The development of new tourist facilities and related infrastructure in Cuba must, among other things, proceed in accordance with Cuban environmental laws and policies. Pursuant to that Law, the government adopted a number of decree laws and resolutions aimed at ensuring that future development including tourism development is sustainable. Of particular importance to tourism development is Decree Law , Coastal Zone Management, which establishes setbacks and other siting requirements for new facilities in coastal areas. house". These are typically single-family residences, and are a very popular choice for tourists. Prices can range from 15 to 30 euros per night or less for longer stays. The casas provide an inexpensive option for young or independent tourists. A stay in a private casa allows tourists more opportunity to mix with local Cubans, and engage in Cuban cultural life. Social impacts of tourism[edit] As tourism played an increasing role in the economy, a large percentage of young people migrate to resort towns seeking employment in the tourism industry. Thus, there is an economic and social divide emerging in Cuba between those employed in the tourist industry and others. Because of the rapid growth of tourism in Cuba, taxi drivers can earn more than lawyers and doctors. Between and , in order to gain the much-needed hard currency , some hotels and resorts were opened only to foreign tourists, leading to accusations of "tourism apartheid". The policy was reversed by the Cuban government in Those having access to dollars through contact with the lucrative tourist industry suddenly found themselves at a distinct financial advantage over professional, industrial and agricultural workers. This was not lost on the average Cuban citizen, and the government tourism policy soon began to be referred to as "enclave tourism" and "tourism apartheid". He described the moves as an economic necessity that would need to be maintained for as long as the country had a need for foreign currency. According to Castro, the government was "pondering formulas" that would allow Cubans to use some of the tourist facilities as a reward for outstanding work, but he believed that giving Cubans access to amenities at the expense of paying foreign tourists would ultimately be a counterproductive move for the economy. Police often demand identification checks of any Cubans seen in contact with tourists. However, access remains very limited in practice[citation needed], as the vast majority of Cubans do not have access to the hard currency needed to stay in such hotels.

All foreign visitors to Canada, however, must bring a valid passport from their home country. Once completed, an ETA lasts for five years or until you get a new passport. Applications can be done online, through the mail, or at an overseas Canadian consulate. It is illegal for anyone, from any country, to enter Canada to work or live without first obtaining a long-term visa, which are much more complicated to apply for, and take many months to be approved. Visitors who arrive by air cross the border at the Canadian airport. Crossing the Canadian Border Anyone entering Canada from a foreign country by land, sea, or air “including Canadians themselves “are required to have an interview with a Canadian border guard at their point of entry so it can be determined they are a safe and legal visitor. Exactly how long and invasive this interview will be depends very much on where you are coming from, why you want to visit, whether you have completed any authorizations you may need, and how clearly you communicate these facts. It pays to be honest, cooperative, and informed. Canada Border Services Agency It should be remembered that while foreigners enjoy various legal rights after they enter Canada see below , no foreigner has the right to get into Canada just because they want to. Canadian border guards have the power to deny anyone entry to Canada for any reason. Possessing a criminal record, a history of subversive political activity, dangerous diseases, suspicions of drug trafficking, or just broadly suspicious behavior are all common grounds for refusal of entry to Canada. In the years since the terrorist attacks of September 11, Canadian security forces have been extra vigilant about terrorist threats, particularly from the Islamic world. Would-be visitors from the Middle East or parts of Africa, or those with a history of visiting such places, may find themselves subject to increased scrutiny. These cards, which ask basic questions about the visitor and their trip, are usually handed out on airplanes or trains. Visitors who cross a land border usually have to just tell the information to the guard. Bringing Goods to Canada It is illegal for foreigners to bring products into Canada to sell without first going through the complex procedures for engaging in international commerce. The liquor limit is stricter: A few very specific things are likewise banned in Canada for safety reasons and are thus illegal to bring into the country, such as certain kinds of kites and baby products.
