Apostasy in the church and false doctrines of men By Don Koenig The reason for this article Most of the major Christian denominations have deviated from biblical Christianity in one way or another. It is not the purpose of this article to point a finger at any one group, or to tell true Christians to get out of their denomination or not to fellowship. I understand that this article will not win me any popularity contest but very few others are talking about the apostasy in the church institutions identified with Christianity and the false doctrines of men within these church institutions that now deviate from true biblical Christianity. The one true Church of God is a spiritual body and it is interwoven in all Christian denominations. I have noticed in my own experiences that there is at least a small core of true believers in just about every church in every denomination. That certainly does not mean that the doctrine of certain denominations actually leads people to Christian salvation - many teach a different gospel than what the Bible teaches. I have at one time in my life been part of all the major groups listed below and I have first hand knowledge of what they practice except the Orthodox Catholics. My purpose is to expose the darkness so that the true light of the gospel of Christ will shine. Who is a Christian? There are over 2. Jesus said you can not enter the kingdom of heaven unless you are born of the Spirit. The new birth from the Holy Spirit occurs when a person truly believes that Jesus is the son of God and trusts in the finished work of Jesus on the cross to atone for their own sins and to justify them before God. The scriptures say you are saved by faith, not by your own works, lest anyone should boast. We cannot judge if a person who identifies with Christianity is really trusting in Christ or in their religion to save them. If they are trusting in their religion to save them they are no more part of the body of Christ than a Jew or Moslem or any other religion. Withholding information knowing that full disclosure will have negative consequences. Deflecting blame to another person to prevent personal embarrassment or responsibility. Attracting someone with an exciting offer only to divert them to an inferior deal. We just have a natural talent for it, that blossoms automatically when we are really young. Just after we learn to talk, we learn to lie. In fact, that skill, which begins so early in our life, was never allowed to fully develop in me. The Kingdom Code This particular section of the handbook is about The Kingdom Code, the rules we ought to follow as citizens of the kingdom. The reason we follow the rules is because we are already in the kingdom and we trust God to tell us the truth. We also need to honor God with our thoughts, our motives and our attitudes—the inner things only God can know about us. Jesus talks about anger, sexual desire, divorce, lying, revenge, and hatred. In each case, he calls us, his followers, to commit ourselves not just to obeying the external requirements of the law, but also to allowing the Kingdom Code to govern our thoughts, our motives and our attitudes. Last week, we talked about divorce. Just as he did with the previous subjects, Jesus begins with what his followers already knew about telling the truth from the Old Testament. The story of the Old Testament is full of examples—oaths are mentioned almost times! But the law picks up the practice and talks about the significance of making an oath. The OT teaches that a person following God, an honest person, will fulfill their promises. You will be able to rely on him doing what he said he would do. But not everyone tells the truth. But if they swear that they will do it, that usually means something more to us. At least they seem to know that they are making a promise. Stick a needle in my eye. They are intended to demonstrate honesty. In fact, when there were no witnesses to a crime, testimony under oath was to be accepted as true testimony even though no one else could corroborate it. The owner is to accept this, and no restitution is required. When no human witness can validate our words, an oath involves an appeal to some supernatural witness: An oath is the promise someone makes when he swears. But both swearing and cursing were originally meant to validate: Swearing an oath does so by invoking a greater witness. Cursing does so by invoking dire consequences. The second time, he denies it with an oath. The third time, he calls down curses on himself and swears to them. Both swearing and cursing are used in the Bible and used by God! I am the LORD. Often, God was called as a witness to an oath. In fact, this is what the third of the ten commandments is talking about: But the intention of the OT was not that words under oath are the only words that are binding! The intention was that it is wrong to lie under oath, just as it is wrong to lie at any time. Does this absolutely forbid taking an oath? Jesus puts himself under an oath Matthew The point of the OT was to say that because we should fulfill our oaths because we should always be honest. The Pharisees interpreted it to mean that ONLY when you made an oath did you have to tell the truth, and even then, it only had to be a certain kind of oath. That is not at all what God meant. Trustworthiness depends on integrity. Let your "Yes" be yes, and your "No," no, or you will be condemned. Giving an oath matters, Because not all words are true. Anyone is at liberty to use this lesson for educational purposes only, with credit.

Basic rules[ edit ] Although there have been some variations in the rules over the years including the addition of a secondary game in some versions , certain basic aspects have remained consistent throughout all versions of To Tell the Truth. Three challengers are introduced, all claiming to be the central character. The announcer typically asks the challengers, who stand side by side, "What is your name, please? The panelists are each given a period of time to question the challengers. Questions are directed to the challengers by number Number One, Number Two and Number Three , with the central character sworn to give truthful answers, and the impostors permitted to lie and pretend to be the central character. After questioning is complete, each member of the panel votes on which of the challengers they believe to be the central character, either by writing the number on a card or holding up a card with the number of their choice, without consulting the other panelists. Any panelist who knows one of the challengers or has another unfair advantage is required to recuse or disqualify himself or herself which, for scoring purposes, is counted as a "wrong vote. Occasionally, the central character would be asked to do something else related to their story instead of standing up. The two impostors then reveal their real names and their actual occupations. Prize money is awarded and divided among all three of the challengers, based on the number of "wrong" votes the impostors draw. The existence of an audience ticket for a taping indicates that the show originated in color at the CBS Broadcast Center in late Cass and Carlisle stayed on as panelists for most subsequent editions. On the pilot and the prime-time run, three games were played per episode. GSN repeated that episode decades later the Game Show Network The prime-time show ended on May 22, , with the daytime show ending on September 6, From to , the show switched to a Bob Cobert -penned theme with a beat similar to "Peter Pan", and then to a Score Productions tune during its final CBS daytime season. Most episodes of the original nighttime run of the series were preserved on black-and-white kinescope , along with a few color videotape episodes. Many daytime episodes including some in color from to exist, including the color finale. Reruns of the black-and-white kinescopes were running on the Buzzr channel as of late April The show was first released to local stations on September 8, A total of 1, episodes of this version were produced, with the series ending on September 7, Some markets that added the series after its release opted to carry the show for another season or two in order to catch up on the episodes that had not aired in their viewing area. To host the revival series, Goodson and Todman made a call to original host Bud Collyer. Although he had retired from television a few

years earlier following the cancellation of his eponymous TV show, Moore decided the time was right to return and he accepted the offer to host the new series. Many regulars from the original run appeared, including Tom Poston and Bert Convy. In late 1970, during the eighth season, Moore was diagnosed with throat cancer [8] and left for the remainder of the season to deal with his illness. As he had done numerous times before, Bill Cullen became his replacement. Garagiola stated that he was "pinch-hitting" for Moore, who returned to the series for a farewell performance on the ninth-season premiere in 1971. To Tell the Truth ended production at the end of the season. Johnny Olson stayed with To Tell the Truth when it moved to syndication. To Tell the Truth used three distinctive sets throughout its nine-year syndicated run. The first, designed by Theodore Cooper and dubbed by some as the "psychedelic" set, was used for the first two seasons and the first four weeks of the third; with one man on the door. The third—and longest-lived—set, which Cooper also designed, was a blue-hued, gold-accented, block-motif set. This set was used for the remainder of the run. The theme was written and composed by Score Productions chief Robert A. The bulk of this version is intact. However, the current status of the first season is unknown, and is presumed to be lost to wiping. GSN has never rerun the first season of the show, and had always begun with the second season. Buzzr began airing episodes from in October 1999. A new theme and set were commissioned for this edition of Truth. Even though previous regulars Bill Cullen, Peggy Cass, and Kitty Carlisle made frequent appearances, there was no regular panel for this edition. The new Truth aired for one season in syndication, but it never recaptured the popularity of the original, and aired its final episode on June 12, 1999, with reruns airing until September 1999. No consolation prize was given if the entire panel correctly identified the subject. After the second game, a new game called "One on One" was played with the four impostors from earlier. One fact had been purposely withheld from the panel about one of the impostors and it was up to the panelists to determine correctly to which of the impostors it applied. The edition of To Tell the Truth was a rarity in that it was still based in New York while nearly all television game show production had moved to California. Millionaire continued to tape in New York until 1999. All episodes of this series exist and have aired on GSN in reruns. The chair next to that was occupied by rotating guests, although voice actress Dana Hill appeared in the seat most often. The third chair most often featured David Niven Jr. Polly Bergen and Peggy Cass, who began appearing on the original series, would appear from time to time, and other frequent panelists included Vicki Lawrence, Cindy Adams, and Betty White. The panelists were introduced in twos, with the male panelists escorting the female panelists down the staircase, followed by the host. Two games were played with two sets of impostors. After the second game, a new version of the "One on One" game from the series was played. A seventh civilian player was brought out with two stories, and a member of the studio audience was given an opportunity to win money by trying to figure out which of the two stories was true. Occasionally, celebrities whose faces were not well known would attempt to stump the audience during this part of the game. For example, Hank Ketcham, the creator of Dennis the Menace and a challenger on the original To Tell the Truth in May 1971, tried during one episode to convince an audience member that he was really the songwriter to "Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer" Johnny Marks had actually done this, but was unsuccessful in doing so. Gary Stockdale supplied the music for this edition. Actor Meshach Taylor was the only regular to appear on every episode of this edition, while Paula Poundstone was a regular during the first season. Kitty Carlisle appeared as a panelist for one episode in the first season, making her the only panelist to have appeared on all incarnations of this show to that point. This edition of To Tell the Truth brought back the audience vote that the original series had last used. A tie in the audience vote or panel disqualification counted as a wrong vote, as they had in previous

versions. It was cancelled on January 28, 1966, only 96 episodes into its second season. However, repeats continued to air through March 15, 1966. The first season featured three regular panelists: Episodes lasted 60 minutes rather than 30 minutes. The questioning period was not split distinctly among the panelists, and Anderson and Bowman occasionally participated in the questioning. Once in each episode, the two impostors from a round participated in "Before You Go," a second round in which one was the central character and the other was again an impostor. On August 4, 1966, ABC announced it had renewed the show for a second season. The house band and regular panelists was eliminated although Rose still made occasional appearances ; Bowman still appeared on each episode. Also starting with this episode, Anderson took over announcing duties and the set was given some updates. ABC announced that the show would air on Sundays in its fall schedule, but later delayed the show to the summer schedule. Two former hosts had appeared on the same run of that series as panelists.
