On April 1, when jokesters, pranksters and April fools of the day tricked family and friends with carefully constructed misdeeds, in the Central American nation of Costa Rica, Epsy Alejandra Campbell Barr was elected the very, first of her race to win the second-most sought after seat in government. However, the date also marked Easter, the Christian celebration of a resurrection recorded in the Bible as a catalyst to transformation, spiritual reconciliation and atonement. An even bigger concession was that a Black, woman – liberal candidate Campbell-Barr won by a landslide to serve with Carlos Alvarado no relation , president-elect and strong supporter of same-sex marriage and LGBT rights whipped him despite his right-wing preaching and championing the cause of conservatism. The loser promised to maintain a status quo with regard to any reforms that would empower the homosexual community there. He allegedly also feuded with the electoral tribunal, which scolded him for failing to submit financial declarations properly. It was a divisive and bitter contest and Campbell-Barr and Alvarado ran on a platform promising unity, rebuilding of infrastructure, and parity of the sexes. On the fabled day – this year which marked levity and holiness – news of the election of the vice-president overshadowed that of the youngest elected president ever in its year history as a Democratic nation, another aspect which must have been a sobering reality to the loser. At age 38, the next leader offers radical changes, the most obvious, a female, Afro-Costa Rican vice president. Her election sounded like an alarm around the world because in the process of winning she blazed a trail for her gender and birth land becoming the first ever of her race to win the position on the continent. Many more will wake up to her arrival on May 8 when Campbell- Barr is sworn in as the first person of African descent to serve as Costa Rica vice-president. Her historic election made headlines throughout Latin America. The pioneering milestone also resonated with Jamaicans who have claimed the winner a daughter of the land of wood and water which the Caribbean island is acclaimed. She is the fourth child of a family of five daughters and two sons. She married at a young age and became a mother when she was just starting her university studies. She now has two daughters, Narda and Tanisha. Reportedly, she lived in the Caribbean for 10 years, but returned to San Jose, where she graduated as an economist from the Latin University of Costa Rica in Reportedly she has always been active in her community and served in the legislature between and before running for vice-president in While making that bid, Campbell-Barr led a grassroots approach to help her campaign travelling in a recreational vehicle RV around the country to get her anti-corruption and accountability message out to voters. She is a researcher and activist for the rights of women and people of African descent, and entered politics because she wanted to become a social activist. The year-old champion has published books and articles on economic participation, democracy, sexism, racism and people of African descent. Campbell-Barr attended the Democratic National Convention in Charlotte, North Carolina and makes no bones about being a fan of her role model – she has maintained that her political influence was empowered by former President Barack Obama. Stop destroying carbon and nitrogen sinks. Rebuild sinks on a mass scale. This will require a revolution of civilization. Most important, pressing, and direct, it requires that with all possible speed humanity must abolish industrial agriculture the worst emitter and by far the worst destroyer of sinks and undertake the global deployment of agroecology: The great rebuilders of sinks and the only way to produce sufficient and abundant food without extreme energy consumption; therefore the only way possible if humanity wants to continue to eat. The solar industry already employs more people than coal mining and wind energy is cheaper than coal power in many U.S. Still, we need more. Big companies like Apple and Google are setting great examples, committing to percent renewable energy and making record-breaking investments in wind and solar. And across the country, everyday Americans are joining the energy revolution by through projects like community solar. But then my laughter turns to coldness. The solution to the evils being wrought by corporate rule, climate chaos just one of these, is to double down on corporate rule and leave everything exactly the same, including the ravages of industrial agriculture. Is there a lower vileness than this kind of lie? And am I the only one sick of it? Meanwhile the cult fantasy of replacing the extreme energy consumption afforded by fossil fuels with industrial-scale renewable energy is simply idiotic and malign. Physically and economically, industrial-scale wind or solar always depends upon the regular fossil fuel foundation. How could industrial-scale renewable energy support itself without massive use of fossil fuels? Indeed, almost none seem capable even of understanding the question. So much for the ecological grace of renewables. Culturally, politically, economically, an industrial-scale renewables buildout is supposed to replace fossil fuels in powering what would otherwise be the same corporate globalization regime. Is that what you think of when you think of restoring our harmony and balance as part of the Earth? On the contrary, here we have ExxonMobil-style rioters and looters, promising to continue with all the political and spiritual evils of the corporate dominion. And in fact this kind of reform is impossible. The fact is that anyone who would want a high-consumption grid based on CSP and industrial wind megafarms never would care sincerely about replacing fossil fuels in the first place, only about supplementing them. If the primary imperative value is to feed the gluttonous consumption maw, then climate change and other environmental crises cannot stand as equally important. By contrast, if averting the worst of the crises is primary, then the notion of maximizing energy production would automatically cease to be a goal in itself. On the contrary, it would be recognized as the ultimate cause of the crises. At the bottom the e-mail signs off with this flourish: For an excellent history see E. This lie exposes the typical gatekeeper function of this typical system NGO, whose goal, much like that of the EPA itself, is to ensure that thought and action remain imprisoned within the bounds of corporate domination, including acquiescence in all the worst extremes of climate chaos, poisonism, and every other environmental catastrophe. All this is hard-wired into the corporate project, and system regulators and NGOs have the mission of ensuring that no one breaks free of faith in the normativity of this project. Of course they still have a constituency. All too many people want to co-exist with the Poisoners, fantasizing about something like the EPA as a watchdog and enforcer. The EPA does the job it was designed to do, assist the corporations while running propaganda interference and fooling people into thinking such a watchdog and enforcer can co-exist with corporate rule. Getting rid of false ideas about regulators is a necessary first step toward building the necessary abolitionist consciousness. It should go without saying that poisonism and climate chaos comprise one crisis, one criminal campaign driven by the same corporate and government
