Martin finds himself distracted and rushed. Unconscious bias impacts every phase of talent management and cannot be fully eliminated from our reactions to people. However, it is possible to mitigate the impact of bias by looking at several aspects of how we manage talent. By creating conscious structures and processes, we can create more consistency in the process and be able to make better selections. These interventions occur generally in four ways. Providing education about unconscious bias, especially to people managers. Education in and of itself may not be able to dramatically reduce bias, but it can encourage people to engage in different behaviors that just might accomplish that. Priming the manager to be more aware by discussing bias just before a talent management interaction. Review the conversation about unconscious bias before any talent management process begins. Creating structures and systems that can help bring more consciousness to the talent management process. Measure the results of your processes and track those measurements. Are certain people consistently more successful than others? If so, there is a reason! Worry more about finding that reason and less about placing blame, and your talent management system will become more inclusive and conscious! Make sure job descriptions demonstrate a balance of gender or cultural patterns. Ensure as much consistency as possible in interpersonal interactions. Include a diversity of people in the recruiting process. Remove as many identifiers such as name and gender as possible in the early stages of the recruitment process. Studies have shown that people can be strongly influenced by various identifiers. Include a diversity of people in the interviewing process. Create as much consistency as possible around the interview “where and when it occurs, what gets asked and who is evaluating. Watch for differences in the way reference letters are written. They can be an enormous source of bias. Watch out for your own comfort level with certain personality types. Use diverse panels for hiring recommendations, and watch out for groupthink on the panel. Be sure to communicate clearly the purpose of mentoring and its structure. Consider creating a uniform mentoring process across the board instead of specialized mentoring for certain groups. Beware of numbered processes e. Rely more on feedback given in conversation. Be careful to observe rater biases relating to current projects or clients. Does the employee get more credit because the project he or she was working on is more important, more recent or more urgent? Watch for places where you might be measuring against personal standards as opposed to measuring against success. Look for patterns of awareness about employees. Make sure there is a written development plan for every employee, and routinely evaluate and compare those plans for patterns of differential treatment.

Phoenix claimed that she had also been born in Galway, although she later stated that she was merely agreeing with something her elderly mother had already told the press. When Phoenix was eight years old, her father was involved in a car accident; in court, it was revealed that his marriage was bigamous as he had never divorced his first wife, who was living some miles away and who he had been paying maintenance to for many years. She later described this period in her life as a "nightmare", saying that "I lost my safe, secure, normal world". Her mother later married Richard Pilkington. Phoenix attended Fallowfield Central School. After leaving school, she worked as a filing clerk for the gas department of Manchester Corporation, performing in amateur dramatics in her spare time. She joined the Arts Theatre in Manchester and other Northern repertory companies. She also worked as a writer for ventriloquist Terry Hall and comedian Harry Worth. Some undistinguished film work followed in *Blood of the Vampire* and *Jack the Ripper*, and in , she returned to Manchester with her ambition all but spent. By this time, she had changed her name from Pilkington to Phoenix, after the mythological bird that rose from the ashes. She featured in the programme from to , and again from to . In she was invited to open a brand new speedway track at Ellesmere Port, and her character as Elsie Tanner helped to draw a record crowd of around 10, to the track at Thornton Road, Ellesmere Port, home of the "Gunners". Her character became known for her fiery red hair, and was described by Prime Minister James Callaghan as "the sexiest thing on television". During her periods of absence from the series, she failed in her attempts to find suitable alternative roles. She left the series for the final time in January . In the story, her character moved to Portugal to meet up with an old flame until when the character died in a car crash off screen. After her final departure from *Coronation Street*, she appeared in a one-act television play, *Hidden Talents*, in . At this time, she was suffering from advanced lung cancer; in the play, she played a woman dying of cancer. She also starred in short-lived sitcom *Constant Hot Water* the same year, playing a Bridlington landlady. Her first marriage was to actor Peter Marsh, whom she married in *Bradford Cathedral* in ; the marriage lasted only a year and they were divorced in . In , she married her *Coronation Street* co-star Alan Browning, who had alcohol-related problems and died from liver failure in . Phoenix wrote two volumes of autobiography: *She was a practising Roman Catholic and a lifelong supporter of the Labour Party*, campaigning for her son-in-law Tony Blair in the General Election and helping him win his first seat in a landslide majority. She also campaigned with Booth for Tony Benn in the Chesterfield by-election in , which Benn won. She continued to work following her diagnosis, hiding her illness from most people, including her lover Antony Booth. In the summer of , her condition deteriorated, forcing her to undergo more extensive treatment and confirming mild speculation in the press that she had health problems. It later leaked that she had just weeks to live and had been given her last rites. Phoenix married Booth in Stockport in September , attracting much media attention. Eight days later, she died in her sleep, aged . At her request, her funeral service at the Holy Name Church in Manchester featured a large brass band; according to *Coronation Street* histories written by show historian Daran Little, she wanted the event that marked her death to be as lively as her life. Tony Blair and his wife Cherie were among the mourners. She is commemorated by a blue plaque outside Granada Studios, the location for most of her work on *Coronation Street*.
