The horn section rides along smoothly in comparison, cresting and dipping deftly as Waits sings vigorously, wounds exposed. Meanwhile, the keyboard line bounces happily along. That the words are set to his impossibly lovely melodies just makes it harder to hear. Father gambles, drinks, runs around. She begs him to repent. Mother gets sick, prays, dies. Finally, father gets religion. With their Appalachian twin harmony, it is the sorrow of the mountains distilled. Winner for most upsetting lyric is hands-down: Both the lyrics and the music are simple, but its repetitive rhythm, steady beat and basic rhyme scheme just make it more relatable. Vedder sings the final chorus with renewed agony and then hums a hymnal-like, wordless tune before the instruments and Vedder both fade into silence. Over his claw-hammer finger picking, Earle lists a litany of afflictions—poverty, alcoholism, loneliness, klutziness, and lost youth and love—throughout a third person narrative. But in the bridge, Earle shifts the perspective to that of the omniscient narrator. Over a cartoon toy cowgirl getting left under a bed. After a final tour the following year, the Grammy-winning country singer, TV host and actor recorded a farewell song for a the documentary Glen Campbell: The father of eight children from four wives, Campbell has been married to Kim Woolen for more than three decades. In her dying days, Sadako therefore worked on folding her own 1,000 cranes, but passed away having only completed 1,000. The remaining cranes were finished by friends and family, and the poor young victim of WWII was ultimately buried with them. In its place was one of the most depressing-sounding—and artistically brilliant—albums in recent memory. Jules and Andrews traded the original pulsating synths for a stark, arpeggiated piano line and soft mellotron swells that arguable better emphasize the brooding lyrics of alienation. But in the chorus, Jules manages to laugh in spite of his dreams of death. Written by Marijohn Wilkin and Danny Dill in 1968, the song tells the tale of a man wrongfully hanged for a murder because his alibi happens to be married to his best

friend. Rather than betray his love and ruin a marriage, he carries the secret to his grave, leaving his lover in a state of constant mourning. A relationship full of resentment, as the bedroom has turned cold and all his failings have been exposed, is something to mourn, and everything about this song super-charges that mopey feeling. Or the song from the perspective of a crooked cop trying to hide his kickback money from his young son to not lose his respect. Or the song about the evil small-town mayor who tricks his illegitimate son into hooking up with his half-sister. Harry Chapin is not kind to the characters in his songs. Its power resides in its slowly stately build up with shuffling drums, a sly bit of marimba, and those weightless strings wafting through it all. Stranded in the middle of this musical swirl stands Orbison, bleeding with emotion as he recounts all the reasons that his shattered heart is never going to heal and his tear-stained cheeks will never dry. This is a song that more people should know, but that no one else should ever attempt to cover. Cohen has a way of invoking deep spiritual longing with Biblical references that turn extremely personal, and Buckley had a way of drenching it all in tremulous emotion. The combination is transcendent. With his deep, hang-dog voice, Stephen Merritt can no longer imagine that the sun would even bother to shine on a world where his love is gone. *The Man Comes Around*, in November His wife, June Carter Cash , died six months later—followed four months after by Cash himself. The robin, the whippoorwill, the midnight train—they all mourn with him to meet his quavering drawl, the imagery paralleling the sonic atmosphere. When the narrator looks at the body of the girl he loves after she finally succumbs to cancer, he thinks for a moment that he sees her breathing. Then he sings about God: And the only conclusion is a chorus of angels whose weeping turns into something like joy as a triumphant trumpet kicks in. There are so many details that lead to my inevitable goosebumps: Because the characters seem so real, so does the sorrow.

This can be frightening to guys who are often afraid of calling something a relationship, before they are really sure what it is. Time and communication are going to be your two best friends in this situation. Tasha brings us the next new relationship question: What should you do when you fall hard for someone and in a really short time? Infatuation is the emotional feeling of romantic love. It feels like love. It acts like love. But it does not pass an important test: There is nothing wrong with being infatuated, most relationships start there. Get to know him as a friend, and let him get to know you. You will be able to make a better decision about whether or not to get more involved with him at that point. In this case, let your head tell you how to act, as opposed to your emotions.

You can have the marriage that you have always dreamed of! Whether your marriage is currently the best it has ever been, or it is in need of repair, the Ethridges suggest that these principles will improve your relationship. Even for troubled marriages, it will take work, but it is possible to breathe new life into a relationship that has grown listless. Often, when the flames of love are growing dim at home women tend to blame their husbands for becoming cold and distant. Perhaps, says author and counselor Shannon Ethridge, women share part of the blame when their husbands pull away from them emotionally. It is not that love has died between them; it is just that the husband has shut down emotionally because of how his wife treats him. Recognizing these patterns can help wives figure out what steps to take to reignite the passion in their relationship. Your husband cannot meet all of your emotional needs. Many times, the authors say, a husband will pull away from his wife because she puts too many demands on him to meet all of her needs. Shannon and Greg, who have been married for 16 years, experienced this in their own marriage. After seven years of marriage, Shannon was extremely unhappy. As is often the case in marriages, she was placing a huge burden on her husband. Too many times, she says, women expect their husbands to first figure out what all of their needs are, and then meet them on their own. She encourages other women to do the same. Your husband has emotional needs that are just as important as your own needs. It is also important, the couple says, to realize that women are not the only ones with emotional needs. Men have many important needs as well. Often, when women feel that their husbands are not meeting their needs, they can become hurtful and unkind toward him. This approach makes most husbands pull away because they do not feel respected, a significant emotional need for men. This was one source of the contention in her own marriage, she says. Greater than their need for respect, or even for sex, is their need to see their wives be happy. I think that we owe it to our men to figure out what makes us happy. Your husband was designed by God to be the leader of your family. Scripture teaches that the husband is the spiritual head of the home, but our culture often takes a different view. The Ethridges cite a popular television program as an illustration of this way of thinking. It is very disrespectful to men most of the time. The Ethridges say many women have contacted them asking similar questions. She says after she and Greg recognized this pattern in their own relationship, they discovered that many couples share the same dynamic in their marriages. Taking a step back and letting their men lead the family takes humility, Shannon says, but it is one step that greatly improved her marriage. Most men truly want to make their marriages work. One thing that the Ethridges say they learned in writing the book is that men are often more committed to their marriages that women believe. The culture would lead women to believe that men do not care about their marriages. In fact, the authors heard from many men who expressed a desire to do whatever it took to save their marriage. They want to keep their family together. They want to do the right thing. Shannon and Greg say they have put these principles to work in their own marriage and have seen drastic results over the years. By sharing their insights, they hope to help other couples experience positive change as well. When both spouses are working together to help the other feel loved, there is no limit to how close the two can be. Want more secrets for a successful marriage?

Michael Bradley Prayer Secret 1 “ establishing a good, personal, intimate relationship with God the Father will now get you into the door with Him. It will get you to the point where God will now listen and consider each of your prayer requests. Prayer Secret 2 is the next step when approaching God with a specific prayer request. This one seems to be so easy to grasp, but many Christians keep violating this basic common sense principle. Prayer Secret 2 is making sure that your prayer request always lines up with the will of God for your life. I have a pet saying when it comes to this principle. God knows what all of your future will hold for you “ you do not! Too many Christians are constantly asking God for things that He does not really want them to have. Here is the main Scripture verse where this basic revelation is being given to us by the Lord: And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him. If it is not, then the above verse is implying that He will not hear your prayer, and thus will not grant the prayer request. This is where each Christian has to really get a grip on any specific prayer requests they are presenting to God. If God comes back letting you know that what you are asking for is not in His perfect will for you and your life, then you have to let it go, trust that God knows best, and move on. When you approach God the Father with a specific prayer request “ this is very serious business. You are asking God to bring something to you that normally would not be coming your way. You are asking God to supernaturally bring or allow this request to come your way through Him. So the first thing you have to do before approaching God with your specific prayer request is to make sure that your prayer request is in His perfect will for you and your life. There are several ways you can do this. You do not even need to pray about whether or not it will be in His will for you and your life. The answer is already obvious and you can go ahead and shoot your prayer through. A good example would be is that maybe you have just lost your job. You will now have to go to God and ask Him to lead you to the next new job He will want you to have. You already know this request will be in His perfect will for your life because you now need a new job to survive and put food on the table. This is quite obvious, and you can now go ahead and start pressing in and praying to God that He lead you to the next new job that He will want you to have. Maybe you are dating someone and you would really like to marry this person. However, God has not voiced His opinion on the issue yet. The way to properly handle this is to go to God and ask for His perfect will on the situation “ whether or not you should marry this person. If you really love this person and really want to marry them, the best way to word your prayer is to tell God you would really like to marry this person, but you will only marry this person only if it will be in His perfect will for you to do so. This way you are on safe ground with God in the way that you have worded the request. You have voiced your opinion on the matter, but you have also let Him know that He knows better than you do as to who you should be marrying in this life, and that you will not marry this person unless it will be in His perfect will for you to do so. The Holy Spirit The other way to approach this is to simply ask the Holy Spirit if you should be approaching God the Father with the specific prayer request. I believe that the Holy Spirit knows most, if not all of the time, whether or not God will answer your specific prayer request. For those of you who have established a good inside connection with the Holy Spirit, the above is rather easy to do. For those of you who have not yet established this kind of inner connection with the Holy Spirit, you can still go ahead and ask Him, and He will somehow get through to you as to whether or not you should be praying to God on a particular issue. Now here are 3 short powerful stories that will really illustrate the importance of making sure that all of your prayer requests always line up with the perfect will of God for your life. One of her girlfriends had been dating a man for about two years. Everything was going great. She got to the point where she was now wanting to marry the man. She went before God and started praying, asking God if she should marry him. God came back with no further answers every time she asked. He started to physically abuse her. The beatings got so bad that she had no other alternative but to divorce the man for fear he was going to end up killing her. I have found from personal experience that whenever God is silent on a specific prayer request, this means to

hold your position and do nothing until you receive further word from Him as to whether or not you should move in the direction that you are looking to move into. Another one of my friends was dating a man for about 1 year. She too started asking God if she should marry him. She got no answer from God for at least 3 months. Again, she got impatient waiting for God to answer her. She went ahead and married the man without any leading from the Holy Spirit to do so, and no confirming activity from the Lord that she should marry the man. One year into the marriage, she found out that her husband had been having an affair behind her back with one of his secretaries during the entire year that they had been married! They were divorced shortly thereafter. Do you see what happens when you go against the perfect will of God on a specific request? Total death can result. They were both praying for marriages that obviously were not in the perfect will of God for their lives. This is why I say God always knows best. God knew the one man had a dark side that was going to emerge once he married the girl. He knew the other man would not stay faithful once he got married to the second girl. Neither girl could have known these things were going to occur. But God does know all these things and what our futures will hold for us – and this is why your prayer requests have always got to be within His perfect will for your life or the consequences could be disastrous like they were in these two stories! About 20 years ago, I was dating a girl for about one year when she got diagnosed with cancer. She immediately started chemo and the rest of the appropriate cancer treatments. I took her to see Joyce Meyer for a healing, along with some of the other ministers in our area who were supposed to have the gift of healing operating through their ministries. None of the ministers were able to bring any type of healing to my girlfriend. I then started to try and pray myself to see if I could get God to heal her. I will never forget what happened when I did. I initially ignored the shield and continued to try and pray through to God for this request. As I started praying the appropriate words, I saw my words travel about two feet in front of my mouth and then drop straight to the ground. I then felt the Holy Spirit start to literally pull back on my words as I was trying to release them to God. There was no anointing on my words. I had no wind at my back from the Holy Spirit to be approaching God with this specific request. I was really straining in trying to get my words to reach God the Father. After about the 5th or 6th time when trying to pray to God for her healing, I immediately stopped and asked God if I should even bother to continue to pray on this issue due to the resistance I seemed to be picking up from the Holy Spirit. I then received an immediate answer. I was given a strong knowing that God did not want to heal her and that it was His perfect will that she be brought home to Him – and if I continued to try and pray for this healing against His will, that I would just be expending useless energy. He made it loud and clear that His mind was already made up on the issue and that I was to let it go. He then conveyed to me as to why He was not going to consider healing her. Long story short, my girlfriend was 40 years old when she came down with the cancer. The doctors told her that if she did not quit smoking, that she would end up in a wheelchair and on an oxygen tent on a permanent basis. For whatever reason, she would not quit smoking and she continued to smoke for another 8 years. The emphysema was starting to break into the next level and she still would not quit. She then broke out with the cancer. God made it very clear to me that He gave her 8 years to clean up her act, to heed the warnings from the doctors and to quit smoking. Our bodies are a direct gift from God, and He expects all of us to do the best we can with them – especially in the area of taking proper care of them. When she refused to take proper care of her body by giving up smoking, God decided He was not going to heal her and that she would have to be brought home much earlier than He would have really liked. I believe to this day that had my girlfriend quit smoking 8 years before coming down with this cancer, that there would have been a very good chance that God would have healed her of the cancer. But because she did not take proper care of her body, God had no natural desire to want to heal her when this emergency presented itself. And God gave her plenty of time to get her act together before this cancer hit – 8 years! I did not tell my girlfriend what I felt God had conveyed to me. I did not want to cause her to lose hope in the event I had not properly heard from God on this issue. She tried several other healing ministries, along with continuing all of the cancer treatments, but nothing worked. She died one year later after getting diagnosed with the cancer. As you can see from the above three stories, you can save yourself a lot of blood, sweat, and tears when praying to God if you can pick it up ahead of time whether or not your specific prayer requests should be brought before Him for His consideration. This is the beauty of the ministry of the Holy Spirit. One of His jobs is to

help us in our prayer life with God the Father. The Holy Spirit will always know whether or not God will want to answer our specific prayer request. By connecting up with the Holy Spirit on a specific prayer request, you will go a long way in being able to decide when to approach God in prayer and when not to. For those of you who have not got this far in your own personal relationship with the Holy Spirit in order to be able to pick Him up and read His movements, you can still approach both Him and God the Father before you attempt to pray and just simply ask God if it will be in His perfect will that a specific prayer request be put before Him. I have found that God will always come through loud and clear on this issue. Remember, God wants to establish a loving personal relationship with you â€” and in this personal relationship will be the benefit of being able to approach Him with your specific prayer requests. God really wants to show you how to play the prayer game with Him.
