In collaboration with their local government and community partners, schools can take steps to plan for these potential emergencies through the creation of a school Emergency Operations Plan. Below are programs and resources that will assist school administrations to develop their emergency plans. California Child Care Disaster Plan: It provides guidance for communication and coordination of key state agencies in the event of a disaster that affects the child care infrastructure. Crisis Response Box Program: This guide is designed to help every school assemble the tools and resources needed for a critical incident response at a school. These guidelines developed by the CA Emergency Medical Services Authority provide recommended procedures for school staff in responding to medical emergencies when the school nurse is not available and until emergency medical services responders arrive on scene.
