Iceland [edit] The first Icelandic census took place in , following upon the first Danish census of " Further censuses were carried out in , and The exercise was the first census ever to cover all inhabitants of an entire country, mentioning the name, age, and social position of each individual. All of the information still exists, although some of the original documents have been lost. All those born in Iceland, and all new residents, are automatically registered. Individuals are identified in the registry by means of a national identification number the so-called kennitala , a number composed of the date of birth in the format ddmmyy and four additional digits, the third of which is a control digit, and the last of which indicates the century in which the person was born 9 for the s and 0 for the s. The National Registry doubles as an electoral register. Likewise, all bank accounts are linked to the national identification of the owner companies and institutions all have their own identification numbers.

Census of India The decennial census of India is the primary source of information about the demographic characteristics of the population of India. The census is one of the largest censuses in the history of mankind. First regular census was started in by Lord Ripon. Since then, a population census has been carried out every 10 years. The latest census commenced on May 1, It will create a National Population Register with photographs and fingerprints of every resident. The act gives Central Government many powers like to notify a date for Census, power to ask for the services of any citizen for census work. The law makes it compulsory for every citizen to answer the census questions truthfully. The Act provides penalties for giving false answers or not giving answers at all to the census questionnaire. One of the most important provisions of law is the guarantee for the maintenance of secrecy of the information collected at the census of each individual. The census records are not open to inspection and also not admissible in evidence. The census is conducted in two phases: The census is carried out by the canvassing method. In this method, each household is visited and the information is collected by specially trained enumerator. They collect data related to households e. In the second phase, total population is counted and statistics related to individuals are collected. Before that, a non-overall census was already conducted in After that census was done irregularly. The first census after independence was , followed by Since it is conducted regularly every 10 years. In between, there is also economical census every 10 years, five years after population census and agricultural census three years after population census. The last census was held on May Demographics of Iran The Statistical Center of Iran carried out nationwide population and housing censuses every 10 years, the last of which occurred in AP. So far there have been six incidences of population census in Iran in the years , , , , , and Since census in Iran is carried out once every 5 years. According to the British government in Iraq, the population estimate in was 3 million. In , the General Directorate of Population carried out the census, the population estimate was 2,, Later, There were another 8 censuses in the years , , , , , and the last one that was carried out in After the War of Iraq , there was a plan for a new population and housing census. Data was collected and published in Central Statistical Organization website. Census of Ireland Population censuses covering all of Ireland were conducted every ten years from to inclusive. The first census following independence was conducted in and done every ten years until Since then, most censuses have been conducted every five years from to with two exceptions. Instead of censuses in and , they were instead conducted in and respectively. The next census is scheduled for All original census returns from onwards survive, together with some 19th century fragments. The census was cancelled as a cost-saving measure, but a supplementary census was held in after it became apparent that the s had seen major demographic changes. The last five were in , , , , and From the census will be done every year, using a sample of population to correct databases that ISTAT create from registry offices and other public offices.

Two major historic events important to the development of the country will take place at the Yaounde Hilton tomorrow. Members of the National Census Council will meet in their sixth session to finalize the results of the third Population and Housing Census and clear the way for the second event, the official proclamation of the census results. The proclamation of the results will certainly break the long silence that had almost led to the complete dashing of hopes in the population. But as experts in the sector say, the delay in the proclamation of the results may not necessarily affect negatively, the credibility of the census. Organized from 11 to 30 November, , the third Population and Housing Census took place in response to the exigency of endowing the country with a human capital of good value in harmony with available and accessible resources. Government in this light took the engagement to put in place policies and strategies on poverty reduction in order to enhance social development. In this light, the set objective of the Third Population and Housing Census was to contribute to the development of the country and reduce poverty by improving demographic and social knowledge of the country as well as the relationship between the population and development and using the results therein in the conception, formulation, implementation and evaluation of policy strategy, sector by sector and national programmes set by the government. In effect, the major question on every mind anytime a population and housing census is organized is; of what purpose is the exercise? According to the National Office for Population and Housing Census BUCREP , who piloted the head count, results of population census enable the government to know the number of people in the country at a specific moment. The Third Population and Housing Census in this light provides figures on the population of Cameroon as at November, The head count equally makes known the population distribution of the country within the administrative units, the composition and characteristics of the population; the number of women, men, children, adults, aged, women of delivery age, foreigners, scholars, workers, etc. The third Population and Housing Census was organized in three main phases in a bid to arrive at reliable results. Pre-census, Census, and Post Census. Each phase was pregnant with activities geared at achieving a defined objective. The first phase consisted in organizing meetings with stakeholders, carrying out cartographic work, organizing pilot head count, and sensitizing the population. The second phase was the head count proper characterized by the mobilization of huge resources to enable a smooth exercise. The post census set out to test the results obtained on the field to ensure that the exercise has been well executed. Considering the importance of this phase, experts were sent to the ten provinces regions between November, and January, as well as in the cities of Yaounde and Douala to carry out the survey. This was then followed by the analysis of the facts gathered, validation of the results and thematic analysis thereof. The results are expected to be published in six main volumes to ease understanding. These include the general report of the census, the thematic analysis, national demographic situation, statistics, monographic regional studies and urban socio-demographic studies.
