He does not merely proclaim the truth, but He sets His personal stamp and royal seal upon it. He speaks as one having authority, and not as the scribes; with a verily, verily of certainty He teaches, and therefore let us unquestionably accept His declaration. The preface is very solemn: Verily, verily, I say unto you; an awful asseveration, which our Saviour often used, to command a reverent attention and a ready assent. Our Lord introduces this discourse in a most solemn manner, Verily, verily! Is not that double Amen the very mark of the Christ? The word [Amen] in the Hebrew properly signifies, truth, Isaiah As the prophets were wont to begin their discourses with The Word of the Lord, and Thus saith the Lord, so to assert the truth of what they were about to say; so Christ, to show that Himself was God, and spake from Himself, beginneth with Amen, and Amen, Amen, sometimes: The style of the prophets was, Thus saith the Lord, for they were faithful as servants; but Christ, being a Son, speaks in His own name: He is not only true, but truth itself: Jesus is the Truth. For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him amen, II Corinthians 1: The Word of God is not yea and nay, but yea and amen; what He hath said He will abide by, whoever saith against it; nor will He retract any of His sayings for the ignorance and mistakes of men. Christianity is an exclusive religion; it claims that it, and it alone, is the truth of God. And not only is it the one and only way, it also does not need any help or assistance. That is absolute and categorical. The Scripture is plain and peremptory in this, as namely, Acts 4: Whether it will be believed or not, it is certainly fact. Verily, verily, I say unto thee, We speak that we do know, and testify that we have seen; and ye receive not our witness, John 3: It was not spoken of as a thing probable, which perhaps might happen, but as a thing certain. It is a word that seals all the truths of God, and seals every particular promise of God.

Excerpt from The Verilies of Jesus It would appear that in our study of the teachings of Jesus we have in some measure overlooked the significance of the word verily. It occurs twenty-five times in its reduplicated form in John's Gospel and fifty times in its single form in the three synoptists.

Verily, verily I say unto you: Verily is the King James word for "amen". We are used to hearing, "amen", at the end of a statement, and not at the beginning. Jesus says, "amen", at the beginning of a statement, to bring emphasis to what he is saying. He says, "Amen, amen", at the beginning of a declaration to really emphasize what he is about to say. The Catholic Bible is one of the few that reads, "Amen, amen, I say to you". There is another variant that we do, and that is to call out, to the preacher, "tell the truth! Preachers also sometimes either say, "amen? A new one, that I see on Facebook, is to say, "truth! I think that they mean, "amen! Here are a few ideas from published sermons: The "Verily, verily" is only employed by John because he sets forth Christ in His higher relations, and therefore conveys transcendent truth that requires emphasis. Jukes, The Verilies of Christ 1 His verilies have nothing to do with natural truths which we can discover or demonstrate. Smyth, The Positiveness of Jesus Verily is simply the familiar "amen! Sometimes it precedes an assertion which it confirms, in which case it may be paraphrased by "Thus it certainly is. It becomes no other lips. Maclaren, Verily What I believe is that when Jesus speaks, he is speaking authoritatively. He is not just a teacher or even just a prophet. Teachers may teach truth, but Jesus is the truth. Prophets may speak for God, but Jesus is God. Eugene Peterson translated John 6: Whoever believes in me has real life, eternal life. Barrett, writes in his commentary on John: John has merely taken it over from earlier tradition, and employs it to give emphasis to a solemn pronouncement. The Eschatology of Biblical Realism about Jesus using the double amen: All four Gospels witness to a characteristic speech form: Jesus used the expression as the equivalent of an oath, paralleling the Old Testament expression, "As I live, saith the Lord. His words will decide the final destiny of men Mark 8: He himself is the message he proclaims. Jesus claimed for his words an authority equal to that of the word of God itself. The prophet announced the coming of the Kingdom; Jesus embodied its presence and power in his own mission. In The Revelation of John, chapter three, verse fourteen; John writes: And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God. KJV Jesus is the Amen. He is the truth. It is settled in him. He is the authority.
