2: Fifth Grade / Welcome to 5th Grade!

If your child receives a classroom detention, you will be notified prior to the day of detention. Transportation will not be provided, so you will need to pick your child up promptly at 4: If you are more than 15 minutes late picking your child up for a detention, they will no longer have this level of infraction. Their fourth infraction will automatically be a referral to an administrator. More serious infractions will result in an office referral, in which, your child will be serving the detention with the assistant principal in the front office. Grades Progress report grades will be issued once in the middle of the grading period and need to be signed by the parent and returned to the homeroom teacher the next day. If the student works hard, there is plenty of time to raise the grade before the final report card grade is issued. If you have a question about a particular grade, please see that teacher. Students have 5 school days before a teacher can mark these missing assignments as zeros. Homework In the fifth grade, you can expect your child to have about 45 minutes of homework each night Monday through Thursday. The majority of the homework will be math assignments, writing, and 20 minutes of reading. It is an essential part of our curriculum. We try to teach them good homework habits and eliminate the bad ones they may have acquired so that each student will have academic success in the elementary and middle schools. This is a skill that will be used for the rest of their academic career, as well as, any career they pursue later in life. Agendas Agendas are mandatory for 5th graders and the PTO is providing each student one free agenda. Students are required to write down all of their daily assignments, test dates and project due dates in their agendas. Parents, please check agendas every evening to make sure students are keeping up with their responsibilities. The agenda is also a way for parents and teachers to communicate. Sometimes a quick note is all that is needed to solve a potential problem. This is also where you will find important updates from the fifth grade teachers. Dress Code Astatula Elementary does have a school wide dress code policy and a school wide procedure in place for students who do not adhere to the policy. Tennis shoes and shorts are highly recommended to be worn on PE days. All other shoes must have a closed heel or strap across the heel. The dress code can be found on the Astatula Elementary website, and will be enforced. Field Trips During the course of the year, we take about 2 out-of-school field trips. Information regarding the field trips will be sent home at a later date. Parents please be advised; student eligibility for field trips could be revoked after two or more office referrals bus referrals may be considered for the first two 9 week periods and then for the last two 9 week periods.
