*Dora Hand (c. - October 4, ), aged c. 34, was an American dance hall singer and actress in Dodge City, Kansas, who was mistakenly shot to death from ambush by a young suitor, who was acquitted of criminal charges in the case.*

The full story of Dora is still unknown, because Soviet documentation in that time was conducted carelessly. For this reason, information about the numerous victims of the Red Terror and their executioners has been lost or little known. Historians have set forth several basic versions of the life and work of Comrade Dora. Historian Sergei Petrovich Melgunov was one of the first to describe the cruelty of this woman. There are contradictory statements that she was Russian, Hungarian, or Jewish. Russian soldiers of the anti-Bolshevik Siberian Army in It has been considered before working in the Cheka, Comrade Dora or Vera Grebennyukova voluntarily engaged in prostitution. Dora then worked as a Red executioner until her arrest in September In January , she was executed. During the two and a half months of her service in the Cheka, she alone shot people, i. Hurray for the Red Terror. One special group made films about the successes of the Whites and the cruelty of the Reds. The director Veniamin Sergeev, who bore the surname Benedetto-Gordon, created one of these films. It is known that she was a supporter of the revolution. After the Whites took control of Odessa, she prepared an uprising and fought against the counter-revolutionaries, but later was exposed and arrested. In , Dora Lyubarskaya and her comrades were executed. In eight days, I will be 22 years old, and in the evening, they will shoot me. I regret that I will perish this way. Only now, I feel myself a conscious revolutionary and party worker! Soon, soon, all Ukraine will sigh and live, conscious work will begin. I wish I could take part in it. Until her death, Dora Lyubarskaya was part of the Odessa Cheka and an actress. Petersburg, Comrade Dora utilized sophisticated torture of prisoners. Dora also used a variety of methods to make the punishment agonizing, which often ended with a shot in the head. *Dora Lee Askoff, of Pataskala, passed away on Sunday, October 15, at Mount Carmel East Hospital. She was born on April 18, in Pataskala, OH, a daughter to the late George and Jesse (Wolfe) Bowie.*

Background[ edit ] Hand may have been born on the East Coast of the United States and some sources list her birth as early as According to legend, she was a descendant of a prominent unnamed Boston family, had studied music in Europe and had once performed opera in New York City. Like Doc Holliday , she had supposedly come to the American West to battle tuberculosis. When she arrived in Dodge City, possibly as early as May or as late as June , she was divorced from her musician husband Theodore "Ted" Hand and used the stage name Fannie Keenan. There was a grace and charm in her walk. She dressed plainly, usually in black, and this color seemed to accentuate the ivory whiteness of her soft skin. Frontier Marshal , author Stuart N. Lake describes Hand as "the most graciously beautiful woman" to come to Dodge City "in the heyday of its iniquity. Kelley managed to arrange for her to sing five nights a week for two hours at his Alhambra Saloon. The added income led Hand to assist the poor and unfortunate. Drago described her as "an angel of mercy" in the eyes of Dodge City residents. When Hand appeared, the church was crowded to the doors, a previously unknown occurrence. Within an hour of the church appearance, she had already returned to the stage of the Lady Gay. Stuart Lake saw her as by night "the Queen of the Fairy Belles" who entertained drunken cowhands but by day "Lady Bountiful," one determined to help the needy. When Kenedy became aggressive toward Dora, Kelley physically evicted him from the Alhambra, and the two later clashed again. He learned that Kelley spent many nights in a crude two-room cabin near the saloon. He struck early on the morning of October 4, , firing a gunshot into the cabin. Kelly was instead seeking treatment for a stomach disorder at the infirmary at Fort Dodge , the United States Army outpost some five miles from Dodge City. He had gone to Fort Dodge because he was on unfriendly terms with the town physician in Dodge City. Kenedy fled south on horseback and did not learn that he had killed Dora until he was apprehended by a posse , which included Bat Masterson and Wyatt Earp. When the partnership with King ended in , Kenedy purchased Laureles Ranch, a ,acre tract near Corpus Christi. Cowboys from the King and Kenedy ranches in alone drove 15, longhorns to Dodge City and were a financial power in the community. He was based at Tascosa in Oldham County , now a ghost town but in its heyday the center of business for ten Panhandle counties. With an "athletic physique, dark hair and eyes, he was the handsomest bachelor in the Panhandle," but Kenedy presumably could not "withstand the temptations of the underworld. Kenedy had already twice run afoul of authorities in Dodge City in On July 29, Deputy Marshal Wyatt Earp arrested him for carrying and brandishing a pistol, which was not allowed in Dodge City at the time. On August 17, Marshal Charlie Bassett arrested him for disorderly conduct, but a lenient judge gave him a mere warning. Months later on December 15, Mayor Kelley appointed Charlie Bassett, while still serving as the sheriff of Ford County , to replace Masterson with the simultaneous title of sheriff and assistant marshal. After Bat Masterson became sheriff, he named Bassett his undersheriff. Kenedy was returned to Dodge City two days after the death of Dora Hand and jailed to protect him from irate citizens. Mifflin Kenedy rushed to Dodge City, apparently with a large amount of cash in hand. We do not know what the evidence was or upon what grounds he was acquitted. A cowhand was quoted as having said, "Every store, saloon and gambling house in Dodge closed during the funeral, and four hundred men with their sombreros on their saddle horses rode behind the spring wagon that carried Dora Hand up Boot Hill. Historians have labeled Dora Hand as anything from angelic nightingale to outright prostitute. Whatever her designation, her shooting death was a frontier tragedy, and Dodge City has never forgotten her. He had one known survivor, a daughter Irene, who did not attend his funeral, held in the Army chapel. Perhaps she no longer lived in the area. Actually, Kelley was already the mayor when Earp arrived in Dodge City. Dora calls on Earp for help when railroad workers and buffalo hunters clash in her saloon. Meanwhile, she raises money for the church and sings at least once in its choir. William Tannen played deputy Hal Norton in this episode. The Lutherplatz in the town of Nordhausen The Dora-Mittelbau camp was first mentioned on 27 August as an external unit of the Buchenwald concentration camp. On 28 October it became a major concentration camp in its own right, with twenty-three branches, most of them in the vicinity, inside a restricted military area. In effect, the camp became operational on November 1, with 32, Mittelbau prisoners of many nationalities. Entrance to the tunnels at Nordhausen The SS used the Boelcke Kaserne, a former barracks in Nordhausen city, as a dumping ground for hopeless prisoner cases. Thousands of prisoners were transferred to Dora-Mittelbau, mostly from Buchenwald and they were put to work excavating underground tunnels that were to serve as the site of a huge plant for the manufacture of V-2 missiles and other arms. The original plan of excavation and tunnelling provided for two long tunnels that would parallel through the mountain from north to south and be connected by forty-six smaller tunnels. The project yielded an excellent site for underground rocket production in the two main tunnels – each 1, meters long and 12 and a half meters wide – and twenty-three connecting tunnels. The Germans used the main tunnels for rocket testing. Railroad tracks ran the length of the tunnel, with sufficient space remaining at the side for huge pieces of machinery. The Junkers company used the small northern section to manufacture airplane engines. Until the plant was put into operation, in the late spring of , the ten thousand prisoners working on the site had no living quarters and were housed inside the tunnels, under unbearable conditions, deprived of daylight and fresh air for weeks at a time. They had to work at a murderous pace, in twelve-hour shifts, in very unsanitary conditions and lack of security precautions led to a mortality rate much higher than that in any other concentration camp in Germany. Tunnel - A One of the two parallel tunnels Only after production began was a camp of wooden barracks constructed in Dora – Mittelbau, to which the prisoners were transferred in the summer of That autumn, when maximum production was attained in the camp, Dora-Mittelbau had a permanent prison population in the main camp of over twelve thousand, with another twenty thousand in the satellite camps. When construction was completed and the plant went into operation, thousands of Jewish prisoners from various countries were brought to Dora-Mittelbau. They were treated with great brutality and were assigned the most physically exacting jobs, their mortality rate was higher than that of any other group of prisoners. Jewish prisoners who were exhausted and could not keep pace with the work were sent to Auschwitz and Mauthausen, in special transports, to be killed there. The first group of prisoners sent to Dora-Mittelbau from Buchenwald included several individuals who had been active in the underground organisation in that camp. Together with other groups of prisoners of various nationalities, they formed an underground while Dora-Mittelbau was still under construction, in order to sabotage the work and slow it down. When production began in , the sabotage operations were intensified, seriously damaging the manufacturing process and upsetting the timetable for the delivery of the weapons desperately needed by the Nazis, as the tide of war turned against them. Regardless of gender, all prisoners were treated with extreme cruelty, which caused illness, injuries and deaths. Examples of the cruelty routinely inflicted on prisoners include: Large numbers of prisoners were jailed on charges of sabotage; many were killed during their interrogations or were subsequently executed. More than two hundred prisoners, including several of the underground leaders were hanged in public. On 1 April the Nazis began the evacuation of the camp, within several days most of the prisoners had been taken out, with the majority transferred to Bergen-Belsen.
