The Cheves family name was found in the USA, the UK, Canada, and Scotland between and The most Cheves families were found in the USA in In there were 2 Cheves families living in South Carolina.

He had two brothers, Richard " and Librado, and two sisters, Rita and Vicki. His family owned a grocery store and a ranch, but their land was lost during the Great Depression. The Chavez family faced many hardships in California. The family would pick peas and lettuce in the winter, cherries and beans in the spring, corn and grapes in the summer, and cotton in the fall. Chavez dropped out to become a full-time migrant farm worker. Local growers were using braceros when domestic workers were available, in violation of the law. Chavez documented the practice, then organized sit-ins and a protest march to draw attention to the issue. When Filipino American farm workers initiated the Delano grape strike on September 8, , to protest for higher wages, Chavez eagerly supported them. Six months later, Chavez and the NFWA led a strike of California grape pickers on the historic farmworkers march from Delano to the California state capitol in Sacramento for similar goals. The UFW encouraged all Americans to boycott table grapes as a show of support. The strike lasted five years and attracted national attention. Chavez received support from labor leader Walter Reuther who, in December , marched with the striking grape pickers in Delano. At a packed union hall, Reuther declared, "This is not your strike, this is our strike! During the hearings, subcommittee member Robert F. Kennedy expressed his support for the striking workers. It is where Cesar Chavez began his day hunger strike on May 11, Coretta King met with Chavez in the hall during his fast. In the early s, the UFW organized strikes and boycotts "including the Salad Bowl strike , the largest farm worker strike in U. He again fasted to draw public attention. Chavez undertook a number of "spiritual fasts ", regarding the act as "a personal spiritual transformation". On a few occasions, concerns that illegal immigrant labor would undermine UFW strike campaigns led to a number of controversial events, which the UFW describes as anti-strikebreaking events, but which have also been interpreted as being anti-immigrant. Joining him on the march were Reverend Ralph Abernathy and U. Later during the s, while Chavez was still working alongside Huerta, he was key in getting the amnesty provisions into the federal immigration act. Just a few hundred marchers left San Francisco on February 22, By the time they reached Modesto on March 1, however, more than 15, people had joined the march en route. In mid, the ALRB ran out of its budgeted money for the year, as a result of a massive amount of work in setting up farmworker elections. The proposition went before California voters in November , but was defeated by a 2"1 margin. Acting on the advice of former UFW leader Andy Imutan, Chavez met with then-President of the Philippines Ferdinand Marcos in Manila and endorsed the regime, which was seen by human rights advocates and religious leaders as a vicious dictatorship. Meanwhile, membership in the UFW union had been in decline and by the mids it had dwindled to around 15, As a result, Chavez undertook what was to be his last fast. He fasted for 35 days before being convinced by others to start eating again. He lost 30 pounds during the fast, and it caused health problems that may have contributed to his death. The couple moved to San Jose, California , where they had eight children. Chavez National Monument in Keene, California. Chavez died on April 23, , of unspecified natural causes in San Luis, Arizona , in the home of former farm worker and longtime friend Dofla Maria Hau. Shortly after his death, his widow, Helen Chavez, donated his black nylon union jacket to the National Museum of American History , a branch of the Smithsonian.
