Rachel Jones, one of the pioneer settlers of this county who came to Hillsboro when its site was a wilderness and lived here the greater part of her life, until after the death of her husband and the marriage of her children. Rachel Jones was born Nov. From here she moved to Buckskin on the farm now known as the "Robins farm" In the 24th year of her age, she was married to Col. At the time of her moving to Ohio Chillicothe consisted of only few hog huts, surrounded by a vast wilderness inhabited by wolves and Indians in great abundance. Venison and wild turkey were plenty and constituted a good share of the food of the people at that time. Jones, her husband, died in , so that Sister Jones has been left a widow for about 40 years. She joined the M. Church in , when she was 46 years old. She continued to reside in Hillsboro after the death of her husband until her children were married, after which time she lived among her children, being the guest of her daughter, Mrs. Waddell, for the last 14 years. She was the mother of 7 daughters, four of whom have passed to the other world and has 43 grandchildren now living. Mother Jones, when young, was blessed with a very strong constitution and with a more than ordinary share of sound sense and cheerful spirits, both of which she retained till the last day of her earthly existence. Although not able to attend the services of the sanctuary for several years, yet she maintained the spirit of religious devotion in the retirement of home and would speak hopefully of her future prospects. The death of her little granddaughter, Lucy Waddell, however, cast a veil of despondency over her mind, scarcely ever seen before in her long life. Her heart was bound up in the child and in her departure, departed also much of the pleasure of this life from Mother Jones. She often spoke of her and wept for her absence and longed to be with her. On the 8th of May she said to me, "the other end of the road is the best. On the 12th she asked me, "Do you think I committed any sin in grieving for our little one? On the 15th, when asked if she was steadily trusing in Jesus, she answered, "I am doing the best I can. They were enough in view of her pious life, her Christian character and the numerous testimonies born for her Lord and Master.
