Quezon was a Freemason most of his adult life, being grand master of the Grand Lodge of the Philippines, Due to the influence of his wife he resigned from Freemasonry, Sept. After his death, the Catholic church claimed he had renounced Freemasonry. Seven years after he left Masonry, he made this statement: There is a formal form which those returning to the church from the Masonic lodge are supposed to sign. Instead, I wrote the Archbishop a personal note saying that I understood that I could not be readmitted to the Catholic Church so long as I remained a Mason, and for that reason I was resigning from Masonry. A Freemason, but his lodge is not known. He was a nephew of Stephen A. Member of Montezuma Lodge No. Vidkun Quisling Norwegian Anti-Mason whose name has become a synonym for traitor. During WWI he was in the diplomatic and intelligence service, mainly in Russia. From he was the Norwegian minister of defense, resigning to found his own political party, the National Union, with a platform calling for the suppression of Communism and the freeing of Norwegian labor from unionism. He was chief collaborator in the German conquest of Norway in The Nazis proclaimed him sole political head of Norway as head of the state council of 13 Nazi-dominated commissioners. In this capacity he took over the beautiful Masonic Temple in Oslo and converted it into an officers quarters, ruining it for Masonic use. He ordered all the library and belongings shipped to Germany but thanks to Norwegian patriots, they failed to arrive. He was tried by the Norwegian courts following the war. Ironically, the trial was held in a former Masonic lodge room, in order to seat more spectators. He was convicted and shot in Congressman from Mississippi, , and "Father of Mississippi Masonry. He was early in-dined towards the ministry, but taught school and studied law in Philadelphia, then moved to Ohio, where he was admitted to the bar in In he went to Memphis, Tenn. He

served as president of the state senate. In he raised a body of men to aid the Texans against the incursions of Santa Anna, q. He was appointed governor of the City of Mexico. In and again in he was suggested as Democratic nominee for vice president, but was not nominated. He was an avowed advocate of states rights, and as leader of the extreme Southern party, supported the right of secession for states. He was raised in Hiram Lodge No. He was grand master of the Grand Lodge of Mississippi from and , declining further terms. He was also an honorary member of the grand lodges of South Carolina and New York. July 17, at his Natchez home "Monmouth," which is now famous as one of the outstanding anti-bellum homes of Natchez. It is thought he died of poisoning at a banquet in Washington, D. R Fritz Rackhorst German physician and Masonic editor. He practiced medicine in Lennep, Germany from , but his heart was more often in Masonry. He served as master of the lodge Theodor zum Belgischen Loewen at Duesseldorf for almost 20 years. He resigned from his mother lodge and affiliated with the Lodge Plato at Wiesbaden, and finally with the Lodge Labor at Vienna. His opinion was that Masonry was a world brotherhood. The set of all spheres satisfying this equation is called a pencil of spheres determined by the original two spheres. In this definition a sphere is allowed to be a plane infinite radius, center at infinity and if both the original spheres are planes then all the spheres of the pencil are planes, otherwise there is only one plane the radical plane in the pencil. The centers of all the ordinary spheres in the pencil lie on a line passing through the center of C and perpendicular to the radical plane. If the spheres intersect in an imaginary circle, all the spheres of the pencil also pass through this imaginary circle but as ordinary spheres they are disjoint have no real points in common. The line of centers is perpendicular to the radical plane, which is a real plane in the pencil containing the imaginary circle. If the spheres intersect in a point A, all the spheres in the pencil are tangent at A and the radical plane is the common tangent plane of all these spheres. The line of centers is perpendicular to the radical plane at A. All the tangent lines from a fixed point of the radical plane to the spheres of a pencil have the same length. Moreover, a sphere orthogonal to any two spheres of a pencil of spheres is orthogonal to all of them and its center lies in the radical plane of the pencil. A great circle is a circle on the sphere that has the same center and radius as the sphere and, consequently, divides it into two equal parts. The plane sections of a sphere are called spheric sections. They are all circles and those that are not great circles are called small circles. Equipped with this " great-circle distance ", a great circle becomes the Riemannian circle. If a particular point on a sphere is arbitrarily designated as its north pole, then the corresponding antipodal point is called the south pole, and the equator is the great circle that is equidistant to them. Great circles through the two poles are called lines or meridians of longitude , and the line connecting the two poles is called the axis of rotation. Circles on the sphere that are parallel to the equator are lines of latitude. This terminology is also used for such approximately spheroidal astronomical bodies as the planet Earth see geoid. Hemisphere[ edit ] Any plane that includes the center of a sphere divides it into two equal hemispheres. Any two intersecting planes that include the center of a sphere subdivide the sphere into four lunes or biangles, the vertices of which all coincide with the antipodal points lying on the line of intersection of the planes. The antipodal quotient of the sphere is the surface called the real projective plane , which can also be thought of as the northern hemisphere with antipodal points of the equator identified. The hemisphere is conjectured to be the optimal least area isometric filling of the Riemannian circle.
