a little kid. I was just so overwhelmed to see him, and blown away when he told me I had done well. Just the opportunity to speak with him and hear his words of affirmation made me cry. His dignity and strength was positively breathtaking. Last night I watched youtube videos of vintage performances. I talked to friends who were feeling the loss, but celebrating the incredible gift to world music that is the Hawkins Family. I smiled, cried, shook my head, and heaved heavy sighs until I fell asleep. I talked to my big sister who is probably the only person I know who loves the music more than I do. I wish it had been a hoax. The sobering truth is that years ago, as we clapped, rocked and hummed along, Bishop Hawkins sang of a day in June fearlessly and with authority. Each song brought back so many delightful memories. The broadcast soundly arrested my morning. The earlier songs reminded me of the day my Dad came down to the basement to investigate what we were listening to. We must have had the volume up too loudly, and appeared to be having way too much fun to be listening to the usual Mahalia Jackson or Sister Rosetta Tharpe albums that for years served as Sunday fare. I listened to each track, keenly aware that I knew every lyric and ad lib. I adore good music. There just ought to be some sign of God and his word that oozes from the lyrics and instrumentation. At a time when the preoccupation seems to be more with charts, numbers, fame and awards, than encouraging souls, it is more than a relief to be able to listen to music that, at its core, is the redemptive message of Jesus Christ. My thoughts, as I listened, only confirmed what I already knew. Walter Hawkins was one of the most articulate and compelling singers ever. His were crisp and convincing vocals, fortified by the Word of God. His are songs of incredible substance and power, replete with excellent musicianship, passion, brilliance, hope, joy and glorious harmonies. Good music never grows old. Some master the making of noise and trite lyrics that fall flat, and move a listener to do little more than yawn. Others inspire priceless memories and stir the heart. Listening to the music of Walter Hawkins so adequately answers the question, and in my opinion agrees: Competence and excellence ought to be the standard. Sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ ought to be the motivation. I opened the window to smell the clean air. The sounds that nature makes are glorious. The sounds that we make, and attribute to our relationships with God should be no less. Thank you, Hawkins

With so many Democrats expressing interest in taking on Trump, CBS has compiled a list of potential candidates and where they are staking their claim in what figures to be the most crowded field yet. The record year was , when 17 major candidates vied for the GOP nomination. Elizabeth Warren, Texas Rep. Kamala Harris The first-term senator has seized her perch on the Judiciary Committee as a national platform, most notably during the confirmation hearings for Supreme Court Justice Brett Kavanaugh when she asked, "Can you think of any laws that give the government the power to make decisions about the male body? Cory Booker A former mayor of Newark, Booker is known for his social media savvy and attention-getting performances – most notably, his "I am Spartacus" moment at the Kavanaugh hearings. Booker has already been testing the waters in Iowa, and told reporters there recently that he wants to "be a voice in this country for love. Elizabeth Warren Known as a progressive darling, Warren has built the most extensive political network yet, reaching all 50 states. The senator has also shown, for better or for worse, a knack for going toe-to-toe with President Trump, releasing the results of a DNA test on any Native American ancestry and using Twitter to fire back at the president. Amy Klobuchar Klobuchar was overwhelmingly re-elected to a third term in November in a state Donald Trump came close to winning in , and is a frequent guest at various state party gathers, including in early states. She was a prominent figure during the Kavanaugh hearing as one of the few women of the Senate Judiciary Committee, and earned acclaim within the party for her back and forth with the judge. Klobuchar is known for her "Minnesota nice" personality, but cut her chops as a Hennepin County prosecutor and has degrees from Yale and the University of Chicago. Jeff Merkley Perhaps among the lesser known of this group, Merkley garnered national attention for being among the first politicians to visit a detention center at the southern border. A liberal who can win in Trump country. Brown picked up his third term in a state the president won by eight points – on the same day voters there chose a Republican for governor. Known for his scratchy voice and disheveled look, Brown has carved out a niche for himself as a working class champion – and one whose views on trade policy and China are more in line with Trump than most traditional Republicans. Bernie Sanders The runner-up for the Democratic presidential nomination in , Sanders has a vast grassroots network that has continued to work through the midterms. The Early Bird Maryland Rep. Delaney, a wealthy former businessman, is still the the least known candidate, though he has made frequent trips to the early states and has endorsed local office candidates in Iowa and New Hampshire. Eric Swalwell The year-old congressman is a familiar face on cable news, using his perch as a member of the House Intelligence Committee to challenge the president, and he has also become a prominent figures in the congressional investigation into Russian meddling and allegations of collusion. His candidacy inspired a nationwide Democratic obsession and garnered endorsements from the likes of Beyonce. Seth Moulton A former Marine Corps officer, the year-old, two-term Moulton set out to create a green wave of military vets running for office in the cycle. Richard Ojeda The West Virginia state senator and veteran of Army tours in Iraq and Afghanistan announced his on Monday, nearly a week after losing his bid to represent the 3rd Congressional District by a dozen points. Ojeda, who voted for Mr. Trump in , garnered national attention over the course of the cycle running as a Democrat in a state where the president is most popular. Interlopers Michael Avenatti The attorney for adult film actress Stormy Daniels and a prolific cable news presence has made visits to early states and developed his own super PAC. Trump at his own game. CNBC reports that Schultz is building a public relations team to help with the release of a new book and a possible presidential run. Schmidt left the GOP in June and is a frequent critic of the president. Hickenlooper has been twice elected in a purple state critical to winning the presidency. He signed gun control measures in Colorado that were met with backlash there, but could be appealing among Democratic primary voters. Steve Bullock The Montana governor has a proven ability to win in a red state, having been re-elected by four points in when Trump carried the state by over 20 points. Bullock was elected to lead the National Governors Association, which helps him build a network of office holders and donors. The governor would be seen as a moderate force in a Democratic primary, but has also voiced support for tougher gun laws, including an assault weapons ban. Terry McAuliffe Having served as governor of Virginia and chairman of the DNC, the longtime friend of the Clintons has built a critical fundraising network around the country. McAuliffe campaigned for candidates in the midterms, including in the first caucus state of Iowa. He touts economic developments and low unemployment in Virginia as a calling card. He pushed for Medicaid expansion in his state, though it met resistance in the GOP legislature, and moved to restore voting rights to felons.
