In this verse we have the word "spirit" being used in the nostrils which is actually the Greek word, "Pneuma" which means Air or Breath. The connection between the breath of life and nostrils is undeniable. One more point I want to make regarding James 2: James is not talking about the Holy Spirit in this verse. He is making a clear comparison. He is merely saying; just as a body without the ability to breath air is dead in reality, so is the faith of the person who has no works dead in spirituality. Both the carnal and spiritual are being used here to illustrate a point. His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish. All three speak of the "spirit" or the "breath" in the same manner. If you really think about it, Death is creation in reverse! The body goes back to the earth, the breath goes back to the Lord. For thousands of years, humans have sought the key to immortality, and while we may be a bit away still, there are all sorts of possible options to escape death: After the birth was completed, doctors told her that the child she had delivered was stillborn, and Bouter and her husband were sent home with a death certificate for the child. The baby had been seen by obstetricians, gynecologists, and even a neonatologist, and all of them reached the conclusion that she was dead. But when they opened the drawer, the baby began crying, and they realized their daughter was alive. The girl was named Luz Miraglos Miracles of Light and the latest reports say that she has grown stronger and healthier. He was playing on the frozen ice and fell through as he tried to grab the body of a dead squirrel. When he was pulled from the river, he was clinically dead: He was taken to the hospital where doctors revived him using a heart-lung bypass machine, which warmed his body, forced out water and pumped in air. The explanation behind this story is that Alvaro was struggling for a few minutes before he actually submerged, which authorities said allowed his body to cool down and reduce its need for oxygen. After four days in the hospital, he was able to communicate by blinking, and he was released after 17 days in total. For a while, he had limited use of his limbs, requiring braces to walk. But he eventually regained full use of them and appears to have no lasting brain damage. After a few minutes, he managed to bring the man back to life. Twenty-one hours later, the dead man woke up and started screaming. Understandably, this freaked out the morgue staff, who thought that the man was a ghost. Terrified, the owner, Ayanda Maqolo, called the police and waited until they arrived to enter the morgue. Maqolo said that he felt safer having firearms there, in case whatever was screaming wanted to fight them. After the undead man was taken out of the fridge, he was sent to a nearby hospital before being discharged. He was placed in a body bag that was reportedly airtight for three hours, and a wake was held for the family later that day. His aunt was visiting the body when she said he started to move, at which point he sat up in his coffin in front of the whole family, and asked his dad for a drink of water. The family thought they were getting another chance with the boy, but unfortunately, he immediately lay back down and died again. He was rushed to hospital, but was pronounced dead for a second time. While some claim it was a hoax, you have to wonder who would suggest such a thing and somehow get the whole family to play along. In the meantime, his wife was informed of her loss and asked to identify his body. The examiners in the morgue were just gearing up for an autopsy on Camejo with an incision to his chin when they realized something was wrong: They began to stitch it up, at which point Camejo woke up, later saying it was because the pain was unbearable. Not long after he woke up, his wife arrived to identify his body and was overjoyed to find her supposedly dead husband alive. Her husband Nathan, a teacher at the same school, called , saying she was having a seizure. Coworkers began CPR and used a defibrillator in an attempt to restart her heart. Emergency personnel arrived and took Erica to the hospital, where doctors stopped CPR in order to deliver the child by C-section. She was kept in a medically induced coma for five days, and it was discovered that she suffers from a heart condition known as hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, which requires her to have a pacemaker. They have not gone onto the next level, the light, heaven, whatever you choose to call it. They remain behind, here on earth, and they account for many ghost sightings and haunted places. The reasons for this are varied. Some are complicated and unique to that spirit and others are simple to understand and relate to. I will discuss a few of the most common reasons that a spirit remains earthbound. Some spirits remain at or near the site of their death, especially if it was sudden and unexpected. These spirits remain in the area and try to make contact with anyone that passes by that is sensitive to spirits. This type of spirit can be found almost anywhere a death has occurred. Sometimes a spirit realizes that it is dead and that life continues beyond that. They do not go to the light for reasons such as the fear that their existence will end, fear of the unknown, fear of going to hell or being judged for past deeds. These spirits are bound here because of their own fears. Other spirits stay behind to take care of unfinished business. It may be to make sure their finances and their loved ones are ok or to pass along one final message. Often these earthbound spirits do not remain here for long, once they can complete their goal, they normally pass over. If the deed that they are attempting to finish is complicated they will often contact the living to assist them. In many cases the living are unsure of what the spirit wants and it adds to the length of the time the spirit spends here. Almost anything that a spirit feels compelled to do before it goes to the light can make it remain here until it feels comfortable with how they have left things. Guilt can also be a reason for a spirit being stuck here. They may feel like they have left the family or loved ones too soon and uncared for. This is also the main reason why suicide victims and other spirits whose death was caused by their actions alcoholics, drug overdose, etc remain behind. They feel guilty over taking their life or contributing to their death. The living can also hold a spirit here. By not letting go of them, they can be bound here by our love and unable or unwilling to go on until the living can come to terms with the loss. This happens when people go beyond the normal grieving process and become obsessed with the deceased person. They feel that they left things unsaid, undone, etc. This keeps the spirit from going over many times simply because it does not want us to feel this way or be that upset. There are many other reasons that a spirit can remain earthbound, I have just touched on a few of the most commonly encountered ones here.

A loved person or friend is always with you. There is no real reason why. You just remember them forever. If thinking about a dead loved one makes you sad try and pick out the things that were good while they were around. Say if its a grandparent and they were say 95 when they died. They probably died of old age so its no ones fault. Whatever happens, how they die or any circumstances. In my experience I just call out to my departed one, or I quietly whisper when around people, just as I would have if I were with them in life. If you are sensitive you can "feel them" like a pressure changing in a room, as if they would have walked in when alive. Keep in mind that with some of our departed they have "moved on" to what ever is next for them. For example when my 80 year old grandparents passed I felt as if they had gone away on a long trip. I would say "I love you, I miss you" but truly felt like I was speaking to myself. I was happy and at peace and glad they were together and had lived long lives. I never dream of them. My mother however was young and died tragically At times she comes to me in dreams. Other times I can hear her voice, smell her skin or feel a static electricity around me that even subconsciously she is first in my mind. I would advise against doing any "spirit boards" or occult like things even dabbling can open a world you would never intentionally bring into your life. Balance and logic are key, all things within reasonable limits, not obsessive. You will have all answers and see all people soon enough. If you are so busy looking and listening for your dead, how can you live your life and keep your eye on your God. What does it mean to dream of a dead loved one? What does it mean when you dream of a loved one that is dead? Dreams of the deceased are very common and natural during themourning period, and may continue throughout life. While grieving, such dreams can be painful, but enable the unconscious mind to accept the reality and permanence of loss. Through the years, such dreams may occur around holidays, anniversaries, or when other circumstances bring memories of the loved one into consciousness. It could happen during a sound and quiet sleeping. What does it mean when you dream about dead loved ones? Dreaming of dead loved ones is a natural part of the grieving process. ### 7: Why Do Some Spirits Stay Earthbound?

*Some people even believe that the dead can come back as spirits to visit the living. So they set out food for the dead. But people who do that do not really believe what God says about the dead.*

There are at least 25 Bible texts that tell us that death is a sleep, and that when a person is dead, he remains in the grave and he has no thoughts. He is in a state of lack of consciousness. He is not in heaven nor hell. He is in the grave and knows nothing. Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might, for in the grave, where you are going, there is neither working nor planning nor knowledge nor wisdom. No one remembers You when he is dead. Who praises You from the grave? When their breath departs, they return to the ground; on that very day, their thoughts perish. For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will become as gods, knowing good and evil. The Bible compares death to sleep over 50 times. This is the essence of creation. The soul is not a separate entity from the body. Breath ceases, the body returns to dust and the thoughts the essence of a living soul perish. They are now in the graves. And I will come to get you and take you where I am. They must have been "judged" already on an individual basis at the moment they died. But that is not Biblical see previous text. What was their understanding about where Lazarus was in death and when he would be resurrected? That would be cruel! The word immortal means NOT subject to death. When we die, we sleep in the grave until we are resurrected. The righteous dead will be resurrected when Jesus comes. Those who died without knowing Jesus will be resurrected for the Judgment after the Millennium.

Commonly Asked Questions Regarding Death What about these few texts that are used to support the doctrine of "immortality of the Soul", meaning that when you die, you are still really alive, just in a different form - a "spirit" form? A What does Paul mean by the expression "absent from the body, and present with the Lord" 2 Cor. In light of these texts written by Paul, we must seek to understand what he means by "absent from the body, and present with the Lord. He is not saying that his spirit has left his body and is "wafting" over to the Colossians. For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that has done this deed. This, obviously, is an expression that Paul used often. For we know that if our earthly house physical body of this tabernacle tent were destroyed, we have a building of God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven. If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked. For we that are in this tabernacle tent do groan, being burdened; not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life. Now he that has prepared us for this very thing is God, who also has given unto us the earnest down payment of the spirit. Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, while we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord: For we walk by faith, not by sight: We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord. There are THREE conditions in this passage 1 Clothed with a temporary earthly body denoted by the term "tabernacle" 2 Clothed with our permanent celestial body denoted by the term "house from heaven" vs 2 3 Unclothed - naked vs 3 , an intermediate condition, which is not desirable which could well mean the state of death, a state of sleep, unconsciousness, awaiting the resurrection. But if I live in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labor; yet what I shall choose, I know not. For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better: The apostle is clear. At the Second Coming of Jesus, the righteous dead are resurrected to receive their eternal reward See 1 Thess. I have finished my course, I have kept the faith. Paul looked forward to his crown of righteousness which he would get when Jesus comes. Death, indeed, was gain for Paul. It meant freedom from the pain of a weary body, deliverance from the bondage of a Roman prison, and security from the temptation of Satan. Also, Paul had, during his ministry, been beaten repeatedly, he had been stoned, imprisoned, shipwrecked and constantly hounded by the Jews who were plotting to kill him. Death would be a sweet relief, a sleep with no conscious passage of time for him. The next event he would experience after closing his eyes in the sleep of death would be to arise at the resurrection and "depart and be with Christ. Everything else Paul wrote would deny that interpretation. C The parable of the rich man and Lazarus. In this parable, the rich man goes immediately to hell and Lazarus goes to heaven. How does one

explain this parable if the dead are sleeping. It is important to note that this is a parable. It is the fifth in a series of five parts of a parable beginning with the parable of the lost sheep, Luke Remember, verses and chapters were added hundreds of years AFTER the Bible was written, and they were designated by uninspired translators, not by inspired Bible writers. The five parts of this parable are: Each part of the parable is designed to teach a different aspect of the same theme. Two groups of individuals are the objects of this 5 part parable. On one hand are the Pharisaic aristocrats. On the other hand are the "tribute collectors and sinners", downtrodden and despised, the objects of contempt and loathing from the Pharisees. In the first part of the parable, the "tribute collector and sinner" are the principal subjects. In the second, the sinner alone is seen. The fourth section parallels the second inasmuch as there the Pharisaic class is also seen by itself without any reference to their group. As the lost piece of silver demonstrated the utter helplessness of the sinner, so in the case of the Unjust Steward, the true character of the Pharisee is vividly portrayed. The third and fifth sections of the parable group together both of the classes mentioned, and bring to a climax the great disparity which existed between them. Jesus was using stories familiar to many in His audience. They were stories, parables, illustrations only. The story of the Rich man and Lazarus demonstrates clearly that it is a story only, and not fact. People do not actually have conversations between heaven and hell. Abraham must have had a very large bosom to contain all the individuals who go there. Do people from heaven actually visit people in hell? How could a finger tip, dipped in water, cool the tongue of a person who was being tormented in the middle of a fire? D What does Rev 6: According to Heb This passage communicates that God has not forgotten His faithful martyrs through the centuries. Their blood symbolically cries out for God to bring justice upon their persecutors and to reward the faithful ones with eternity. E Is the soul immortal? The word immortal means - not subject to death. The Bible plainly states "The soul that sinneth, it shall die. But the Bible says "It is impossible for God to lie. If dead people go immediately to heaven in spirit form, why would God call it an abomination for our dead relatives to come back in spirit form and talk to us? Because our dead relatives are in the grave. And these "spirits" are demons masquerading in the form of dead loved ones. These beings are appearing to Christians in the form of their dead relatives. They can then tell Christians all sorts of falsehoods about heaven, God and other doctrines, and these Christians will believe it because they think it is coming from their dead loved ones whom they trust. What does this say about the Mary apparitions? It is a demon impersonating her. H What does Peter mean when he talks about Christ preaching to the "spirits in prison" 1 Peter 3: In order to understand this text, we must read the entire passage 1 Peter 3: Verse 18 reveals that Jesus, the divine Son of God who was crucified for our sins, was "made alive" through the power of the Holy Spirit. Verse 19 makes a transition and declares that it was by this same Holy Spirit that Christ spoke to the spirits in prison.
