Every December, the Carolina Ballet puts on an amazing show in the triangle area. The show moves around, and is sometimes in Durham or in Raleigh. Tickets can be pricey, and they go fast. Blowing Rock North Carolina is just a short drive south of Boone in the far eastern part of the state. Chetola is a resort that puts on an amazing holiday experience. They also have an annual holiday parade and tree lighting ceremony, too. Head to the coast for a Christmas Parade on the water. For more than three decades, people have been flocking to Wrightsville Beach to watch their annual Holiday Floatilla. Santa makes an appearance on the Friday after Thanksgiving, and on Saturday night, you can watch an amazing Christmas Light boat parade. New Bern also has a similar event. This is also free. Go and watch Santa rappel down a mountain face. Chimney Rock State Park is a short drive south of Asheville. On certain days out of the week, Santa Claus rappels down the side of a mountain. Claus and enjoy some other holiday festivities like cocoa, cookies and music. Head to the Outer Banks for a Christmas experience. They put on a good show that includes Elizabethan Gardens WinterLights, a garden-type Christmas walk, and other events. Click here to see the schedule , as they change it every year. Santa does make an appearance on certain nights. At the beginning of each December, you can head over to downtown Durham near the baseball field and watch them light up the famous tobacco tower. All of this is free. Plus, you can skate outdoors, as they turn an area here into an outdoor ice rink. You can also get a Christmas Tree and see other cool sights and sounds. The complete schedule of their events is here, as it changes year to year. Christmas at The Biltmore is something you need to do at least once. Throughout November and December, they turn the place into a totally Christmas experience. Basically, you walk around the place and check out the sights and sounds. If you live in the greater Charlotte area, this is a great idea for a night of fun. You drive around throughout their town, which is decorated like a giant Christmas Village. The lights stay on until 11 pm on Friday and Saturday and turn off at 9: It lasts all of December. With this event, you can actually get out of the car and walk around a bit and soak in the scene. Claus are there, and you can buy things from the gift shop. Monday through Thursday are far better options so avoid large crowds. Folks near Raleigh can head to Lights On the Neuse. Raleigh area moms can take the kids to Meadow Lights Meadow Lights is something of a yearly tradition in Benson, NC a 30 minute drive south of Raleigh. Here, you get to meet Santa, ride a train, and buy some cookies, delicious Christmas-themed candy, and other treats. Most of it is free, but you pay for smaller things like the train ride and treats. Drive around an awesome Christmas display in Wendell, NC near Raleigh The town of Wendell gathers together and puts on a very impressive free show that spans a few blocks through town called the Lake Myra Christmas Lights Show. But probably not worth driving more than an hour for. Santa makes an appearance often. Times vary, but it typically shuts off at 10 pm except for Friday and Saturdays 11 pm. Carolina Beach turns its boardwalk into a Christmas themed display, with lights, music, crafts, Santa Claus and different events throughout the month. It starts with an annual lighting ceremony the Friday after Thanksgiving. Every night is different, so you can check here to see what you want to do. Each year, you can head downtown to meet Santa, watch the tree get lit up and listen to music. Here, you can watch model trains drive around a holiday themed display, meet Santa and enjoy a few other activities. Or, just find another holiday display in your area. Most of these displays are free. Typically, you drive around and look at lights, and some of these have other added bonuses like Santa Claus, music and smallish events. It saves you a lot of money for parking around the stadium and the shuttle has its own route that avoids gameday traffic. If you have pepper spray or a pocket knife on your key chain, take it off before you leave your car. Ticketholders can bring one unopened water bottle from outside the stadium, so bring one with you.
