The Master of Religious Education in Missional Leadership MRE integrates rigorous theological content with practical experience designed to prepare students for a lifetime of faithful service and vibrant discipleship. The MRE is a hour, cohort based, full-time integrated program combining 24 online hours with 12 intensive, face-to-face hours. While the majority of coursework is completed online, students are required to travel to the RC campus or other designated sites one week each semester for spiritual retreat and intensive coursework. It is part of Rochester Hills, an area that has developed into one of the most popular residential communities of southeastern Michigan. Upscale shopping centers, theaters, parks, biking trails, and popular restaurants offer many options for recreation. The Greater Detroit Area also features museums and professional sports teams. Canada is less than an hour away, accessible by bridge or tunnel. This facility also hosts the Student Call Center, allowing current students to help with alumni-related communications and functions. The library offers electronic, print, and audio-visual materials to all students and guests. Users have remote and on-campus access to indexing and fulltext articles in over 60 electronic databases. The library home page contains information on the online catalog, electronic resources, Internet resources, contact information, interlibrary loan services, and library news. The lower level of the Ham Library building has several well-equipped classrooms, as well as the laboratory for the Rochester College School of Nursing Ham where, through simulations, nursing students integrate their theoretical knowledge and previous learning in the curriculum into practiced skills. Most recently it houses senior male students. Rooms are carpeted and furnished with bed, wardrobe, desk, chair, chest of drawers, and hutch. Each floor has a community bathroom. All rooms are furnished with tile flooring, wardrobes, dressers, beds, desks, and chairs. Phone hookups and cable are also available. All rooms are furnished with beds, wardrobes or closets, dressers, desks with hutches or shelves, and chairs. Both men and women have access to a laundry room and kitchenette. All rooms are furnished with tile flooring, beds, wardrobes, dressers, desks, and chairs. Some rooms include a kitchenette. Palmer Hall is also the headquarters for the Housekeeping Department. The commons features a TV lounge, computer terminals, and coed laundry facilities. Food service for the college is provided by Aladdin Food Services. Located adjacent to the Isom Atrium, Westside-Central Auditorium, and the Fletcher Center the cafeteria, the Utley Center is an ideal location for students to study, meet with groups, and improve their academic skills. The Student Center houses three different sections. One section has tables and chairs for students to study, read, and relax. Kibo Corner supports Kibo Group International, a foundation which promotes missions and business opportunities in East Africa. The auditorium also hosts lectures, classes, theatre and music performances, and other special programs. The lab is open for use when classes are not meeting in the room. The intimate size of the student body allows all students to participate in wide variety of leadership or social activities. The Student Development Office oversees student related events, student organizations, intramurals, campus ministry, residence life, student services, and the Academic Center for Excellence. This includes a snap shot of available resources such as the library, Academic Center for Excellence tutoring lab, student organizations, campus ministry, Global Educational Opportunities GEO, highlights of the student handbook and many other topics. After Welcome Week is FYE, a series of events and activities during the first six weeks of the fall semester that help engage all incoming students to interact with returning students, contribute to the campus environment, and learn to create their own valuable RC experience. Rochester College aims to provide each student with an academic education, along with a holistic experience that spurs each of us into working together so as to positively impact our campus, communities and neighborhoods. Students who have an interest in singing may join the A Cappella Chorus, which performs at local, regional, and national events, or the Rochester Community Chorus, which performs frequently with the Rochester Symphony Orchestra. Students also have the opportunity to audition for Autumn, which performs contemporary Christian popular music for a variety of audiences. Students with instrumental skills may audition for the Concert Band. The theatre department produces four or more plays per academic year, including a musical in the fall semester. Additionally, students have opportunities to learn to direct, stage manage, and design for the theatre. Students may also get involved with performance groups that tour to local schools, churches, camps, and other community venues. The staff also produce smaller specialized publications throughout the year. Faculty in the Mass Communication Department train and oversee students in preparation and production of Shield. Working for Shield offers students the opportunity to use their creative talents in producing media while at the same time helping them gain valuable media experience. Mass Communication majors are required to work for Shield, and students from other majors are welcome to participate as well. Scholarships are available to students who work as editors or managers. Even with no experience in publication work, students who have an interest in writing, editing, design or photography are encouraged to volunteer for Shield. Full-time students are eligible to pledge in the fall of each semester. Social clubs offer an opportunity for students to gain leadership experience as well as small group and team working skills. Nook Program The Unquiet Library Update, March Catching Up Many of you have been writing or Tweeting for updates on the Nook program we had planned to launch last fall; unfortunately, several factors slowed our launch date for the program, including: Nooks are for circulation to students who return a parental permission form or who would like to use them in the library during a class or lunch visit. Challenges with the Digital Managed Locker Program In terms of the digital managed locker program, there have definitely been some problems that I have experienced as have many of you. Barnes and Noble has frankly not done a very good job in educating its employees about the Digital Managed Locker program. If you are not able to get the answers you need from someone at the first store you visit or call, I recommend contacting a neighboring store or the regional Barnes and Noble manager for your area. We have not had any issues connecting to wireless, and the downloading process has been fairly seamless. We did have one device go bad as we could not unlock it; after not having any success with the technical support, our representative Dan was helpful in resolving the issue and actually bringing us a replacement device a major time saver – thank you! One other helpful hint: First Steps of Implementation, Spring We have now started circulating devices to students for free reading yes, I let them take the devices home – students and parents sign an acceptable use agreement, and we also bought a 2 year warranty , so I hope to have their feedback for you soon. One student in particular is absolutely thrilled to have the chance to use a modern eReader – I am not exaggerating when I say he was giddy and glowing when he left the library! At this time, the free circulation Nook collection is purely student driven like our Kindle eBook collection since students submit eBook request forms when they turn in their permission forms. At this time, the loan period is one week although we hope to extend that in the future.
