Nandi – Some Puranas describe Nandi or Nandikeshvara as bull-faced, with a human body that resembles that of Shiva in proportion and aspect. Selkie – A creature that a seal becomes a human by shedding its skin on land. Werecat – A creature that is part cat , part human, or switches from between the two. Peryton – A deer with the wings of a bird. Winged Cat – A cat with the wings of a bird. Winged Lion – A lion with the wings of a bird. Winged Unicorn – A unicorn with the wings of a bird. Criosphinx – A Sphinx that has the head of a ram. Gajamina – A creature with the head of an elephant and body of a fish. Gajasimha – A creature that has the head of an elephant and the body of a lion. Griffin – A creature that has the front quarters of an eagle and the hind quarters of a lion. Gye-lyong – A creature with the head of a chicken and the body of a dragon. Hieracosphinx – A type of Sphinx that had a falcon head. Hippocampus or Hippocamp – A Greek mythological creature that is half-horse half- fish. Hippogriff – A creature that has the front quarters of an eagle and hind quarters of a horse. Kelpie - A creature that is half horse half fish. Krampus – A half goat half demon who punishes bad children during Christmas. Longma – A winged horse with dragon scales. Merlion – A creature with the head of a lion and the body of a fish. Ophiotaurus – A creature that is half- bull half- serpent. Sea-goat – A creature that is half- goat half-fish. Identified with the constellation Capricornus. Used in Roman imperial coinage. Serpopard – A creature that is part snake and part African leopard. Shug Monkey – A creature that is part monkey and part dog. Skvader – A Swedish creature that has the forequarters and hind-legs of a hare and the back, wings and tail of a female wood grouse. Three kinds of animal parts[ edit ] Ammit – An Egyptian creature that has the head of a crocodile , the front legs of a lion , and the back legs and hindquarters of a hippopotamus. Chimera – A Greek mythology creature that has the head and front legs of a lion , the head and back legs of a goat , and the head of a snake for a tail. Sharabha – A Hindu mythological creature deity having the head of a lion, the legs of deer, and the wings of bird. Simurgh – A griffin-like exclusively-female creature of Persian mythology with the head of a dog and the claws of a lion although sometimes with a human face. Four kinds of animal parts[ edit ] Enfield – A Heraldic creature with the head of a fox , the forelegs and sometimes wings of an eagle , the body of a lion , and the tail of a wolf. Hatsadiling – A mythical creature with the head and body of a lion , trunk and tusks of an elephant , the comb of a cock , and the wings of a bird. Questing Beast – A creature that has the head and tail of a serpent , the feet of a deer , the body of a lion , and the haunches of a leopard. Tarasque – A French dragon with the head of a lion , six short legs similar to that of bear legs, the body of a ox , the shell of a turtle , and a scorpion stinger-tipped tail. Wolpertinger – A creature that has the head of a rabbit , the antlers of a deer , and the legs and wings of a bird. Yali – A Hindu creature that has head of a lion , the tusks of an elephant , the body of a cat , and the tail of a serpent. Ypotryll – A Heraldic

creature with the tusked head of a boar , the humped body of a camel , the legs and hooves of an ox or goat , and the tail of a snake. Five or more kinds of animal parts[ edit ] Navagunjara, has limb representing eight animals, including a human hand. Alebrije â€” A brightly colored creature from Mexican folk art and mythology. Baku â€” A Japanese creature that has the head of an elephant , the eyes of a rhinoceros , the legs of a tiger , the body of a bear and the tail of an ox. Calygreyhound â€” A mythical creature that appears on Medieval heraldry. It is described as having the head of a wildcat , the torso of a deer or antelope , the claws of an eagle as its forefeet, ox hooves, antlers or horns on its head, the hind legs of a lion or ox and its tail like a lion or poodle. May sometimes be depicted with wings. Fenghuang â€” A Chinese creature that has the head of a golden pheasant , the body of a mandarin duck , the tail of a peacock , the legs of a crane , the mouth of a parrot and the wings of a swallow. Navagunjara â€” A Hindu creature with head of a rooster, neck of a peacock, back of a bull, tail as a serpent, three legs of an elephant, tiger and deer or horse, fourth limb being a human hand holding a lotus. The Japanese version is described as a deer-shaped dragon with the tail of an ox.

For most people the word Armageddon is thought to mean a great destructive battle between good and evil which will bring about the end of time or the end of the world. The Merriam Webster Dictionary: And it goes on to define more exactly where this location is: Now, in this article, we are going to explain some very key elements of this battle to show not only what the battle of Armageddon is, or where this battle is going to take place, but who the key players in this battle are, how it will affect the whole world--including you and me--and how we are at the brink of this great battle taking place right now, even as you read these words. To answer these questions, and many more, we refer again to the Bible. So the obvious questions to ask ourselves are: Will it actually take place and be confined to that small area on the map that we defined earlier as Armageddon? And finally, what does this mean for the people of the world, for you and for me? To answer these questions, we will first explain what the dragon, the beast and the false prophet are. Then it will be easy to see exactly who the three foul spirits are and how these come "issuing from" the mouths of these three. We will also tell you why the kings of the earth will go to battle and you will hopefully understand that Armageddon is about to happen so that you can prepare yourselves and those you love for this event. Daniel describes this dragon as a beast in chapter 7, verse 7: It was different from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns. John explains further that it has seven heads. This dragon started with the Bani-Umayyad which was the dynasty that took over and corrupted Islam after the death of Muhammad. The seven heads of this dragon were the seven countries or dominions that the Bani-Umayyad had power over. John says that the seven heads have diadems upon them. A diadem is a crown so this refers to the kings or rulers of these countries or dominions. The ten horns are symbolic of the ten Bani-Umayyad rulers beginning with Abu Sufian and ending with Marwan that ruled over these seven countries. It was these ten Ummayyad rulers who ascended from the bottomless pit [bottomless pit being the pit of error] to corrupt and destroy the Revelation that Muhammad had brought to the world. Thus fulfilling yet another prophecy which is found in the 11th chapter, verse 7 of the Book of Revelation as: The city of Mecca, even before Muhammad, had been a place of pilgrimage due to the fact that in this city was the Kaaba, a very ancient sanctuary, to which great numbers of people came to worship. It is the corrupt and apostate religion created by the Bani-Ummayed dynasty. Who then is the beast that is talked about? The beast is also clearly described and prophesied in both the book of Daniel and the book of Revelation. And four great beasts came up out of the sea, different from one another. Then as I looked its wings were plucked off, and it was lifted up from the ground and made to stand upon two feet like a man; and the mind of a man was given to it. And behold, another beast, a second one, like a bear. Daniel is describing three other beasts. People have wild imaginations. There are people who really do believe that at the time of the end there is going to be a beast rise up out of the sea that will actually look -or be- exactly like what Daniel describes here from his vision. But then there are a lot of people out there that believe there really is a Santa Claus, and a boogey-man. These people are living in a fantasy world. These animals that Daniel is describing are symbolic. Not some mutant monster created in Hollywood. Daniel is in fact, describing the four world powers that exist today! The lion with eagles wings is England. At one time England had been ruled by the Saxons, who had the lion as their symbol. At that time the lion became the symbol of England and has remained so even to this day. The eagles wings represent the United States who has the Eagle as its symbol. We all know that the United States was at one time a colony of England and that with the Declaration of Independence and the Revolutionary War that followed, the United States became separated from England. The bear symbolizes Russia. The leopard which Daniel sees in his vision symbolizes France. The leopard became the symbol of France when the Saxons and Franks were forced to become part of the Holy Roman Empire. Before the Saxons became united with the Franks their symbol had been the lion and the symbol of the Franks was the panther. In French the word for lion is leo and panther is pard. The word leopard is a contraction of the words Leo and pard. This beast of Daniel is the same beast that the apostle John describes in the Book of Revelation, verses 1 and two of the 13th chapter: And to it the dragon gave his power and his throne and great authority. John sees this beast, however, not as four separate beasts but as one beast. The reason that John sees the Beast as one is that these four world powers became united into a single beast in under the United Nations Charter when they formed the United Nations. This is prophesied in Revelation And authority was given it over every tribe and people and tongue and nation. These apostate religions are: These seven apostate religions are the seven heads which John describes in verse one as having a "blasphemous name. Each of these religions have fallen into the hands of a clergy class who has changed the religion so that all that is left is a religion that was created from their own vain imaginings and their own corrupt inclinations. And these man-made religions become veils that prevent the people from knowing what the true religion of God is. John also refers to these heads in the 17th Chapter of Revelation, verse The "five of whom have fallen" are those that took over and corrupted the Hindu, Buddhist, Jewish, Zoroastrian, and Islamic religions. These dynasties are no longer in existence. The "one is" that is revealed to John is the dynasty that took over and corrupted the Christian Faith. It started in the day of the Apostles. The lion denotes lordly dominion and rule; the bear suggests crushing force and tenacity of purpose; the leopard is distinguished for its swiftness and cruel blood thirstiness. These characteristics marked the Roman empire at the time of this vision, and this probably was the first fulfilment of the vision. The same qualities have, however, been exhibited at all times by the persecutors of the Church of God, and thus the application may be extended, and the vision represents as Alford says "not the Roman empire merely, but the aggregate of the empires of this world as opposed to Christ and his kingdom. The dragon and this beast are essentially one, since the latter wields all the influence of the former. Matthew Henry Commentary It was a frightful monster! It appears to mean that worldly, oppressing dominion, which for many ages, even from the times of the Babylonish captivity, had been hostile to the church. The source of its power was the dragon. It was set up by the devil, and supported by him. The world admired its power, policy and success. They paid honour and subjection to the devil and his instruments. It exercised infernal power and policy, requiring men to render that honour to creatures which belongs to God alone. Christ has a chosen remnant, redeemed by his blood, recorded in his book, sealed by his Spirit; and though the devil and antichrist may overcome the body, and take away the natural life, they cannot conquer the soul, nor prevail with true believers to forsake their Saviour, and join his enemies. Perseverance in the faith of the gospel and true worship of God, in this great hour of trial and temptation, which would deceive all but the elect, is the character of those registered in the book of life. This powerful motive and encouragement to constancy, is the great design of the whole Revelation.

We will consider here Biblical prophecy, in particular the new testament Book of Revelation, and the old testament Book of Daniel. The Book of Revelation has prophecies of future world events, in particular the rise to power of an evil dictator called the Beast or the Antichrist, he is in Revelation Chapter Note that the Antichrist is described in Revelation This would imply a Russia-China military alliance. And the "seat" may be referring to Russia geographically sitting on top of China. In chapter 7 of the Book of Daniel, Daniel saw a vision of 4 beasts rising out of the sea, representing future empires to come. The second beast was a bear with three ribs in its mouth. The third beast was a leopard with wings and 4 heads. The fourth beast had iron teeth and 10 horns, one of which was a man that spoke great things. These are believed to represent the Babylonian empire the lion, Medo-Persian empire the bear, and Greek empire of Alexander the leopard-- Alexander had the speed of a leopard during military conquest, and the Roman empire with iron teeth. It is also believed that the final empire may be talking about the Antichrist -- the man who speaks great things. Note that these beasts are combined into the horned beast of Revelation 13, which has the mouth of a lion, feet of a bear, the speed of a leopard, and 10 horns representing a confederation of 10 states. This could be Russia and the Commonwealth of Independent States, evolving into this angry beast. This may mean that there will be an increasingly close military alliance between Russia and China, because the beast gets its power from the dragon, which would be Red China. Note that Russia is selling some of its best military weapons to China, including ships, submarines, radar systems, and jet planes, and Russia is also selling nuclear power plants and missiles to Iran. It is interesting that a severe drought was drying up the River Euphrates in, this was the worst drought in Iraq in his century, and also Turkey is building dams upstream which could dry up this river, so this is another sign that Armageddon is approaching. SARS would be a demon coming out of the mouth of the dragon China, described in Revelation 16, where the dragon and the two beasts send out demons. His being born at Christmas is an indication of Mao being a type of evil Antichrist. Of the worst tyrants and murderers of the 20th century, only Stalin and Hitler can surpass Mao for evil. Mao being born at 28 degrees N we will relate to Revelation Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven.
