This demonstrated the intellectually radical critical potential of the Gothic. My second research monograph, *Victorian Demons: The book examines how medicine at the time became increasingly implicated within a language of degeneracy that it was ostensibly meant to diagnostically police.* My most recent monograph, *Gothic death The Ghosts of World War One.* The first two volumes have been published.
