There are a litany of reasons why butterfly populations have declined, such as pollution of air, soil and water, widespread use of insecticides and herbicides, monoculture and GMO crops, tremendous loss of habitat and global warming. Can we actually make a difference if we plant what the butterflies need? You bet we can. There are examples of butterfly species being brought back from the edge of extinction. The people in the town of Wilton, New York made a concerted community-wide effort in the Adirondacks to restore the habitats of the nearly extinct Karner blue butterfly. By massive planting of wild blue lupines, its only host plant, the Karner blue now graces the area each July. Everyone got involved, from school children to community groups to individuals. Hopefully you have many butterflies already visiting your gardens. No matter the season, it is always time to be inspired by butterflies. From spring through autumn we encounter these beautiful creatures. In the winters, their power of transformation informs our dreams and inspires our souls while we plan our gardens to attract them. hummingbirds there that I felt like I was at a humming bird racetrack. Maraleen created a medicine wheel with the four directions healing stones that she made out of shells, jewels, stars on a concrete base, with flowers in the center. Maraleen also made a labyrinth that we walked on that was created to help us focus our intentions to create what we desire in our lives. We then went into her art studio that her husband, Steve built and she gave an animated talk on how she became the Butterfly Woman, then enlightened us about facts about butterflies that was so informative, I learned so much! If your town is not yet listed, please contact me to add your town, wherever it is. The bees, the butterflies and all pollinators thank you. What does this mean? New housing developments cut down trees, create lawns and use non-native plantings that do not support local species. Of course, the same is true for malls and roadways. Conscientious development can work with nature rather than obliterate all life around it. You can now take a tour of my butterfly gardens from the comfort and warmth of your own home or come in person during the summer. The tours are a two hour experience. The dates for summer garden tours are Sundays July 24th, August 7th and August 21st. Maraleen is available as a Butterfly Garden Consultant. Butterfly habitats are disappearing at an enormous rate, at least 2. In addition to habitat loss, the use of pesticides and herbicides kills caterpillars and butterflies. Maraleen participated on a panel at the Princeton Library sponsored by the Sierra Club on October 23, We all have a part to play in protecting our pollinators. Time is of the essence.
