Writing Your Dissertation Acknowledgement: Personal Gratitude Most of your thesis or dissertation will contain technical, scientific, and heady language, but your dissertation acknowledgement will probably contain the exact opposite. Acknowledgements for papers are typically found before the first chapter and should be very easy for you to write. Even though you can write your dissertation acknowledgement in a short amount of time, you should make sure that your writing style remains heartfelt and pure; you should avoid coming across as smug or arrogant. Though you can include several names in your acknowledgements, you should only include names of people who actually did help you during your dissertation or thesis journey because of limited space and reader patience. In general, you should keep your acknowledgements on one full, double-spaced page of the same font type and size that you are using throughout the rest of your paper. Acknowledgements that are much longer than this will wear on your professional readers and review board, and the last thing you want to do is annoy the people to whom you will be defending your paper. Below you will find more information about whom you can include when you write acknowledgements for your dissertation or thesis.

Personal Acknowledgements Before you even begin writing your dissertation acknowledgement, take time to make a list of people who are linked to your dissertation or thesis in any way. These people may have read or edited your paper or may have encouraged you or listened to your academic woes. In terms of family or friends to include, only list people who were active in your graduate studies. However, if there were people who inspired your work, do not forget to include these people on your list of names. For example, you might want to include a grandfather whom you never met but who was the first member of your family to graduate from high school or college, maybe even under less than ideal circumstances. When you mention these people in your acknowledgements, remember to state specifically how they helped you. This will mean a lot to these people, and they will be grateful that you remembered exactly what they did for you along the way.

Professional Acknowledgements Take a look back at your list of contributors, and be sure to mention the members of academia who helped you complete your dissertation or thesis. Again, you only have room for major contributors, not your freshman biology professor. Professionals to include could be advisors, upper-level professors, lab assistants, librarians, colleagues, or classmates. Anyone who assisted you in researching, conducting experiments and surveys, or writing could be a candidate for you to include in your dissertation acknowledgement. For academic contributors whom you choose to mention in your acknowledgements, you should use their full names and titles. However, if you are mentioning friends, you might consider only using first names to protect their identities. If several people within a large group assisted you, you only need to state the group name.

Patrick on In certain instances a debt will prescribe after 3 years, and will then become unenforceable against you. In your situation however, the debt has not prescribed for the simple reason that you have actually been making monthly payment in terms of the acknowledgement of debt to the individual which he was still alive. The second question is whether or not the estate is allowed to continue holding you to the acknowledgement of debt. Basically, can the estate claim the outstanding balance from you, and if so, are they limited in terms of the acknowledgement of debt? The general rule in our law is that the estate takes over ALL claims that the individual had prior to their death, and that the estate is entitled to claim from third parties whatever the individual was entitled to claim while the individual was alive. This means that the estate is still entitled to hold you liable for the outstanding balance of the amount owing. The further question is whether the estate must collect the amount owing in terms of the acknowledgement of debt, or whether the estate is entitled to demand from you the full outstanding balance now " in one payment. In my opinion the estate would be bound by the terms of the acknowledgement of debt. If the acknowledgement of debt makes provision for the full capital amount to become due and owing on certain conditions, and one of those conditions is if you breach the acknowledgement of debt, or another condition is if either party dies, then that condition would have become fulfilled and the full debt would be due and owing. Also furniture from a store, etc, etc If however the acknowledgement of debt does not make that provision, then you would be entitled to continue discharging your liability by way of monthly payments of R50 to the estate. There would be no problem in you writing to the executors to explain this, and also if you were to confirm the debt owing, and that you are intending to make payments in terms of the acknowledgement of debt. Perhaps you should also suggest to the executors to write off the debt, on condition that you pay the estate a certain amount now. You say to the executors: You should also remember that interest will only run against a debt due to the estate IF it was part of the original agreement that interest would run.
