

## 1: Kings and Corn: Summer Heli Skiing in Alaska

Plot[ edit ] The film is set in the fictional town of Gatlin, Nebraska , an agricultural community surrounded by huge cornfields. The town appears to be neglected, except for the church, and residents choose Biblical names over more modern ones. When the corn crop fails one year, the townsfolk turn to prayer to ensure a successful harvest. Isaac and his subordinate, year-old Malachai, lead the children in a revolution, murdering all of the adults ages 19 and up, since year-olds are seen as halfway between teenager and adult in town as human sacrifices. Only Job and his sister Sarah refuse to participate, as they can see visions of the future, drawing them on paper. Three years later, Vicky and her boyfriend Burt travel through rural Nebraska for Seattle , where Burt will start working as a physician. However, Burt discovers his throat has been cut beforehand. They place the boy and his suitcase in the trunk and search for a phone to call for help. They come across an elderly mechanic , the last adult in Gatlin, but he refuses them service. The mechanic is actually in an agreement to supply the children with fuel in exchange for his life. Vicky and Burt explore the abandoned town , finding Sarah alone in a house. Burt searches the town, while Vicky stays with Sarah. Malachai and his followers appear, capturing Vicky and taking her to the cornfield, where they place her on a cross to be sacrificed. Burt enters a church where a congregation of children, led by a girl named Rachel, are performing a cultural birthday ritual for her boyfriend Amos by drinking his blood, made by a cut on his body in the shape of a pentagram. Since Amos has turned 19, he is now considered old enough to be killed. Burt scolds the children for participating in a blood cult, enraging Rachel, and is chased by Malachai and the others. Job rescues Burt and they hide in a fallout shelter with Sarah, learning Vicky was captured. Isaac warns Malachai that sacrificing him will break their pact with He Who Walks Behind the Rows and the children will be severely punished. At night, Burt sneaks into the cornfield to rescue Vicky. Burt emerges and fights Malachai, but Isaac suddenly reappears, revived by He Who Walks Behind the Rows, tells Malachai that he wants him too, and seizes and kills the terrified Malachai by breaking his neck. A storm appears over the cornfield, and Burt and Vicky shelter the children in a barn. They read a passage in the Bible that implies the cornfield must be destroyed to stop the false god. Burt sprays the cornfield with gasohol and tosses a Molotov cocktail into the field, setting it alight and destroying the demon. Vicky, Burt, Job, and Sarah return to their car to leave Gatlin, only to find it disabled. Rachel attacks Burt, but he knocks her out with the car door. Just before the survivors set out on foot, Vicky quips that they should all send Rachel a get-well card from Seattle, with Burt and Vicky ostensibly deciding to adopt Job and Sarah.

Jesus the Corn King: Examining some Parallels Between Jesus and Dionysus According to the biblical scholar and historian Dennis MacDonald there are extensive connections between the Gospel stories found in the New Testament and the Greek myths and legends of old. I contend that they do, and more specifically, I contend that the Jesus narrative closely follows, if not borrows from, the myth of Dionysus. Perhaps more striking than this, however, are the parallels between Jesus himself and the pagan god Dionysus, especially when it comes to ritual, wine, and symbolism. Kessler has detailed that the Dionysian cult had developed into a monotheism by the 4th century CE giving direct competition to early Christianity. Wick notes that the numerous references to wine, miracle and wine, and ritual and wine cannot possibly represent a Christian vs. These uncanny parallels can be seen in Jesus of the Gospels as contained in the discussion with Pontius Pilate, for the same charges against him, [8] [9] and Jesus too is likened to the Lion of Judah in Revelation 5: Although it could be claimed this is a rather loose parallel, it is interesting to note that both figures were likened to lions as well as having wine symbolism, are both dying and rising corn-gods, and offer salvation from sin. It almost seems as if those anonymous Greek writers of the Gospels were so enamored with the discourse between Dionysus and Pentheus that they retold it using their favorite character Jesus Christ, another dying and rising Corn King, with ties to wine rituals Mat. At the marriage in Cana John 2: Needless to say gallons of wine is far more than required for such a small wedding. Was Jesus trying to get everyone drunk? Whatever the case may be, there was no doubt that Jesus loved his wine. In fact, the Pontius Pilate and Jesus dialog mirrors the King Pentheus and Dionysus dialog in such profound and undeniable ways that I am more than inclined to think it was the template for that particular discussion found in the New Testament. Additionally, both Pontius Pilate and King Pentheus meet similar ends, dying atop mountains. Besides the above dialog other similarities exist between Jesus and Dionysus as well. In Euripides The Bacchae, Dionysus refers to himself as the Child of God and Jesus is frequently referred to as the Son of God, and both are atoning for the sins of their people. Both infants are birthed in secrecy while fleeing from the powers that would seek to have their blood spilled and their lives snuffed out the ever jealous queen of the gods Hera in the case of Dionysus and King Herod the Great in the case of Jesus. Both Jesus and Dionysus get sentenced to death and both overcome death. If it is all a big coincidence, what a coincidence indeed! A whole string of them! All seeming to form a distinct pattern connecting Jesus to Dionysus! It makes sense that those living in the first, second, and third centuries would have been familiar with the Dionysian myth and Euripides The Bacchae, and would have instantly seen the parallels. I can only imagine that in the Hellenistic minds of the time, Greeks seeing Jesus as the new and improved Dionysus would be more inclined to accept Christianity. In Colorado, it fattens the feed trough of a ,head cattle feedlot. Ian and Curt are increasingly troubled by how the abundance of corn is helping to make fast food cheap and consumers sick, driving animals into confinement and farmers off the land. Animal nutritionists confirm that corn feeding can make cows sick and beef fatty, but it also lets consumers have fast food at low prices. High-fructose corn syrup, corn-fed meat, and corn-based processed foods are the staples of the modern diet. Last fall, when KING CORN got picked up for theatrical distribution, they set out on the road with Aaron, talking with audiences at theaters, college campuses and community screenings. In December they returned to Iowa, where they held screening-and-discussion events in communities across the state. Ian and Curt have since finished a new documentary, The Greening of Southie, which follows the construction crew that tries to build the first residential green building in Boston. That film will be broadcast on the Sundance Channel on Earth Day Ian is now living in Boston, where he roots for the Red Sox and is working on two new documentaries: Curt is back home in Oregon, where he is writing and working on film projects as a Food and Society Policy Fellow. The latest hair tests show Ian to be 43 percent corn, and Curt, 39 percent. Aaron is living in New York, where he has opened a know-where-your-food-comes-from grocery store, Urban Rustic, in Brooklyn.
