

### 1: Are You More Likely to Remember Stuff You See or Stuff You Hear? | HuffPost

*You see, visual images tend to have more things we instantly associate with them -- for example, a picture of some horses on a farm, instantly calls up images of hay, riding, a barn, a cowboy, etc.*

At the end of this post, there are two experiments for you to test your own memory to determine which information you are better at recalling: A few nights ago -- around 8: I was stuck in highway traffic and about eight miles or so from where I live. If, at that moment, you had asked me how long it would take me to get from where I was to where I live, I would have said about 15 or 20 minutes. It turns out the brain stores various types of information differently. Think about it like this. Remember when someone told you their phone number and before you could say it a few times over in your head or write it down, you got briefly distracted by something The memory of the phone number is GONE! So, it turns out the brain stores audio information in one way -- think of it as a more temporary way -- and it stores visual information in an entirely different way. A way that will make the memory easier to recall.
