WordPress settings – WordPress settings control the global settings for your WordPress website and is broken into six components: Here is where you set your site name and tag line, assign an admin email account for your blog, and set the language and timezone for your blog amongst other things. The writing settings allows you to set a default post category and post format for your blog posts. You can also enable the ability to post to your blog via email. From here you are able to set the homepage for your blog, adjust how many posts are displayed on index pages, and most importantly toggle on and of the visibility of your blog to search engines.
