About that time war injured began arriving from all the- aters of operation. On 1 Janu- ary , the census showed 3, patients and on the same date in , St. Albans reached a peak figure of 5, patients. The hospital ran smoothly though greatly overcrowded. Corridors were jammed with beds and administrative offices often found themselves relocat- ed in the basement. The num- ber of medical officers rose to , nurses to and corps- men to an all time high of 1, At the date of opening in there were 42 wards, but with the continual addition of temporary buildings it grew to 76 wing units around a main corridor, of which the present ramp is a part, slightly longer than one mile.
