THE CHOCOLATE LOVERS' CLUB brings together four very different women with one thing in common: they can't resist chocolate. This is an irresistible novel for anyone who wishes they were a member! Lucy Lombard can't resist it - rich, creamy, sweet, delicious chocolate.

It is fun, but no literary masterpiece. A good holiday read. Lucy Lombard, a something London office temp, has a passion for chocolate. She haunts a place called Chocolate Heaven, where hand-made, exquisite chocolate products are created and sold by the owners, gay couple Clive and Tristan. Autumn, an earnest, single, upper class woman who works as an art therapist at a drug rehabilitation centre. Chantal, a wealthy, glamorous ex-pat American journalist who lives in great luxury, but in a marriage without any sex. She looks elsewhere to satisfy her sexual needs, which in turn creates a situation that forms a major element of the narrative. Nadia, of Asian heritage, is the only one of the four club members to have a child, three year old Lewis. She has a long term relationship with Marcus, for whom she has a strong attraction, but he is chronically unfaithful. For a heroine who I guess is supposed to be strong and feisty, her ongoing weakness for the shallow, venal Marcus mystified me. She has two other nebulous romantic interests, in the form of Jacob, a handsome stranger she meets at Chocolate Heaven, and Aidan Holby, nicknamed Crush, her boss at work. Lucy and her friends embark on some hilarious adventures which provide a great deal of amusement for this reader. The situations faced by the three friends told in the third person in separate chapters have features that are grounded in reality, which adds a poignancy to their stories. In the early chapters I was very taken with the spirited, fun-loving Lucy, but she began to pall on me as the book progressed. In my opinion the author had trouble finding the right level to pitch the Lucy character. Is she meant to be a compassionate, supportive friend or a cheeky, comedic character? Some of her behaviour descends towards the slapstick, as the author tries to milk the madcap aspects of her nature. It seemed to me that the author kept tossing elements of both into the Lucy mix, which created a bit of a mess. The other problem with that approach is that the book is rather lengthy. The fifth major character in this book is Chocolate. In all its forms it is described in loving detail, time and time again throughout the story. Did it make me salivate? Admittedly there were a few descriptions that evoked wonderful images in my mind and tastes in my mouth. Again, I see this as a lack of judgment on the part of the author, who did not seem to strike an harmonious balance. It is this failure to equalise competing elements which has reduced my rating for this enjoyable book by a full star. So it is 3.

I realize this is a popular technique right now, but I really wanted to understand more about each individual story. With a bit more understanding, I might have not felt that it was being overdramatic. In the end, I started to feel like I was reading a soap opera on paper. The elements were there for an amazing story, but maybe just needed a bit more depth added to certain individuals so that you could relate to them more? Unfortunately, this book was more a swing and a miss to me because the main protagonist Lucy was clearly more caricature than character. I would like to believe that no self-respecting young woman would truly be so proud of her ability to stick with a serial cheater of a boyfriend. I would like to believe no self-respecting young woman would be so proud of her absolute inability to perform any of the basic functions of her employment. I would like to believe no self-respecting young woman wants to read and sympathize with so vapid and annoying a main character. No self-respecting woman would actually stick with a cheating boyfriend for so long and actually be proud of herself for it, nor would true friends let such stupidity go on indefinitely. If you want to learn a million different types of chocolate, or drool over your book a bit, then this book is a worthwhile read. As far as chick-lit goes, however, I was really disappointed. I want to find women in books that strike me as people I might know, friends I might have - not women who make me cringe and give the worst name to the fairer sex.
