Light Reflectance Value is commonly used by companies selling paint to help customers identify paint colors. The above image is from the Benjamin Moore Paint color system. Paint companies often have cards on display which provide values for numerous colors that can be selected to identify the required type of paint. Similarly, graphic designing and even generic image editing application often provide LRV values to pick a color to insert in the project. LRV is also included at the back of paint chips and boxes to provide accurate information regarding the paint inside the box and to help professional painters to determine the color that they may require. It is worth mentioning here that light, color and texture are inter linked. For example, it can decrease and make the room appear darker than it was before. Similarly, matt surfaces are known for absorbing light and therefore, they give out a deep, dark look, unlike glossy reflective surfaces. If you want to make a room appear larger, then you should use light and glossy colors. If you are painting a kitchen or a dining room, then it might be a good idea to use darker colors, with heavier textures and perhaps a matt finish. This will make the room appear cozier. Make sure that the selected dark colors are low light reflectance darker colors. If you find a room too flat in appearance, after painting it with a matt finish, then you can paint the top with a glaze. This will increase light reflectance of your walls. When selecting colors for painting your house or office walls, it is also necessary to consider the life of the paint that is being applied on the walls. Colors which have a higher level of light reflectance value normally last longer. One example of a color with a high reflectance value is white. On the contrary, darker colors with low light reflectance have a shorter life. However, lighter colors also reflect some of the harmful light from the sun, whereas, darker colors have the quality of absorbing light. When it comes to semi-transparent surfaces, Light reflectance values are hard to determine. This is because light that moves through such a surface is absorbed and reflected by the timber that lies below it. Even a stain that may be applied over a pine can have a very high reflectance value, as compared to stains on darker timber. This is the reason where is no standard value available for colors of wood stains. Color consultants and graphic designers require analyzing information regarding Light Reflectance Values in different stages. This is particularly true for large business organizations. When designing the buildings for such corporations, LSV plays an important role. Value is an important term used in color and it speaks strictly to the lightness or darkness of a color. Light Reflectance Value LRV is the total quantity of visible and useable light reflected by a surface in all directions and at all wavelengths when illuminated by a light source. British Standard BS An absolute black or perfectly reflecting white does not exist in our everyday terms. Many examples can be found in the workplace. Careful planning for proper visual ergonomics is paramount in color design. From individual work surfaces to the outside walkways, ramps, hand-railings and everything in between. From a sustainability point of view, a wall color with a higher LRV supports lighting plans by helping to propagate daylight deep into the space. Thereby reducing the standard number of lighting fixtures required to enable employees to efficiently and safely perform their tasks. Most important for the do-it-yourselfer is to refer to color specifications for exterior products. For example, vinyl siding. Painting vinyl siding with a color that has too low of an LRV, that absorbs too much light and energy and thus retains too much heat, could result in warped siding. Some paint manufacturers have developed special formulations for painting heat-sensitive exterior surfaces. They offer diverse color choices. However, if you do not use one of those specially formulated products, you are limited to a paint color that is within the same LRV range as the original color. Else you risk warping and voiding any warranties. LRV provides a reference as to how light or dark a color could look and feel once up on all the walls. Fifty percent LRV is the common guideline for residential interiors. Thus, an interior lighting plan that accounts for the darker paint color should be a priority. When sampling paint colors, paying attention to Light Reflectance Values as you try different hues, tints, tones, and shades create benchmarks that can assist you in arriving at color selections quickly and efficiently. LRV refers to the percentage of light reflected by the paint color regardless of how much light is present. The LRV number is a measurement, a piece of data and is one of the few things about a color that is a consistent factor.
