Many of the trials in our life are allowed by God to help us learn to trust God more than what we really believed was necessary, or that our carnal, sinful nature delights in doing. Trials test our motives and resolve for serving God like nothing else will. Why wait until eternity? Seek wisdom and knowledge. Primarily wisdom - knowledge secondarily. Knowledge without wisdom applied to that knowledge offers little payback. This is the heart of what God in Hebrews. And without faith trust it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him. Trusting God is not optional, if you want Him to reward you with a joy and peace [with additional blessings] that is not attainable any other way. All you have to do is watch the daily news and it is one tragic story after another. Our neighborhoods are no longer as safe as they used to be. Bizarre, random, and senseless type crimes seem to be on the increase with all of the shootings that have occurred at our high schools, and now in our churches and in the courthouses themselves with the latest round of senseless tragedies that have just occurred. All of us, to one degree or another, have been wronged in some way throughout the course of our lives. And for some, these wrongs have been vicious, nasty, and sometimes extremely traumatic " especially those who have been victims of crimes such as assaults, robberies, and actual murders of close friends or family. The Bible says that many will become lovers of self, unholy, proud, unloving, without self-control, brutal and lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God and His ways. Paul talks about these traits in 2 Timothy 3: Being brutal and without self-control may help explain some of the really bizarre crimes that we are starting to see more of with the random type shootings that are occurring in our schools and other public places. Even our own government has to keep reminding us of the dangers of possible further terrorist activity anywhere and at anytime, and that we have to keep a sharp lookout just within our own natural surroundings as you never know when the next land-mine may go off. Spousal abuse in this country is still out of control with the number of women who are being severely beaten by either their husbands or boyfriends. Many people have been so badly beaten and abused during the course of their lives, that they no longer have any ability to trust anyone " including God Himself! A dog can only take so much of a beating. After a certain amount of time, the dog will no longer trust anyone, including his own master. As a result of the curse of Adam and Eve that is still in full operation on this earth, there is always going to be a certain amount of wrongs that we will all have to put up with " no exceptions! Nobody comes out of this life unscathed with all the people who have chosen with their own free wills to live this life on the dark side. However, for Christians, no matter how badly you have been beaten up in your past, the one thing that you cannot have affected is your ability to trust in your Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and our heavenly Father. It is one thing to have faith in God, to know that God exists, and that He is all-powerful and that there is nothing that He cannot do or accomplish " but it is quite another thing to be able to fully trust God with your life, and to fully trust Him to properly handle it for you, especially if everyone in your past has let you down in one way or another. Oh, fear the Lord, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him – But those who seek the Lord shall not lack any good thing. For he shall be like a shrub in the desert, and shall not see when good comes, but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, in a salt land which is not inhabited. Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, and whose hope is the Lord. For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes; but her leaf will be green, and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit. Let them do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life. He says that our faith and hope should be in Him, not in the wealth and riches of this world! 3: Learn How To Trust in the Lord In ALL Situations

In the storms of life I find people desperately wanting to trust this God that offers hope, but simply not knowing how to when the waves are coming fast and threatening to pull them under. God even gives us the formula in His Word.

For some reason, God has chosen to use us, His people, to be the agents through whom He will reach out and touch the world. But in the delivery of this blessing God is wanting us to have a role. In fact, we are the Body of Christ 1 Corinthians After all, that is what a body is for - to reveal and express a person. These things ought not to be, and God desires to do a healing, as each part learns to submit to the Head, Jesus Christ. After all, how far would you get if your legs did not do what your brain told them to do? The world is crying out for something more. People seek satisfaction for their souls through many things, but ultimately its only God the Creator who can give it. People need the Lord. But people need to see that the Lord is real. Jesus said, "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe" John 4: We ought to be able to see from this just how important the manifestation of signs and wonders before unbelievers is. But God will do these signs through people of faith. Paul said his message and preaching were not with the persuasive words of human wisdom, but with the demonstration of the Spirit and power, that our faith may not rest in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God 1 Corinthians 2: The modern evangelical church has adopted the opposite strategy for the most part in the last several hundred years, encouraging people to rest their faith in the wisdom of learned scholars, who may or may not believe in the integrity of the Scripture, and in any case, rarely if ever manifest the power of God promised by the Scriptures. This strategy has led in many cases to a very intellectual and cerebral approach to faith, often quite irrelevant to the felt needs of the world. I do believe that the facts are on our side as Christians, but our major strategy is to simply demonstrate the power and authority of the Lord as Peter, Paul and the early apostles did, rather than to attempt to provide a philosophical proof to satisfy skeptics whose root problem is spiritual and not intellectual, in any case. Jesus expected it when he said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to my Father. In the last hundred years especially, the church has begun to realise this and some have even dared to proclaim it openly. We could be disappointed if we survey what Christendom has revealed by and large until the present time. But it is a new day in God, and even a new century of opportunity stands before us. What we will witness in the 21st century is far beyond all that has been known until now, especially in the magnitude of its extent. Truly, "the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea". This will happen, I believe, in our generation, in an unprecedented way. I myself have had occasion to put these into practice and I can assure you that they do work. Pursue intimacy with God. The apostle John was a man who loved to be close to Jesus and experience the anointing of God. John was involved at the Gate Beautiful when he and Peter ministered to the crippled man, and that man began to "walk and leap and praise God" see Acts 3. If we are going to move in the supernatural of God, we must pursue intimacy with God. This means being close to God, letting God touch our hearts, and learning to touch the heart of God. It means listening to the promptings of the Spirit of God and obeying them. The Bible is full of exhortations to us towards this intimacy of hearing and knowing the voice of God, hearkening unto Him, praying without ceasing, abiding in Jesus and being full of the Holy Spirit, with the Word of God and the praises of God continually upon our lips. This intimacy is the true meaning of the phrase "knowing" God. It is direct contact with God we must pursue - its not enough to read a report of what He has done or know about Him. God wants us to know Him in this way. How do you become intimate with God? One of the major keys to intimacy is self-disclosure. In an intimate marriage, a man and a women disclose everything about themselves to the partner. Likewise, in intimacy with God, we must expose everything about us to God. It means telling the Lord our hopes, dreams, fears - and our sins. God will wash away our sins if we confess them to Him in the light of His presence. The more we open our heart to God in prayer, the more He will begin to open His heart to us. God has secrets to share with us, but we will only hear them if we walk with God, respect Him, and seek to please Him on a day by day basis. Holding onto wrong things after God has spoken will limit our intimacy with God. Rebellion against God is a reflection of pride.

But "the Lord knows the proud from afar" and that is where he keeps them. The opposite of pride is humility. Humility recognises who we are and who God is. A humble person will therefore yield to God, obey God. A humble person, in recognising who God is, will praise God, and will adore God. Worship is the vital key to truly knowing the voice of the Lord. When we are occupied with fulfilling our own desires, we usually miss the intimacy with God that could have been possible. It helps us only to know about Him. All this is foundational to learning to move in the supernatural. If we ever move away from this base of doing things out of relationship to the Lord, we have strayed from the path of life and must turn back to our first love. No amount of works done or even miracles performed in His name will satisfy the heart of God concerning us, when our hearts are not truly given over to Him. Its similar to the scenario of a wife dutifully performing household duties for her husband and family while secretly wishing she was out of the marriage, because she really loves someone or something else. God help us to keep a vision and a revelation of the love of God for us. Why is this key important for moving in the supernatural? To move in the supernatural of God most effectively, we should seek to be as Jesus, who "only did what He saw the Father doing" John 5: Intimacy with God empowers us to see what the Father is doing and do likewise. Praying publicly for people whose hearts are not prepared to receive from God will often do more harm than good, because it may confirm them in their unbelief. By knowing God and being sensitive to the leading of His Holy Spirit, we can perceive on whom the Spirit of God is moving and then minister to them. This is but the first of several keys to moving in the supernatural power of God, but it is foundational to all of them. God willing, I will write soon on the others, which include:

Read biblical answers to questions about God, like "who is God?", "what is God really like?", "why can't we see God?" and many more. Use our Bible verses by topic.

God is in a category all by himself. His being and moral character transcends everything else that exists. The glory of God that we perceive is the shining out of his infinite holy excellence and worth. We were created to find satisfaction in this glory alone. God reveals his glory and makes it known so that it can be praised and rejoiced in. Everything that he does is for this purpose. God predestines to redeem to the praise of his glory. Christ returns to consummate the revelation of divine glory. God has designed us to be worshipers, and worshiping anything other than himself is idolatry. Praising God is what a believer desires to do, and God draws us into it. He is not selfish to demand praise: We are not to be half-hearted or divided, but to pursue him and exalt in him with passion and intensity. We are to worship him with all of our being, rejoicing sincerely in his truth. John tells us that the word became flesh and revealed his glory. The resurrected Lord told Thomas that many would believe who never saw him physically. Glory, therefore, is revealed through reading. Paul tells the Ephesians that when they read his letter, they could perceive his insight into the mystery of Christ. Paul tells them that Gentiles and Jews are reconciled to God in one body, and each has the glorious inheritance of the riches of Christ. As Paul states, the riches of the glory of God in Christ are revealed through reading. Paul loved books and he loved reading Scripture. He compares the glory of the old covenant with the glory of the new. The glory of the Old Testament is incredible, but the glory of the gospel is even greater! Paul makes the point in this passage that the glory is seen or veiled in reading. When someone turns to the Lord Jesus, they see the glory unveiled. Before, the veil covered.
