During this time we had also been preparing ourselves for my father-in-law to move in with us, as he was recovering from a stroke. The first night he had returned to our home, we read the last chapter and he looked at the book for a time by himself. Three days later he had a massive brain hemorrhage. In the panic of the moment I started to fear for how we would explain to our daughter about her grandpa. You know what to say. The next night, our daughter had asked where Grandpa was. We were able to have that conversation with her because all three of us shared a common knowledge of Heaven. Thank you for passing on these truths in this format. We know exactly where he is! My youngest son passed away almost eight months ago in a drowning accident. He was two months shy of his fourth birthday. We read one chapter a night together before bed. After each chapter, my boys would ask me to read more. I stuck with only one chapter a night so we could just talk about our memories of their little brother—the fun times, the silliness, his antics and just how much we miss him. We would end the night by praying together and thanking God for giving us time with him and how, through the shed blood of Jesus Christ, we will spend eternity all together—forever—never to be separated again. If you know anyone that is grieving the death of a friend or family member, this book is excellent—not only for children but for adults as well. I highly recommend this book and reading it together as a family! I rushed over to show the many fathers in our Bible study here and they were at a loss for words to show their gratitude. Now they can take them to visiting and read to their children. These are wondrous books. I just had to have it. And then I did the unthinkable—after we read the first chapter aloud, I told her we would continue tomorrow with the second chapter. She is a voracious reader and you would have thought I suggested some type of torture when I closed the book. We both loved the book. Randy has included material that young and old will appreciate. I liked breaking it into chapters to read because it gave us time to process before moving on with the story. It is truly wonderful. Meanwhile we groan, longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, because when we are clothed, we will not be found naked. For while we are in this tent, we groan and are burdened, because we do not wish to be unclothed but to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life. We know that, when He appears, we shall be like Him, because we shall see Him just as He is. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ, who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body. In fact, a neighbor recently offered my wife to become his queen when he becomes a god in his own kingdom. The only thing she had to do was to be baptized in the Mormon church. She declined the offer. For they all had her. For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven. This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. To him who overcomes, to him I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, and a new name written on the stone which no one knows but he who receives it. The sound I heard was like that of harpists playing their harps. Each one had a harp and they were holding golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. They held harps given them by God and sang the song of Moses the servant of God and the song of the Lamb: Just and true are your ways, King of the ages. On the day that you were created They were prepared. You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked in the midst of the stones of fire. And I have destroyed you, O covering cherub, From the midst of the stones of fire. I cast you to the ground; I put you before kings, That they may see you. Therefore I have brought fire from the midst of you; It has consumed you, And I have turned you to ashes on the earth In the

eyes of all who see you. His tail swept a third of the stars out of the sky and flung them to the earth And there was war in heaven. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon, and the dragon and his angels fought back. But he was not strong enough, and they lost their place in heaven. The great dragon was hurled down--that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who leads the whole world astray. He was hurled to the earth, and his angels with him. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings. I say this because you claim that I drive out demons by Beelzebub. Now if I drive out demons by Beelzebub, by whom do your followers drive them out? So then, they will be your judges. But if I drive out demons by the finger of God, then the kingdom of God has come to you. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever. Therefore, they are before the throne of God and serve him day and night in his temple; and he who sits on the throne will spread his tent over them. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven. You have come to God, the judge of all men, to the spirits of righteous men made perfect, to Jesus the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire. For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us. Do not be deceived: Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor male prostitutes nor homosexual offenders nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death. This is the second death, the lake of fire. As for you, let that abide in you which you heard from the beginning. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, you also will abide in the Son and in the Father. However, as Papa explains from the Bible what heaven is all about, Jake begins to understand that life in heaven is going to be so much better than life here on earth. Given all the recent discussions of how much a kid can learn and should know about Jesus, his crucifixion, and other biblical truths, I was afraid that this book was going to be a disappointment even though it is authored by Randy Alcorn. The central theme of the book is that heaven and earth will pass away and God will replace them with a New Heaven and New Earth. Papa quotes scripture heavily especially Rev. The story is very believable and at one point, I began wondering if this was a rehearsal for Randy Alcorn as he may have this discussion with his grandsons. The story line is pretty forthright and does not dance around the issues. Nowhere does Papa state something as truth if it is not based in the Bible. At one point, he corrects Jake and says that he is to always pray to Jesus and not Grammy. It is subtle, but significant in that many young children are told to pray to their loved one. However, that is not in the Bible and therefore, Papa Alcorn explicitly says that this should not happen. The greatest aspect of this book is that the gospel message is presented clearly and concisely in the story itself. However, at the end of the book is a page devoted to the Roman Road along with a brief explanation of the gospel. It is very clear that the goal of this book is to be used as a tool for evangelizing children and perhaps the adult reading to the child as well as explaining what awaits them in the life to come. If there is a negative to be found in this book, it is of no significant value. There are some assumptions made that I do not personally agree with, but nothing that causes any concern. For example, in a discussion about pets and animals in heaven, Papa tells Jake that he thought Moses the dog would be in heaven because animals were in Eden. Conclusion In asking my pastor and some other men in the church I attend about how much their children know about heaven, they said not much. I admit that I have not told my son much about heaven, either. That is, until now. It explains the doctrine of heaven in a way that a child can understand and a parent can be interested in. The book is solidly rooted in the Scriptures. The conversational tone makes for a good story time book to be read at night, as part of family worship, or during story hour at church or a daycare. I would also highly recommend this book for a young child grieving the loss of a grandparent or parent. It would be a great resource for those who council children after the death of a loved one. This book is worth owning multiple copies of to give away during these times.
