There are 3 comments In , with my uni life behind me, I watched more movies than any other person in history. This is the true tale of my triumph. Remarkably, the record in stood at a pithy 41 hours. We could watch movies for 41 hours. Heck, we could probably go longer. We could be world record holders!! But how exactly does one go about breaking a Guinness World Record? I jumped online, submitted my details, and waited for a response. Guinness Rules Exactly weeks later, an e-mail arrived. Attached were the strict rules of the Movie Marathon, as well as news that the record had been broken: The rules are tough. They loved the idea, and better still most of them have medical training. We then went looking for sponsorship. Sure, the rules were strict, but they were open to interpretation. Suddenly, we had a cinema, a public place, and free coffee. We quickly isolated the Toilet Rule as the toughest. There had to be a way around itâ€¦ and there was. It would also maximise our 15 minutes breaks. Rob and I started by putting together a list of movies, and their running time which, with the rules, included all the credits. That was when we discovered that Rob has no taste in films. History is written by the good looking. Finally, we had to select a team to break the record. In the end, only two others felt they had it in them: The videos were stacked up. The projectors were readied. The lights went down. The first hours progressed as anticipated, and nervousness was replaced by the simmering thrill that only comes when you make history. Saturday passed without incident, but not even daylight could save Joel, who had started the attempt under a cloud of illness. As the movies blended into each other, it became an exercise in following rules and staying awake. We all made it past 36 hours without a single coffee. During a break after 2 days, unaware of the pain to come Can you spell diuretic? Freddy Got Fingered, which I had been assured was riotously funny, was not. Struggling to find meaning in a film devoid of humour, I went perilously close to snoozing. The caffeine was instantaneous. So too was the movement of all bodily fluids to my bladder. I needed to pee. And there were still more than five hours, and at least one Adam Sandler film, before I could use the bathroom. At least three lifetimes. In that time I invented, refined, and mastered the art of Tantric bladder control. Dawn crept through the window. It appeared that I was going to be survive. And in walked an ABC Radio journalist with only one question on her mind. How badly did I need to go? How many minutes until I could? The journalist left, but I still had fifteen minutes. I pride myself on never giving up. I had come so far. Phone calls were rolling in. I got a text message from Scotland. And the crowd began the countdown. Nothing â€” and here I include Graduation, Childbirth, and walking on the moon â€” can compare with the moment the room erupted. We had done it. The 3 of us at the end. We could have carried on, but knew no matter what record we set it would eventually be broken. We were the best in the world. Our record â€” 63 hours and 27 minutes â€” was approved and acknowledged by Guinness World Records. I understand the current record sits at 72 hours. Others are preparing to break that. But the memory of those days, and that moment, is something nobody can ever take away. Both brothers had an encyclopedic memory; on the TV series Record Breakers, based upon the book, they would take questions posed by children in the audience on various world records and were able to give the correct answer. Guinness Superlatives later Guinness World Records Limited was formed in to publish the first book. Sterling Publishing owned the rights to the Guinness book in the US for decades. Gullane was itself purchased by HIT Entertainment in . He holds the Guinness World Records title as of [update]. Recent editions have focused on record feats by person competitors. Competitions range from obvious ones such as Olympic weightlifting to the longest egg tossing distances, or for longest time spent playing Grand Theft Auto IV or the number of hot dogs that can be consumed in three minutes. Many records also relate to the youngest people to have achieved something, such as the youngest person to visit all nations of the world Maurizio Giuliano. Applications made by individuals for existing record categories are free of charge. At that time, he held records. The list of records which the Guinness World Records covers is not fixed; records may be added and also removed for various reasons. The public are invited to submit applications for records, which can be either the bettering of existing records or substantial achievements which could constitute a new record. They later dropped all beer and alcohol records from their compendium in , and reinstated the records in . Guinness World Records states several types of records it will not accept for ethical reasons, such as those related to the killing or harming of animals. For example, following publication of a "heaviest fish" record, many fish owners overfed their pets beyond the bounds of what was healthy, and therefore such entries were removed. There have been instances of closed records being reopened. For example, the sword swallowing record was listed as closed in the Guinness Book of World Records, but the Guinness World Records Primetime TV show, which started in , accepted three sword swallowing challenges and so did the edition of the Guinness World Records onwards. Similarly, the speed beer drinking records which were dropped from the book in , reappeared 17 years later in the edition, but were moved from the "Human Achievements" section of the older book [31] to the "Modern Society" section of the newer edition. For example, its website states: We currently include over 15,000 records online which we update every week, so make sure to check the site regularly!
