The purpose of this directive is to establish the guidelines for conducting undercover operations. An undercover operation in which the undercover agent purchases illegal materials, usually drugs, from a suspect and cover agents immediately follow with an on-scene arrest Buy-bust reversal operation: An undercover operation in which the undercover agent supplies drugs or other illegal materials to a suspect for money and cover agents immediately follow up with an on-scene arrest. An operation conducted to avoid detection, which is divulged only to those directly involved in the investigation Detail: Sworn members of the ALE Branch grouped together for the accomplishment of a specified official mission Raid: An operation conducted with the element of surprise in an effort to arrest suspects in the act and to preserve evidence of the criminal activity Surveillance: Close observation of a person or location; may involve a simple, periodic check on a stationary subject or location conducted by one sworn member, or a continuous long-term multi-person, multi-vehicle operation Undercover agent: An ALE sworn member who conceals his or her identity as a sworn law enforcement officer from suspects, members of the public, and other persons, for the purpose of discovering violations of any ABC laws or regulations, violations of the Controlled Substances Act, or any other violations of the criminal laws of the State Undercover operations: Any law enforcement investigation, conducted for the Branch or another agency, during which an undercover agent or other law enforcement officer conceals his identity as a sworn law enforcement officer from suspects, members of the public, and other persons. A sworn member shall request permission for an undercover operation after a preliminary investigation has shown clear necessity for such an investigation. SACs may approve an undercover operation if: The investigation takes place entirely within the district; b. All officers involved in the investigation are within their territorial jurisdiction; and c. If the undercover operation uses sworn members currently assigned to another district, the SAC of the requesting district should coordinate the request with the SAC of the other district. Sworn members from other districts should only be used in short-term, routine operations. Once arrangements have been made, the SAC of the requesting district should notify the Assistant Director of the operation via email. This email should include a summary of the operation and notification of any per diem needs. SACs should provide this notification as early as possible to allow for the securing of per diem funds prior to the operation. Undercover operations that involve any officer outside their territorial jurisdiction shall be approved by the Assistant Director. For these types of operations, the SAC in whose district the operation is scheduled to occur shall request the approval through a memorandum at least seven 7 calendar days prior to the proposed beginning of the operation. In extreme circumstances, the AD may waive this deadline. The identity of the requesting member or law enforcement agency; b. The specific nature of the undercover investigation anticipated example: A summary of any prior investigation conducted and problems encountered. If prior investigations have not been conducted, state why other types of investigative techniques would be ineffective; d. Background information concerning the subjects and location believed to be involved in the alleged violations and any other information helpful to the undercover agent; e. A list of the equipment to be used by the undercover agent including automobiles, radios, buy money, or other similar items; f. The type of clothing the undercover agent should wear example: Arrangements, if any, for lodging; h. An appraisal of the anticipated results of the operation; i. The identity of any undercover agents requested; j. The time, date, place where the undercover agent should meet the cover agent to begin the operation; and l. The anticipated termination date of the undercover operation. The Branch Head must be given prior notification of every investigation that targets questionable sexual conduct or activity, including those investigations involving licensed ABC outlets. Sworn members shall not personally participate in any undercover activities in massage parlors or similar adult entertainment businesses unless the operation is approved by the Branch Head or his designee. The Agent in Charge shall contact the District Attorney to verify legal appropriateness prior to conducting this type of operation. The SAC controlling the undercover operation shall assign a cover agent

from the district in which the undercover operations begins. The cover agent shall provide personal on-scene coverage to the undercover agent at all times in order to assure his safety. A sworn member shall never conduct an undercover operation unless a cover agent is present. A member of another law enforcement agency shall not assume this responsibility. When at all possible, a sworn member shall use an informant or other source to introduce the undercover agent into the operation. When possible and as a general rule, proper case deconfliction should be conducted during undercover operations. The SAC shall ensure that the names of all persons being investigated are submitted to ISAAC and other primary agencies where no overlapping investigation may be occurring. For more information, see section A of this directive. All participants in the operation should familiarize themselves with the suspect, any vehicles used by the suspect, and the neighborhood or area of the operation. Any legal issues in question should be reviewed with the District Attorney of the county in which the surveillance is being conducted prior to the beginning of the operation. The Branch will supply participants with the expense funds necessary to conduct the surveillance appropriate to the operation. The SAC shall be kept advised of all on-going surveillance operations. The lead agent on the surveillance operation is responsible for documenting the activities of the operation and reporting those activities to the SAC. For operations requiring use of technical surveillance equipment or the surveillance platform, refer to directive 6. SACs shall be aware of all details of the operation to ensure that Branch guidelines are being followed. Participants in undercover and decoy operations shall familiarize themselves with the location of the operation, the suspects involved, and the types of crimes expected. Participants for undercover and decoy operations will be chosen from those who best fit the requirements of the particular investigation. Ability to infiltrate the target area; b. Familiarity with procedures and the target area; and c. Ability to establish rapport with the suspects particular to the operation. Specific plans shall be made for suspect contact. Considerations shall be made for support manpower and other officer safety resources. The location, proximity to witnesses or bystanders, and light conditions shall be considered. Sworn members, for reasons of officer safety, shall not disclose the identity of any undercover participant without the consent of that participant. Sworn members shall be supplied with the appropriate equipment and funds to safely and effectively conduct the operation. All equipment shall be checked prior to use to ensure proper functioning. Provisions for communication between participants in the operation shall be established in advance and shall include back-up measures. All activities of the undercover operation shall be documented by the lead agent and reported to the SAC following the operation. The funds are issued upon written request by the SAC or designee and approval of the Assistant Director. The SAC, or designee, will issue funds to sworn members as needed in conducting investigations. Additional funds may be requested throughout the year when necessary. Each person in this process is accountable and responsible for the legitimate expenditure and accurate accountability of these funds. Expenditures may be made from Special Funds at the discretion of an individual sworn member in accordance with the guidelines set forth in this section. The sworn member is accountable for each expenditure and must justify the propriety and necessity of the expenditure. He shall document the results of his undercover activity as soon as possible, but no later than seven 7 calendar days thereafter. Operations involving more than one 1 undercover agent require a separate report AL from each sworn member. Upon completion of the undercover operation, the case agent shall submit a complete investigative report to the SAC. This report shall reflect the course and results of the undercover operation. The case agent shall submit this report no later than fifteen 15 calendar days from the last action date. The case agent shall retain responsibility for the case following the termination of undercover activity. The report shall clearly identify the agency responsible for each arrest. The SAC or his designee is responsible for submitting monthly source of information and undercover funds expenditure reports to Headquarters by the 7th of the month. The Assistant Director or his designee is responsible for compiling and maintaining a monthly Undercover Funds Report for the Branch.

To go "undercover" is to avoid detection by the entity one is observing, and especially to disguise one's own identity or use an assumed identity for the purposes of gaining the trust of an individual or organization to learn or confirm confidential information or to gain the trust of targeted individuals in order to gather information or evidence.

Drug Enforcement Administration DEA , announced the results of a year-long, coordinated national operation that used the first nationwide undercover action to target vendors of illicit goods on the Darknet. Investigators monitoring Darknet marketplaces found accounts used by some of the conspirators, leading agents to execute search warrants at three addresses in residential communities in Flushing and Mt. While searching the residence where Akkaya and Tseperkas were found, investigators recovered three loaded shotguns, including a tactical double-barreled shotgun loaded with 14 shells, and over 50 shotgun shells, as well as significant quantities of narcotics, packaging materials, and paraphernalia including a money-counting machine. Powell, 32, and Michael Gonzalez, 27, former and current residents of Parma, Ohio, respectively, were charged by the U. The conspiracy involved distributing Xanax, steroids, marijuana and other drugs across the country using these and other Darknet monikers. Powell and Gonzalez would then launder the funds as cryptocurrencies such as Bitcoin, Ethereum, and Komodo through individuals specializing in money laundering on Darknet marketplaces. Jose Robert Porras III, 21, and Pasia Vue, 23, both of Sacramento, were charged with drug distribution, money laundering, and illegally possessing firearms, in a count indictment returned by a grand jury in the Eastern District of California. After receiving the Bitcoin from Porras and Vue, the undercover agent mailed parcels of cash to them in Sacramento. Sam Bent, 32, of St. The indictment alleges that the conspiracy involved setting up accounts on dark web marketplaces, establishing online identities, accepting Bitcoin in exchange for sales over the dark web, and mailing controlled substances from several different post offices in Northeastern Vermont and Northwestern New Hampshire in an effort to avoid detection. The indictment also charges Sam Bent with four counts of money laundering involving three different exchanges of bitcoin drug distribution proceeds for U. McMonegal was also the owner of a marijuana delivery service in San Luis Obispo called West Coast Organix, which claimed to be a non-profit medical marijuana cooperative. McMonegal then laundered the Bitcoin proceeds of his drug distribution through an undercover agent located in New York. More than 50 Darknet vendor accounts were identified and attributed to the real individuals selling illicit goods on Darknet market sites such as Silk Road, AlphaBay, Hansa, Dream, and others. An Israeli lieutenant colonel was killed and another officer wounded in the operation on Sunday night in south-east Gaza, the first known ground incursion there by Israeli forces since the last war in In apparent response to the gunfight, more than a dozen rockets were launched from the Hamas-controlled enclave overnight, and the Israeli prime minister, Benjamin Netanyahu , cut short a visit to Paris, where he had been gathering with world leaders for a first world war commemoration. In a second round of what appeared to be retaliatory attacks, militants in Gaza fired a barrage of rockets and mortar bombs deep into Israeli territory on Monday afternoon, hitting a bus and severely wounding a year-old, according to Israeli media. The Israeli army said 80 projectiles had been launched. Bomb sirens sounded in Israeli communities along the frontier and the military said its anti-air defences had intercepted several rockets. Its fighters had given chase as the vehicle sped away, it said. Medics and Hamas officials said at least seven people were killed, four of them militants, including the Hamas commander Nour Baraka. Israel had largely abandoned its tactic of targeting senior Hamas officials in recent years. Its military said in a short statement: Israeli media reported the operation had been to gather intelligence. The public radio station Kan reported IDF special forces had their cover blown as a result of a technical malfunction, and became pinned down. Residents in the area where the fighting took place said the car being driven by the soldiers, some of whom were dressed as women, had been stopped by Baraka, who asked for identification. The soldiers shot him with a silenced gun before speeding to an olive grove, where they were extricated by helicopter. Hamas militants in pursuit had been bombed by air, residents said, and Israeli aircraft destroyed the car used by its forces once they had left. Later on Monday a Hamas member in the neighbourhood refused to comment on the accounts. The incident threatens an unofficial ceasefire between Israel and Hamas. Last week, Israel, which blockades the sq mile area, allowed shipments of fuel into the strip to supply electricity plants and reduce crippling power cuts. Violence has flared frequently on the frontier since Palestinians began weekly protests in March. Israel responded to the movement with lethal fire, killing about demonstrators and injuring thousands more. Bloodshed has continued for seven months, with Hamas and Israel fighting an on-off war of airstrikes and rockets. Egypt, Qatar and the United Nations have been working to broker a long-term ceasefire.

There are some moments, in which the movie can show off its strengths, and they mainly lie within the characters and the fact that the triad members are portrayed like real human beings and not like merciless killers. Many of them show their weak sides. There is Jim with his sudden lovestory with Elaine, played by Sonja Kwok, which is actually a bit too spirited, yet manages to ignite the spark necessary for us to be interested in this subplot. Even an emotional fridge as Tommy shows some heart, in his case when it comes to his mother. In exchange, the "good guys" get some surprisingly dark sides, too, for instance Wai and his past in the police force. This grey-coloration of the characters is very welcome and refreshingly honest. At its core, the plot is quite clever and has many twists up its sleeve, but then the movie drifts off again and again, sometimes being funny, at others emotional or just deadly serious. Furthermore, there are several missed opportunities. Many scenes could have been more thrilling, and especially during the emotional scenes there was so much potential hidden. Marko Mak showed with his "Colour of the Truth" that he can do a lot better and so "Operation Undercover" clearly falls short of what it had the potential to be. Despite all the flaws and the disappointment about the many missed opportunities, the actors can make up for a lot. Especially Eric Tsang and Francis Ng once more prove that they are great in depicting complex individuals. Everyone is doing his part and is convincing almost all of the time. Especially some of the barefaced allusions to "Infernal Affairs" may be proving the point that there is a good amount of humor to be found in this film, but they somehow lack the necessary wink for us to get along with it. However, as you dive deeper and deeper into the world of some of the interesting characters, you learn to oversee these flaws. Towards the end things get better, anyway, and somehow the director even manages to get things right, so that everything resolves in a way that is acceptable for the viewer. Whereas it even gets surprisingly gritty and unforgiving. There are ups and downs, but the cast and the character-driven aspect of the film prove to be really entertaining. Keeping in mind that Wong Jing produced this movie you just have to give some words of praise. Despite the many flaws.

Woodpax land purchase, and development of Sheffield Park Carriage Shed, Platform 2 canopy restoration, with new Museum and new toilet facilities, Loco washout pit and new loco lobby facilities at Sheffield Park. We also have a unique collection of carriages spanning the years from the s to the s. In three carriages, whose average age was , were outshopped to wide acclaim. These are proving excellent crowd pullers in every sense. These restorations were done in the cramped conditions of the old carriage shed. One of the first two Metropolitan Railway coaches, fresh from its overhaul in January This is an example of the many vintage carriages we have which must be kept under cover to ensure their long-term survival. Lewis Nodes The long term plan has three schemes to ensure we can maintain our high quality vintage trains and restore more of our historic collection. The first of these was an extension to the existing carriage shed. This provided 3 properly laid out restoration bays and allowed the return to storage use of half the old shed and the remainder to be reorganised to provide another 3 restoration bays. The cladding and roof completed September The Southern Railway style and colouring of the building, which is designed to match that of the rest of the station, has already received much praise. Since this photo was taken the windows have been glazed, a mammoth task in itself. The generous assistance of The Bluebell Railway Trust in contributing half the cost of the cladding is acknowledged. During the last parts of this project fell into place, with the relocation of the paint shop to the south end of the old building, construction of a fire-break wall between the two halves of the shed, and partial re-cladding of the paint-shop area. Having achieved this, we move on to: Completion of north end of loco running shed This project involved the tidying up of unfinished work, and was the relatively minor scheme to complete the north end of the existing Locomotive Running Shed, which was extended by one bay, and brickwork completed at that end, on foundations laid some years ago. This has been funded partly from money already raised over many years for the purpose, by new donations given specifically for this latest work, and by a contribution from the Bluebell Railway Trust, under the auspices of "Operation Undercover". The Woodpax site forms the basis for Phase 3 of Operation Undercover, which provides covered accomodation for up to 17 carriages, a new museum building, a new loco washout pit, the repair and reconstruction of the platform buildings and canopy, provision of toilets on platform 2, and the shell of a building for new loco staff facilities, all at Sheffield Park. The Shed and museum both opened during Full details and news reports relating to Phase 3 are available on a separate web page. The limited length of the down-yard headshunt means that this shed would not be suitable as a running shed for 6-car rakes. It is therefore considered that this shed would eventually be the home of the shorter vintage sets, but in the immediate future will simply be the home of those vehicles stored awaiting overhaul. This would enable us to put virtually all the pre-Mk. I carriages under cover. The plans also include a Heritage Skills centre, and a component storage shed to clear the shipping containers and open-air component storage. With planning permission secured for the entire project, fund-raising in the Autumn of enabled contacts to be let for the foundations, structure and roof. The building can then be completed in manageable stages over the coming years as funding permits, but will immediately give the benefit of the cover to the coaches as seen in Matthew Cousins drawing here. Longer term plans Outside the Operation Undercover banner, at Sheffield Park the ASH project plans to construct a 2-road shed on the site of the original small loco shed, providing much improved frost protection for the locomotives used during the winter, also covering the new loco washout pit, and providing a maintenance facility independent of the main loco works. A further way to cover more locomotives could be a roundhouse for the smaller pre-grouping locomotives, which would take space from the top car-park, or a small southern extension of the main loco shed. These plans are still evolving, and input from around the railway is constantly being canvassed as these plans develop over the years. It is clear that the long-term aim must be, somehow or other, to get our entire collection of historic stock locos, carriages, vans and wagons under cover.

One year later, it expanded again, to 28 secret agents. He himself still went out hunting for criminals too. His memoirs are full of stories about how he outsmarted crooks by pretending to be a beggar or an old cuckold. At one point, he even simulated his own death. From the start, the force occasionally employed plainclothes undercover detectives, but there was much public anxiety that these powers were being used for the purpose of political repression. In part due to these concerns, the official Police Orders required all undercover operations to be specifically authorized by the superintendent. It was only in that Police commissioner Edmund Henderson established a formal plainclothes detective division. This pioneering branch was the first to be trained in counter terrorism techniques. Its name was changed to Special Branch as it had its remit gradually expanded to incorporate a general role in counter terrorism, combating foreign subversion and infiltrating organized crime. Law enforcement agencies elsewhere established similar Branches. The first is the maintenance of identity and the second is the reintegration back into normal duty. Living a double life in a new environment presents many problems. Undercover work is one of the most stressful jobs a special agent can undertake. This simple isolation can lead to depression and anxiety. There is no data on the divorce rates of agents, but strain on relationships does occur. This can be a result of a need for secrecy and an inability to share work problems, and the unpredictable work schedule, personality and lifestyle changes and the length of separation can all result in problems for relationships. The amount of elaborate planning, risk, and expenditure can pressure an agent to succeed, which can cause considerable stress. The lack of the usual controls of a uniform, badge, constant supervision, a fixed place of work, or often a set assignment could, combined with their continual contact with the organized crime, increase the likelihood for corruption. They are more prone to the development of an addiction as they suffer greater stress than other police, they are isolated, and drugs are often very accessible. There can be some guilt associated with going undercover due to betraying those who have come to trust the officer. This can cause anxiety or even, in very rare cases, sympathy with those being targeted. This is especially true with the infiltration of political groups, as often the agent will share similar characteristics with those they are infiltrating like class, age, ethnicity or religion. This could even result in the conversion of some agents. Agents work their own hours, they are removed from direct supervisory monitoring, and they can ignore the dress and etiquette rules. After working such free lifestyles, agents may have discipline problems or exhibit neurotic responses. They may feel uncomfortable, and take a cynical, suspicious or even paranoid world view and feel continually on guard. Plainclothes law enforcement[edit] Undercover agents should not be confused with law enforcement officers who wear plainclothes. This method is used by law enforcement and intelligence agencies. To wear plainclothes is to wear civilian clothes, instead of wearing a uniform, to avoid detection or identification as a law enforcement officer. However, plainclothes police officers typically carry normal police equipment and normal identification. Police detectives are assigned to wear plainclothes by wearing suits instead of the uniform typically worn by their peers. Police officers in plainclothes must identify themselves when using their police powers; however, they are not required to identify themselves on demand and may lie about their status as a police officer.
