

1: A Mormon's pre-existence

Why does the Bible say that there is a new heaven and a new earth? Clearly, our image of a harp-strumming, cherub-populated, marshmallow-clouded heaven is in need of some tweaking. The Bible teaches that our hope is not in heaven, per se, but in resurrection. Our hope is not that we will escape the earth and fly off like spacemen; it is that God will renew the earth and put it back the way it should be. The Bible teaches that God will purge evil from among us, and there will be a new heaven and a new earth Isa. Additionally, it teaches that our souls will be reunited with our bodies, and we will all be bodily resurrected Isa. The eternal state involves both a physical earth and physical bodies. This means that the eternal state will look far more like Eden than the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel. A Better Definition Based on the biblical account, heaven appears to be both a place and a state. Heaven is a waiting room for the new heavens and new earth, just as hell is a waiting room for the lake of fire. In Eden, the realms of heaven and earth were together. God walked with man. When sin entered the world, these realms were separated. In the book of Revelation, these realms come back together. What we are interested in is life after life after death. Our hope is in the resurrected Christ, for His resurrection means that we will be resurrected, as well 1 Cor. Resurrected bodies dwell with God personally in a new heavens and new earthâ€”the way it was meant to be. And that beats playing the harp any day.

The place where believers will live for eternity is not some strange spiritual world where we will have wings, float on clouds, and sing songs all day long forever and ever. In the past three parts of this series, I have discussed our resurrection bodies, the environment of the New Earth and Outer Space! In this final article, I want to write about what our daily lives will be like. I wrote about how we will have work to do in part 3. The reason why I bring this subject up is that some people will ask how we can have free will when we cannot sin. First off, Scripture is clear that while we are under the Curse we are slaves to sin. It is very difficult, especially for Americans, to understand how someone can be free and yet never sin. Yet the Bible tells us plainly that Christians in heaven will be righteous 1 Corinthians 5: The Holy Spirit will make us perfect to the point where we will never want to sin, and He will give us the power to never choose to do wrong. There will be no temptation on the New Earth. This idea basically says that life cannot be fun without drugs, sex outside marriage, alcohol, or a host of other things. This kind of thinking shows just how perverted and sinful civilization has become â€” God is boring, Satan is fun. Yet, God is the one who created fun. He is the one who made the universe, animals, meadows, oceans, and everything else. He created all the things that we have fun with. Neither Satan nor humanity created fun. Sin is not required to have fun. Writer Randy Alcorn sums it up well: His most basic strategy, the same one he employed with Adam and Eve, is to make us believe that sin brings fulfillment. However, in reality, sin robs us of fulfillment. In fact â€” as everyone else can see â€” drugs make them miserable. Throughout this series, I have noted that a good way to think about Heaven is through the principle of continuity. Jesus says in Matthew Many cannot think of life without marriage and everything that it entails. However, Christians should not despair about this. We must remember that marriage was created by God before the Curse. God is not going to remove something for no reason at all. When thinking about Heaven most Christians do not typically think about whether or not we will eat and drink on the New Earth. Most assume that there would be no point. If we are going to have perfect bodies, then why would we need to eat? Besides there are a couple of passages that seem to say that eating will not be a part of the Kingdom of God. The context of the passage is concerning how Christians should not make other people stumble over what we eat and drink in this life. It is in the general context of sexual immorality. It does not seem likely that it is referring to the New Earth especially in regards to the following points that I am about to make. However, there is some evidence that there will be food and drink in the Restored World. Jesus ate food after his resurrection Luke It is possible that Revelation 19 and Matthew 8 are speaking figuratively. I believe He ate with them for two reasons: When He was last with them, they fellowshiped around the table and shared the Passover meal. Most people think we will not because of two reasons: Yet, there is nothing evil about food. God created food before the Curse. Eating and drinking is one of the many pleasures that God created for us to enjoy. Yes, in Heaven we will not be overweight or underweight â€” we will be healthy. Yes, God has the power to give us unlimited energy. Even so, that does not mean that food will be taken away. Adam and Eve lived in a perfect world with perfect bodies, yet God specifically told them to eat Genesis 3: However, this raises an issue. It is clear that humans and animals were vegetarians before the Fall Genesis 1: Meat eating was not given by God until after the Great Flood Genesis 9: This is a good reason to believe that humanity and animals will once again be vegetarian. The issue that I

alluded to above has to do with the fact that Jesus ate fish after his resurrection. Randy Alcorn explains the problem, and solutions, well: However, that was on an unresurrected Earth, still under the Curse. Hunting and killing animals is legitimate and sometimes necessary on the present Earth. And considering that the Curse will be removed, it is safe to assume we will no longer be killing and eating the flesh of animals, who will also be free from the curse. Where will we live? Will we live in homes? However, it is an improper translation. Although it is possible that the context of John What these homes will be like, the Bible does not say. However, it is pretty safe to assume that our homes in Heaven will surpass anything the greatest kings have lived in during this life. Will some homes in Heaven be like this? What about music, art, entertainment, sports, etc.? In part 3 , I noted that we will continue to have our individual gifts, skills, and abilities. This would naturally include music and artistic ability for crying out loud there is an entire book of music in the Bible called Psalms! What about sports and entertainment? Will we be able to play baseball or run track? Will there be movies and other forms of entertainment. There is nothing inherently evil about any of these things. Is there any reason to believe that God hates play? Sadly, in this world we have twisted athletics and entertainment think about violent video games and the arrogance some people have when they are very good at a particular sport. Yet, remember, that God will redeem not only humanity and the world, but human culture as well see part 3. Sports and entertainment will remain a part of our lives, but with the sinful attitudes humanity has with them removed. Will we sleep and rest? This topic is similar to eating and drinking. If our bodies are perfect, then why would we need rest and sleep? There is a simple way to look at this issue – God rested on Day 7 of creation. Was God sinning when he did this? Sleep and rest, like food, are a pleasure in life and something to enjoy. Heaven will be a place of work and relaxation. Will we wear clothes in heaven? Since God created Adam and Eve naked, it can be assumed by Christians that we will be naked once again in Heaven. However, Adam and Eve were innocent, not righteous as we will be 1 Corinthians 5: Also, remember that Adam and Eve did not even know of their nakedness before they sinned Genesis 3: We will retain our memories in Heaven so we will know if we are naked or not. However, as I have noted more than once, there will be a continuation of human culture in Heaven, and Jesus presumably wore clothing after his resurrection or was he running around in his birthday suit? 5: Preexistence: Did We Live in Heaven before We Were Born? | Mormons in Transition

6: Why We Won't Live in Heaven Forever | The Village Church

Before we were born, we lived with God in heaven as spirits. All of our spirit brothers and sisters were there, too—everyone who has lived or will live on earth including Jesus Christ. In this "pre-earth life," each of us was an individual with a divine nature and destiny.

All men and women are literally the sons and daughters of God. Do We Have a Heavenly Mother? What makes the lack of any reference to a heavenly mother in Scripture so puzzling is that this would seem to be a very important thing to know. Imagine you were separated from your parents at birth and then when you were an adult you met some people who knew them. Would it not be odd if they talked repeatedly about your father but never even mentioned your mother? The reason for this puzzling state of affairs is that LDS belief in a heavenly mother comes not from divine revelation but from later LDS leaders reasoning that she must exist. No, the thought makes reason stare! In answer to your question about a mother in heaven, let us use reason. The fact that there is no reference to a mother in heaven either in the Bible, Book of Mormon or Doctrine and Covenants, is not sufficient proof that no such thing as a mother did exist there. If we had a Father, which we did, for all of these records speak of him, then does not good common sense tell us that we must have had a mother there also? This answer does not explain why the scriptures never even once mention a mother in heaven. The appeal to reason shows that the idea of a heavenly mother is simply assumed to be true on the assumption that God is our father in the literal sense that he procreated us as his literal offspring. Does the Bible teach this idea? The Bible never explicitly says that human beings lived as spirits in heaven before their physical lives on earth. What the Bible does say supports the traditional Christian view that our existence begins here on earth. Consider the description of how God made the first man, Adam: That is, if God is a physical being and produces literal offspring, one would expect that offspring to be physical beings. Do earthly parents have to construct bodies for their offspring? No, because earthly parents with physical bodies produce offspring that also have physical bodies. According to the Bible, only one human being existed in heaven before his physical life on earth: When he said this, he was clearly saying something about himself that was not true about everyone else. What about These Verses? There are a few verses in the Bible sometimes thought to imply that human beings existed as spirits in heaven. We will look briefly at three of these verses. That is because this verse does not say that Jeremiah knew God or had done anything before his earthly conception and birth. Other verses sometimes cited to prove our preexistence fall into this same category: Finally, Paul told the Athenian philosophers: For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring. It would be a mistake to take these words literally. The doctrine that we preexisted as spirits in heaven and that God sent us here to further our spiritual development is not taught in the Bible. What this means is that God created human beings to act as his visible representatives on earth, ruling over the other living things on his behalf Genesis 1: God has given us a tremendously responsible and privileged position in his creation. He has endowed human beings with a combination of physical, emotional, and mental faculties that make them uniquely suited to be earthly reflections of his wisdom and goodness. He has given human beings a capacity for an eternal perspective that transcends the merely biological aspects of our existence. And although we are not and never will be gods. Is. For Further Reflection If a heavenly mother exists, why do the Scriptures never mention her? Does the Bible teach that we are the literal offspring of heavenly parents? How could spirits in heaven prepare themselves for their service on earth if during their earthly lives they remember nothing about their life in heaven? Are the gifts and talents that we have from God any less valuable if he gave them to us in this mortal life rather than in a heavenly preexistence? The Bible never explicitly says that human beings lived as spirits in heaven before their physical lives on earth. What the Bible does say supports the traditional Christian view that our existence begins here on earth.

According to the Bible do we exist as spirits before we are born? Some believe that humans exist as spirits before they are born. They use Jer 1: Is what they propose biblical or not? We will start with the proposed text: Let us examine this text closely. There are only two possibilities: We existed in another dimension before we are born Or b. Notice that this verse uses the following words: In other words before I created you, before you came into being. The text itself leans towards interpretation b: Foreknowledge does not mean pre-existence of the beings foreknown. Nowhere in the Bible is there a mention of spirits existing before they are or were born. God foreknew the events of this planet and revealed future events to His prophets: Genesis, being the book of the Bible concentrating on creation, reveals to us how man was created: All life was created by God Himself! The prophet Isaiah prophesied years before the event the following prophesy concerning Cyrus: How else would God call him by name? However the text is quite implicit: I will strengthen you, though you have not acknowledged me. Otherwise he would have no choice but to acknowledge God, as he would be in His presence. God foreknew what Cyrus would do in his short existence. He also foreknew that Cyrus would be an unbeliever. Although he never acknowledged God, God was able to use him to carry out His plans. As God can read into the future as if it was a history book, He sees what is going to happen. His foreknowledge is the basis of all prophecies. He is far beyond our limitations. This is confirmed by the promise mentioned in Rom 4: With a God like this, you know that all your problems can be resolved. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light. Are you tired of struggling with problems beyond your understanding? Come to Jesus and accept Him as your Saviour. Do so now by accepting His call at <http://> This is NOT a true Christian view. The Bible teaches us that a person comes into existence at the very moment of physical conception, not a moment before Ps. Several passages speak of God knowing people before they were born Isa. Instead they indicate that God knows His plans that He has for a person even before that person exists, in comparison to how an architect would know the building he has designed before the foundation has ever been set. Only Jesus Christ spiritually existed before His physical incarnation John 1: That has a smattering of reincarnation. God knew we would be, Acts Some have taken Jeremiah 1: This however is a misinterpretation of the text. God is omniscient, i. Knowing and being are not necessarily the same things. We were a reality to Him, because He knew that we would exist in His plan. The idea of preexistence of mankind flies counter to what the Scriptures, especially Genesis, states about the creation of man. This could not be further from the truth. All created things, by nature, have a beginning and such is the case for mankind. Christ, however, being the Second Person in the Trinity was not created and by very definition must be eternal. We are not divine and therefore cannot claim that which Christ can. We are flesh, and have the spirit in us when we become Christians. Meanwhile we groan, longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, because when we are clothed, we will not be found naked. For while we are in this tent, we groan and are burdened, because we do not wish to be unclothed but to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life. We know that, when He appears, we shall be like Him, because we shall see Him just as He is. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ, who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body. In fact, a neighbor recently offered my wife to become his queen when he becomes a god in his own kingdom. The only thing she had to do was to be baptized in the Mormon church. She declined the offer. For they all had her. For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven. This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. To him who overcomes, to him I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, and a new name written on the stone which no one knows but he who receives it. The sound I heard was like that of harpists playing their harps. Each one had a harp and they were holding golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. They held harps given them by God and sang the song of Moses the servant of God and the song of the Lamb: Just and true are your ways, King of the ages. Who will not fear you, O Lord, and bring glory to your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship before you, for your righteous acts have been revealed. And if you are to judge the world, are you not competent to judge trivial cases? Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more the things of this life! However, Satan had fallen by the time humans were created. Tell Me, if you have understanding When the morning stars sang together, And all the sons of God shouted for joy? The ruby, the topaz, and the diamond; The beryl, the onyx, and the jasper; The lapis lazuli, the turquoise, and the emerald; And the gold, the workmanship of your settings and sockets, Was in you. On the day that you were created They were prepared. You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked in the midst of the stones of fire. And I have destroyed you, O covering cherub, From the midst of the stones of fire. I cast you to the ground; I put you before kings, That they may see you. Therefore I have brought fire from the midst of you; It has consumed you, And I have turned you to ashes on the earth In the

eyes of all who see you. His tail swept a third of the stars out of the sky and flung them to the earth And there was war in heaven. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon, and the dragon and his angels fought back. But he was not strong enough, and they lost their place in heaven. The great dragon was hurled down--that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who leads the whole world astray. He was hurled to the earth, and his angels with him. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies. Then come together again so that Satan will not tempt you because of your lack of self-control. And what I have forgiven--if there was anything to forgive--I have forgiven in the sight of Christ for your sake, in order that Satan might not outwit us. For we are not unaware of his schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings. I say this because you claim that I drive out demons by Beelzebub. Now if I drive out demons by Beelzebub, by whom do your followers drive them out? So then, they will be your judges. But if I drive out demons by the finger of God, then the kingdom of God has come to you. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever. Therefore, they are before the throne of God and serve him day and night in his temple; and he who sits on the throne will spread his tent over them. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven. You have come to God, the judge of all men, to the spirits of righteous men made perfect, to Jesus the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire. For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us. Do not be deceived: Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor male prostitutes nor homosexual offenders nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death. This is the second death, the lake of fire. As for you, let that abide in you which you heard from the beginning. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, you also will abide in the Son and in the Father. This is the promise which He Himself made to us: This is the true God and eternal life. Lewis may have been the most important Christian thinker of the twentieth century.
