Does Music Affect Your Mood? Researchers have pondered the possible therapeutic and mood boosting benefits of music for centuries. Conversely, the study found that for some people, sad music can cause negative feelings of profound grief. The research involved three surveys of more than 2, people in the United Kingdom and Finland, focusing on the emotions and memorable experiences associated with listening to sad songs. The majority of experiences reported by participants were positive. He also said the study may help find reasons for both listening to and avoiding sad music. An earlier study, published in the Journal of Consumer Research , found that people tend to prefer sad music when they are experiencing a deep interpersonal loss, like the end of a relationship. The authors of that study suggested that sad music provides a substitute for the lost relationship. Other research has focused on the joy upbeat music can bring. A study in the Journal of Positive Psychology found that people who listened to upbeat music could improve their moods and boost their happiness in just two weeks. In the study, participants were instructed to try to improve their mood, but they only succeeded when they listened to the upbeat music of Copland as opposed to the sadder tunes of Stravinsky. And a happier mood brings benefits beyond feeling good. In a press release , lead study author, Yuna Ferguson, noted that happiness has been linked to better physical health, higher income, and greater relationship satisfaction. Music as therapy This music research aligns with the larger arena of music therapy. The American Music Therapy Association AMTA reports that music therapy programs can be designed to achieve goals such as managing stress, enhancing memory, and alleviating pain. It might seem surprising that music can help people cope with physical pain, but research has shown a clear link. A review in The Lancet found that people who listened to music before, during, or after surgery experienced less pain and anxiety, compared to patients who did not listen to music. To conduct the study, researchers looked at data from 73 different trials, involving more than 7, patients. The people who experienced a slightly greater, but nonsignificant, reduction in pain, and needed the least pain medication, were the ones who got to pick their own music. When it comes to treating chronic conditions, music therapy can also play a powerful role. After reviewing 25 trials, the researchers concluded that music is a valid therapy to potentially reduce depression and anxiety, as well as to improve mood, self-esteem, and quality of life. They also noted that no negative side effects were reported in any of the trials, making music a low-risk treatment. Barry Goldstein, a recording artist who has studied the vibrational effects of music for more than 25 years, says music has a profound impact on the brain. In a column for Conscious Lifestyle magazine, Goldstein wrote that music can actually enhance brain functions. He said music can evoke emotion, help regain memories, stimulate new neural connections, and active attention. Boosting moods While listening to music may bring greater health benefits, creating it can be an effective therapy, too. A unique orchestra for people with dementia helped improve their mood and boost their self-confidence, according to researchers at the Bournemouth University Dementia Institute BUDI in Dorset, U. The orchestra is one of several BUDI research projects that aims to demonstrate how people with dementia can still learn new skills and have fun. Eight people with dementia and seven caregivers participated in the project, along with students and professional musicians. She said that the orchestra has been a life-enhancing project for everyone involved, and that the project challenges the negative public perceptions of people diagnosed with dementia. History[change change source] Musicians think of the Baroque period as starting around The famous Renaissance composers Palestrina and Lassus had died a few years earlier. Claudio Monteverdi wrote some music in Renaissance style, and other music in Baroque style. Opera was being invented. It was a time of musical change. The change from writing music in the Baroque style to the Classical style was much more gradual. The Baroque was a time when people liked large spaces and a lot of ornamentation. This can be seen in the architecture of famous buildings such as St. They were built at this time. In Venice there were churches with galleries on either side of the church. Composers liked to write music for two groups of musicians placed in opposite galleries. Giovanni Gabrieli wrote a lot of music like this. Styles and instruments[change change source] The idea of two contrasting groups was used a lot in Baroque music. These were pieces for orchestra and a solo instrument. Sometimes a concerto contrasted a group of soloists with the rest of the orchestra. These are called by the Italian name " Concerti Grossi. Organs , and some harpsichords , had at least two manuals keyboards. The player could change from one manual to the other, contrasting two different sounds. Baroque music was often a melody with a bass line at the bottom. This could be, for example, a singer and a cello. There was also a harpsichord or organ that played the bass line as well, and made up chords in between. Often the composer did not bother to write out all the chords harmonies but just showed some of the chords by figures, leaving it to the performer to decide exactly which notes to play. The soloist, who played or sang the melody on top, often put in lots of ornamental notes. Because composers were now writing opera it was important for the audience to hear the words clearly. In the Renaissance the groups of a choir were often singing several different words using different melodies all at once. Polyphony was widely used in instrumental music, but was not used in opera, which needed to tell a story without being confusing. When a soloist in an opera sings a song an aria the aria is in a particular mood. Each movement in a concerto also had one particular mood. Music from later periods is different. Haydn in the Classical Period would often change its mood during a piece. Suite[change change source] The Baroque suite is a collection of dance movements written in the style of Baroque music. There is an accepted standard order in which the dances are performed. Many times a composer would add a Prelude before all the dances. Sometimes a composer would add another piece in between the Sarabande and the Gigue. There are many exceptions to the standard order, but the order of Prelude, Allemande, Courante, Sarabande, Other, and Gigue is most common.
