Ghetto walls were breached and torn down exposing the Jewish population and its artists to a myriad of Christian and secular influences. While traditional Judaica continued to be fashioned by artisans, synagogues ornamented and books and Haggadahs illustrated, many Jewish artists now became aware of another kind of artistic expression; the art object itself. Painting became a legitimate mode of Jewish cultural expression. In this outburst of artistic freedom Moritz Oppenheim is the undisputed father of Jewish painting in the nineteenth century. Educated in heder and Talmud Torah he nonetheless made a quick transition to secular studies and art school upon the emancipation of the Jews in Frankfurt. After studying in Frankfurt, Munich, Paris and Rome he returned to Frankfurt to pursue a successful career painting society portraits especially the Rothschilds and academic visions of biblical scenes. In he launched upon a series depicting scenes of eighteenth century Jewish life much like the world of his childhood. These images of Shabbos, Yom Tov, weddings and many other Jewish communal and family scenes were quickly reproduced in bound albums and were soon found in almost every German Jewish home. They were the encapsulation of the world that once was and was now slowly disappearing. The Pictures of Traditional Jewish Family Life became a visual anchor for many Jews caught in the sweep of emancipation, nationalism and modernity. Providing a sense of identity, even with a sentimental vision of a vanishing Jewish world, would help keep Jews in the fold for at least another generation. Jews Praying on the Day of Atonement oil on canvas by Maurycy Gottlieb Tel Aviv Museum of Art, Israel That next generation could be characterized by Maurycy Gottlieb , a singular artist from eastern Galicia Drohobycz who painted the masterpiece Jews Praying on the Day of Atonement in one year before he died at the age of twenty-three. He was the child of progressive parents, studied at the art schools in Lemberg and Vienna and quickly began painting subjects of Polish history, Shakespeare and the Bible, including some Christian scenes. In his brief career he saw both his Jewish heritage and all of European civilization as his cultural birthright. While stillborn, his work seeks to thrust Jewish subjects and sensibilities into the heart of modern thought. Oppenheim looked to the past while Gottlieb yearned for the future. Hannah oil on canvas by Isidor Kaufmann Isidor Kaufmann continues the movement of Jewish Art into the Modern through a wonderfully subversive methodology. Born in Arad, Hungary, Kaufmann took up painting in Vienna and was soon drawn to the mysterious world of the shtetl and Hasidic life in Galicia, Poland and Ukraine. In annual field trips he would collect images; portraits, costumes, interiors and genre scenes that would be transformed into glistening narrative gems of Jewish life for his eager customers; assimilated, rich Viennese Jews. His best works, mainly portraits of young Hasidic men and women impeccably dressed for Yom Tov, are beautifully and simply composed paintings that reveal subtle psychological insights. In the work of El Lissitzky , modernity subsumes tradition. Had Gadya is his Jewish Art masterpiece. He grew up in Vitebsk, Russia and after the revolution joined Chagall teaching in the Vitebsk art school. Deeply involved in the movement to recreate Jewish culture in Russia especially in the publication and illustration of Yiddish books his Had Gadya of color lithographs were published in Kiev in Soon after El Lissitzky turned his attention to the most radical modern art movement of the time, Constructivism. Along with fellow Russian, Casimir Malevich, he created a totally abstract visual language, merging aspects of painting and architecture. The seeds of this new vision are clearly visible in Had Gadya. Combining vivid imagery such as the savage fury of the red cat leaping over the slain goat , a text border and bold abstract shapes the artist breaks out of nineteenth century naturalism into the drama and uncertainty of a new age. That new age is in many ways the world we still live in. Subsequent Jewish Art would continue to struggle between textual traditions and visual innovations we associate with Modern Art.

3: Leviticus 19â€“ A Law of Performances and Ordinances, Part 3: Laws of Mercy and Righteousness

The study of Genesis helps us understand much about the world we inhabit. Because it maps the beginnings and development of human society, it provides perspective on our own times. In our exploration of this book of origins we have arrived at the immediate post-Flood world, about 4, years ago.

Hyper Grace Proponents of hyper grace teach that the moral law found in the 10 Commandments has no relevance in the New Testament Church era. Consequently, its proponents can theoretically sin without fear since everything is based on grace, without consideration for the moral law of God. Whenever a church only preaches the love and blessings of God in Christ without ever mentioning the need to repent and or the consequences of sin in the life of the believer â€” then there is a good chance that is a hyper grace church. One of the worst things many proponents of hyper grace teach is that the teachings of Jesus as found in the gospels are not relevant for the church today. They believe that the teachings of the Gospels fall under the O. This is why even a cursory study of the epistles of Paul, James, Peter and John show that they reiterate obedience to the 10 Commandments as a standard for ethics, not for salvation as well as the words and teachings of Jesus. Although I believe pastors should consistently deliver evangelical messages focused on bringing new people to Christ, I also contend that the church needs teaching on Sundays that will ground Christ followers in sound doctrine. Since most people only attend church on Sundays â€” we cannot merely depend upon small group discipleship and or mid-week services and bible institutes. Unfortunately, with most church attendees, the Sunday sermon is the only exposure they will get to biblical teaching. Although it takes some skill, pastors can minister effectively to both saint and sinner with Sunday sermons so that unbelievers can be saved, and saints can mature. They believe that since Jesus already ascended into heaven and returned when He judged Israel in 70 A. They assert that Jesus is already fully reigning from heaven irrespective of the condition or politics of nationsâ€”since His reign is from heaven and is spiritual. Without getting into detail regarding this view, I will only say here that this extreme teaching can de-motivate its adherents regarding global evangelization and transformation since. According to them, everything Jesus promised has already been fulfilled. Consequently, it leads to a mystical kind of Christianity without practical goals nor any phenomenological handles to grab hold of. It also flies in the face of the historic biblical beliefs of the church and General Councils such as Nicaea and Constantinople as well as the Apostles Creedâ€”that affirm the future, second, bodily return of Christ and by implication, that the fulness of the Kingdom on earth is a future event predicated by the Bodily Return of Jesus Christ as Lord of all. Zion, the New Jerusalem as the church of the Firstborn; see Hebrews As an example of the problem with Hyper Zionism, I remember one time in a significant city-wide prayer gathering, a national prophetic figure put cold water on a powerful meeting when he said that unless we minister to the Jew first â€” revival will not come to our churches and our regions. After that statement, the whole meeting died! Although I believe in ministering to Jewish people and believe our nation should be a strong ally with political Israel, I also believe strongly in ministering to the Arab peoples. I do not presently center my whole ministry upon the restoration of the Jewish nation to Messiah- like others specifically called of God to do so like some of my dear friends and partners in ministry. In spite of this, God has greatly blessed our church and ministry as He has thousands of other churches and leaders throughout church history who never focused their whole life and ministry in Jewish evangelism or the restoration of political Israel. Of course, God never blesses anti-Semitism, and He still has a special place in His heart for Jewish people and the land of Israel, that I believe will one day be restored as a joy to the whole earth in accordance with many of the O.

Trip report part 3 Mar 15, , 3: Woke up to a rainy morning. Walked down to the dining room to find that I am the first one there. The young woman who is setting up scurries around, I tell her to take her time, I am in no hurry. Besides, they have wifi down here and I want to upload pictures. I get myself a coffee, and upload pictures. This was the best breakfast I had yet, on this trip! I finished the tuna and feta first, and she brings me more! Amazing food and outstanding service! While I was eating my delicious meal, it started to pour! So much for hiking today, I think to myself. Already running over a mental list in my head of other things to do, I could go to Acre and see the underground sites, or I could go to Zsfat, orâ€¦. Back to my original plans. I am on the road by 9, go over to Goren Park, just get to the railing and looking out over the stupendous views when my battery dies in my Canon DSL. Luckily I have a spare already charged, but I left it back in my room, not a problem, just a few minutes down the road. I just make it back to my car when it starts raining again. I am heading out the road of Goren Park when something comes out of the woods and lopes onto the road, coming my way. I stop the car. It is very cautious, has its head down, sniffing the ground, slowly moving my direction. Big pointy ears, long thin nose, is it a wolf? I never saw a jackal, are they as big as a coyote? But the thing is, this animal looks sickly. Its hind quarters seem to be missing fur also. I got pictures and a video of it. Tomorrow I will show them to Izsak, the guy who works the reception desk here at the kibbutz. I am sure he will know what it was. Go back to my room, exchange batteries, grab the big plastic El Al Fly Buy bag yes, I did some shopping on the plane , the bag will go in my backpack, in case I get caught in rain while hiking, all my electronics will stay nice and dry. By the time I pull into the parking lot, the sun comes out again. Blustery and cold up here. Put on my fleece pullover, then my waterproof shell. Wish I had brought my gloves, it is that nippy. Extremely windy at the arch, the wind whips up through the cave and you really have to fight to keep your balance. Buffeted by the wind, I wander around enjoying the scenery and the lavish landscapes. I can even see the waves of the Mediterranean Sea from way up here. Bet they are huge! A herd of fluffy black goats appear above the rocky hill just before the arch. A little hunched-over elderly shephardess calls them back to her. That is tough terrain, let alone the heavy gales. From the arch, I follow the red marked trail along the rim, out to where I am just a little northwest of kibbutz Elon, than I turn around and head back to my car. I meet a couple about my age, from Montana, the man has shorts and a shortleeve shirt on, his wife has a warm jacket on. I tell them how blustery and cold it is out on the exposed bluff, he goes back to the car and gets a jacket. Bet he was happy that he did. Head on back to Goren Park. And I drip dry. Twenty minutes later a deluge is upon me. I stood on the trail and watched it come across the valley, you could see the band of rain coming, here it comes And then it is done. Finally make it down the slick, slippery trail and do a portion of the very pretty Nahal Kziv, hike an hour out, another brief rainshower, I give up and come back and climb to Monfort Fortress where the winds await me. Were you ever in gusts of wind where you can hardly keep your balance? The wind howls around the corners of the ancient ruins, and bursts through the doorways, its always there to greet you. And it sings a wild high-pitched tune through the pipe railings. It was like something alive. I truly enjoyed it. Back down the trail, and back up to Goren Park. Rain drops hit me as I get to the parking lot. Take off my muddy hiking shoes and leave them on the porch. Realize how exhausted i am, but it is the good kind of exhaustion. Makes it all worthwhile; the sleepless plane ride, the immense jet lag, the frustrating drives when you get lost THIS day has made it all worth it! Wash my dirty pants in the bathroom sink, a long hot shower, make myself dinner, crack open that last Goldstar Lager and write down my memories. Next will be a glass of that very good Abaya red I picked up yesterday.

If Burge is correct, then the nation of Israel should not be of any concern to the writers of the New Testament after the coming of Jesus. The major focus should be on Christ and the church - not one nation, especially Israel. Burge fails to understand the verse quoted by Paul from Genesis Through progressive revelation, the prophets revealed this blessing would come through one seed of Israel - the Messiah. Theirs are the patriarchs, and from them is traced the human ancestry of the Messiah, who is God over all, forever praised! Yet Paul never says the other covenants God has with Israel will be nullified once the Messiah comes. Only theologians like Sizer and Burge spout forth that false belief. Paul says later in Romans Further evidence is found in the prophetic passages of the New Testament that describe Israel back in the Promised Land after the present diaspora. Consequently, the rebuilding of the Temple can only occur if the Jewish people are back in the land. For those Reformed theologians and adherents of replacement theology who see these events as already fulfilled in the first century, then they would be forced to conclude Jesus has already returned. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory. And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other" Matthew From these New Testament passages we can only conclude the Jewish people will be back in the land prior to the return of Jesus when the abomination [the Antichrist] stands in the Jewish Temple to desecrate it 2 Thessalonians 2: In Zechariah 14 the prophet is speaking to the Jewish people and telling them the nations of the earth will come against Israel vs. How can such a passage be fulfilled unless the Jewish people are back in the land? What is happening is that the story line is moving from the universal to the particular. It narrows from the dispersed nations to one man. The survivors of the Flood were to repopulate the earth, and their possibilities have been outlined in the Table of Nations chapter. Three times since Creation, man has failed God: Several of those named are notable. As we have seen, Nimrod represented a way of life contrary to God. Abraham will come to symbolize a very different way. The toledoth of Terah Genesis. With chapter 12 the focus turns to this individual and his primary descendants. God will mainly be concerned with them for the next two thousand years. The land to which he is to journey is at this point unknown. Following his call by God, he left the city of Ur with his family Genesis. Accompanying Abram were Sarai his wife, Lot the son of his deceased brother Haran, and their servants. They traveled through Canaan to the Oak of Moreh just outside Shechem, where God appeared to Abram and promised that the land would be for his offspring Genesis. This is the first iteration of the Abrahamic Covenant. In what became a practice of the patriarchs, Abram built an altar to God there. Having entered Canaan, the land of promise, Abram was now living a nomadic life. This is symbolic of his new life in this world. None of this is to imply that Abram was perfect in his way of life. He was just beginning to learn to follow God, to have trust and faith. He was journeying toward the goal. His immediate visit to Egypt was to avoid famine in Canaan Genesis. Sarai, now at least 65 years of age, was a very beautiful woman. Because Abram knew that the Egyptians might steal her away and kill him, he asked her to say that she was his sister to preserve his life and to benefit herself. This was not an outright lie—she was his half sister see Genesis. Not only were Pharaoh and his household cursed for his unwittingly taking Sarai as his wife, but the stay in Egypt also resulted in Abram acquiring wealth and servants that led to difficulties in his household for a long time to come: Further, it is likely that one of the maidservants Abram was given in Egypt was Hagar, with whom, as we learn in later chapters, he fathered Ishmael, the cause of dissent between Sarai and Hagar chapter. Despite these outcomes, God was intent on carrying out His plan for Abram and providing the blessings He had promised. This did not result in denying blessings to Lot, Hagar and Ishmael. We also learn later that Abram was able to rescue Lot and return his possessions after he had been taken captive by warring kings from nearby territories including Babylon and Elam chapter. But returning to chapter 13, it is with Abram and Sarai that God is now primarily concerned. The friction with Lot is resolved when Abram gives his nephew the option of choosing land where he prefers to make his home. He decides on the well-watered fertile plains of Jordan, close to Sodom and Gomorrah. Though at first still a tent-dweller, his access to Sodom will lead him into great danger. Abram is left to tend his herds and flocks in the high country of central Canaan verses 10—11. It is in the aftermath of the separation from Lot that God, as Yahweh, speaks again to Abram. This time He promises the land in all directions to Abram and his innumerable descendants forever verses 14—15. Names of God Genesis records several names by which God is known. In response, Abram gave him a tithe of the spoils of war. By the time the book of Hebrews was written in the first century C. The covenant between God and Abram is repeated in chapter 15, where Yahweh shows him in a vision that, despite Sarai being unable to conceive and Abram being old, they will have a son to continue their line verses 1—6. Satan brought in his false teachers, and deceitful workers, disguising themselves as messengers of Christ, and as servants of righteousness, 2CO If Israel only realized that the Mosaic Law given to them in the dispensation of Israel had no power to give them life or to sustain life, as the apostle Paul taught in GAL 3: If a Law had been given which could give spiritual life, then righteousness and right standing with God would certainly have come by the Mosaic Law. The purpose of the Mosaic Law was to make obvious to everyone that we are, in ourselves, out of right relationship with God. The Law was given to show us the futility of devising some religious system for getting by our own efforts what we can only get by waiting in faith for God to complete His promise. The Mosaic Law, given to them in the dispensation of Israel, was actually bondage for the unbelievers and believers in the dispensation of Israel, GAL 4: All who depend on the Law, who are seeking to be justified by obedience to the Law of rituals, are under a curse and doomed to disappointment and destruction. Today's post is Part 3 about the New Babylonian Empire. Refer to Part 1 and Part 2 about the New Babylonian Empire to refresh your memory. Last time, we left off with Nebuchadnezzar's experiences in the animal kingdom.

For seven years, Nebuchadnezzar was given the mind of an animal because he continuously glorified himself as the great ruler and builder of his empire. The chapter also indicates that Nebuchadnezzar turned from his gods whether his false gods or himself and worshipped the one true God alone. Then the next chapter skips even more time. After Nebuchadnezzar, there were several more kings until King Labashi-Marduk came along. Whoever is in power can make up a new story for a new god. They should have tried writing fantasy instead of religious writings. Nabonidus was so passionate about Sin who he promoted to chief god how silly does that sound? Since he was rarely in the capital city of Babylon, he left his son Belshazzar to rule the kingdom. This brings us to Daniel 5. Since he was drunk, he commanded that the gold and silver vessels which were used in the Temple of Jerusalem to serve God be brought out for the party. They defiled these vessels dedicated to God and instead praised all of their phony gods. If you remember, Nebuchadnezzar plundered the Temple in Jerusalem in the beginning of the book of Daniel. All of a sudden, a hand appeared and wrote on the wall: Belshazzar saw this hand, and he became very afraid. Daniel is brought in and reminds Belshazzar of some family history. Nebuchadnezzar was a very powerful king. God gave him all of that power, but he did not glorify God for any of it. He did not even recognize God at all and kept praising himself as if he was solely responsible for all that he had. So, God humbled him by driving him out with the animals until he knew that God ruled over all men. Belshazzar had the same pride, and he had not humbled himself under God. That was really obvious from his previous actions. Then Daniel interpreted the words. MENE meant that his days were numbered. The word appearing twice meant that it was surely going to happen soon. TEKEL meant that his actions were weighed, and he needed to pay for them since he was wanting in the balance. Daniel received his rewards, but that same night, Belshazzar was killed by the Medo-Persian conquerors. Herodotus writes that the Persians started their siege outside of the city. When this took too long, they diverted the Euphrates so they could cross under the city walls through a dry river bed. King Darius of the Medes became king of the empire. The fall of Babylon shows an important concept. Nebuchadnezzar had plenty of years and plenty of warnings to repent from his pride and turn toward God. He was warned at least three times with three pretty unforgettable signs: Belshazzar had one sign: We might have several years or we might have an hour left to repent. Granted you will not have a strange dream that a prophet will need to interpret. But how about someone giving you a gospel tract or a Bible or someone telling you about your sins and the salvation in Christ. Do not ignore these "signs" if I could use that word. Your way is not the right way; it will not be good for you; it will not satisfy you. It will only lead to more destruction. It is the best choice you could ever make for your life, hands down. But make that decision now. Get your life right with the Lord and ask Him for forgiveness.

How do we celebrate Yom Kippur, while biking 70 miles a day, moving 7 people around in van, entering new cities every night, on a speaking tour? First, let me tell you who we are. Today we are a group of 7, but our number is always changing, through this trip that grows and develops with the places we go and people we meet along the way. These two months happen to coincide with the Jewish holiday season, so we are celebrating from the road. While holidays are very specific with everything from the customs, down to the date and minute, our trip is the opposite. We are usually in a new city each day, jumping from place to place, which makes coordinating holidays into our busy schedule, far from simple. Israelis have a different way of being religious. But here in America, we have every kind of Jew. Jews fitting into each of the general religious divisions, and then those picking and choosing between whatever suits their beliefs and lifestyles. Before we began BFF, the organizers assured my mom and I that we would be celebrating all of the Jewish holidays. For Rosh Hashana, my Israeli team thought that the holiday was over after the first dinner. According to my tradition and beliefs, I still had another two days to spend in shul. Last year, I remember going with my family to our Chabad in Santa Monica. We each chose a live chicken to say a blessing over, before the ritualistic beheading of it- leading to vegetarian Miriam for the following six months. With moving all of the time through our busy speaking and biking tour, we have had a different pre-Yom Kippur schedule. Last night was our final night in New Jersey, so I split from the group to see my sister. Tonight I am writing this from quite a different location. As we were hit with a rainstorm today, we had to change the bike route, and we ended up in Princeton, NJ, without a place to stay. After going through our list of local contacts without any luck, we pulled up in front of a church to stop and figure out our plan. We decided to go inside to inquire about a place to stay. After speaking to them and being sent to another three churches, the fourth one welcomed us in with open arms! This is one of my jobs on the team- making things happen. The shortest and the youngest, but it usually seems to work. I even got a nickname: Yom Kippur in Philly! While our usual days may not seem so religious, Yom Kippur will be. The biking will be replaced with a day of rest and atonement. We will all be fasting together. Because even with our different levels of belief, from opposite sides of the world, we all share the same heritage and tradition. Even if we live by a jumbled schedule, similar to the Jews wandering from place to place in the desert, our mission is to bike and spread our positive message. But for Yom Kippur, together we stop and observe. Together we take the lessons of our past and look towards a brighter future. So wherever you are spending Yom Kippur, wherever you are coming from, and wherever you are going, we wish you an easy and meaningful fast. Keep an open positive mind. Remember it is the journey that is more important than the destination. Each person has the chance to become better.
