Head-up display A head-up display HUD is a transparent display that presents data without requiring users to look away from their usual viewpoints. Near-eye augmented reality devices can be used as portable head-up displays as they can show data, information, and images while the user views the real world. Many definitions of augmented reality only define it as overlaying the information. Due to encumbered control, smartglasses are primarily designed for micro-interaction like reading a text message but still far from more well-rounded applications of augmented reality. These bionic contact lenses might contain the elements for display embedded into the lens including integrated circuitry, LEDs and an antenna for wireless communication. The first contact lens display was reported in , [46] then 11 years later in The company Samsung has been working on a contact lens as well. This lens, when finished, is meant to have a built-in camera on the lens itself. It is also intended to be linked with your smartphone to review footage, and control it separately. When successful, the lens would feature a camera, or sensor inside of it. It is said that it could be anything from a light sensor, to a temperature sensor. In Augmented Reality, the distinction is made between two distinct modes of tracking, known as marker and markerless. Marker are visual cues which trigger the display of the virtual information. The camera recognizes the geometries by identifying specific points in the drawing. Markerless also called instant tracking does not use marker. Instead the user positions the object in the camera view preferably in an horizontal plane. It uses sensors in mobile devices to accurately detect the real-world environment, such as the locations of walls and points of intersection. This results in bright images with high resolution and high contrast. The viewer sees what appears to be a conventional display floating in space. In the macular degeneration group, 5 out of 8 subjects preferred the VRD images to the CRT or paper images and thought they were better and brighter and were able to see equal or better resolution levels. All handheld AR solutions to date opt for video see-through. Initially handheld AR employed fiducial markers , [63] and later GPS units and MEMS sensors such as digital compasses and six degrees of freedom accelerometer " gyroscope. Handheld display AR promises to be the first commercial success for AR technologies. The two main advantages of handheld AR are the portable nature of handheld devices and the ubiquitous nature of camera phones. The disadvantages are the physical constraints of the user having to hold the handheld device out in front of them at all times, as well as the distorting effect of classically wide-angled mobile phone cameras when compared to the real world as viewed through the eye. SAR makes use of digital projectors to display graphical information onto physical objects. The key difference in SAR is that the display is separated from the users of the system. Because the displays are not associated with each user, SAR scales naturally up to groups of users, thus allowing for collocated collaboration between users. Examples include shader lamps , mobile projectors, virtual tables, and smart projectors. Other applications include table and wall projections. One innovation, the Extended Virtual Table, separates the virtual from the real by including beam-splitter mirrors attached to the ceiling at an adjustable angle. Many more

implementations and configurations make spatial augmented reality display an increasingly attractive interactive alternative. An SAR system can display on any number of surfaces of an indoor setting at once. SAR supports both a graphical visualization and passive haptic sensation for the end users. Users are able to touch physical objects in a process that provides passive haptic sensation. These technologies offer varying levels of accuracy and precision. However, they often rely on computationally intensive computer vision algorithms with extreme latency requirements. To compensate for the lack of computing power, offloading data processing to a distant machine is often desired. Computation offloading introduces new constraints in applications, especially in terms of latency and bandwidth. Although there are a plethora of real-time multimedia transport protocols, there is a need for support from network infrastructure as well. Computer[edit] The computer analyzes the sensed visual and other data to synthesize and position augmentations. Computers are responsible for the graphics that go with augmented reality. Augmented reality uses a computer-generated image and it has an striking effect on the way the real world is shown. With the improvement of technology and computers, augmented reality is going to have a drastic change on our perspective of the real world. The more that computers progress, augmented reality will become more flexible and more common in our society. Computers are the core of augmented reality. This translates to an input to the computer which then outputs to the users by adding something that would otherwise not be there. The computer comprises memory and a processor. The fixed marks on an objects surface are stored in the memory of a computer. The computer also withdrawals from its memory to present images realistically to the onlooker. The software must derive real world coordinates, independent from the camera, from camera images. That process is called image registration , and uses different methods of computer vision , mostly related to video tracking. Usually those methods consist of two parts. The first stage is to detect interest points , fiducial markers or optical flow in the camera images. This step can use feature detection methods like corner detection , blob detection , edge detection or thresholding , and other image processing methods. Some methods assume objects with known geometry or fiducial markers are present in the scene. In some of those cases the scene 3D structure should be precalculated beforehand. If part of the scene is unknown simultaneous localization and mapping SLAM can map relative positions. If no information about scene geometry is available, structure from motion methods like bundle adjustment are used. Mathematical methods used in the second stage include projective epipolar geometry, geometric algebra , rotation representation with exponential map , kalman and particle filters, nonlinear optimization , robust statistics. To enable rapid development of augmented reality applications, some software development kits SDKs have emerged. Since AR system rely heavily on the immersion of the user and the interaction between the user and the system, design can facilitate the adoption of virtuality. For most Augmented Reality systems, a similar design guideline can be followed. The following lists some considerations for designing Augmented Reality applications: Designers should be aware of the possible physical scenarios the end-user may be in such as: Public, in which the users uses their whole body to interact with the software Personal, in which the user uses a smartphone in a public space Intimate, in which the user is sitting with a desktop and is not really in movement Private, in which the user has on a wearable. UX designers will have to define user journeys for the relevant physical scenarios and define how the interface will react to each. Especially in AR systems, it is vital to also consider the spatial space and the surrounding elements that change the effectiveness of the AR technology. Environmental elements such as lighting, and sound can prevent the sensor of AR devices from detecting necessary data and ruin the immersion of the end-user. For example, applications that is used for driving should reduce the amount of user interaction and user audio cues instead. The purpose of Interaction Design is to avoid alienating or confusing the user by organising the information presented. In other applications that require users to understand the focus and intent, designers can employ a reticle or raycast from the device. This means that a user can potentially access multiple copies of 2D interfaces within a single AR application. Visual design[edit] In general, visual design is the appearance of the developing application that engages the user. To improve the graphic interface elements and user interaction, developers may use visual cues to inform user what elements of UI are designed to interact with and how to interact with them. Since navigating in AR application may appear difficult and seem frustrating, visual cues design can make interactions seem more natural. To solve this issue, designers

should apply visual cues to assist and encourage users to explore their surroundings. Birindwa ci Birhashwirwa and E. Tshisekedi wa Mulumba for consideration under the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights; Having taken into account all written information made available to it by the authors of the communications and by the State party; Adopts the following: Views under article 5. They claim to be the victims of violations by Zaire of articles 9, paragraph 1, 10, paragraph 1, 12, paragraph 1, and 17 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights. Tshisekedi is represented by counsel. The authors were among the co-authors of communication No. The Committee adopted its views on communication No. In the cast of Mr. Tshisekedi, this second period of internal exile is said to have lasted from mid-June to the end of June Birindwa was confined to his native village in the province of Kivu close to the border of Rwanda , Mr. Tshisekedi was kept under surveillance in his native village in the province of Kasai-Oriental. The relatives of both authors were also subjected to surveillance by the Zairian authorities. Tshisekedi was released from banishment on 27 June , and Mr. Birindwa on 1 July , following a presidential amnesty promulgated in the context of the Zairian elections of August In that respect, they allege that an explicit order has been given to the registrars of the courts in Kinshasa not to make available to members of the political opposition or to their legal counsel any court orders or decisions in cases affecting them. They further allege that the pursuit of domestic remedies is obstructed in Zaire by the fact that any person in possession of official documents of the Human Rights Committee is deemed to be in possession of "subversive" documents and subject to arrest. The State party was requested, in particular, to provide the Committee with information concerning all the measures taken by its authorities vis-a-vis the victims referred to in communication No. This information relates exclusively to their situation after their release in mid Senior officials of the U. Others were appointed to responsible positions at the head of certain State enterprises. With respect to Mr. Tshisekedi, the State party explains that he was able to travel extensively throughout Europe and the United States, that he returned to Zaire towards the middle of January , where he sought to organize a public demonstration in Kinshasa on 17 January , without prior authorization. The State party explains that under its laws, every demonstration must be notified to the authorities and meet certain requirements before it is approved. It adds that Mr. Tshisekedi nonetheless decided to proceed and that the police was forced to intervene. The author and other demonstrators were arrested and transferred to Makala prison in Kinshasa. The State party submits that as the author displayed "signs of mental disturbance, the judicial authorities decided that he should undergo a psychiatric examination, both in the interests of his health and to ensure a fair trial. Birindwa, the State party merely observes that he has remained abroad, and that no administrative or legal measures have been taken against him. In these circumstances, the author decided to defy the authorities. Counsel further claims that the security forces who intervened allegedly caused the death of several demonstrators, although the manifestation is said to have been peaceful. Following his arrest and transfer to Makala prison, he was kept detained until 11 March , when he was released. On 16 March , he was, however, again placed under house arrest and military surveillance at his home in Combe-Kinshasa. The Committee ascertained, as it is required to do under article 5, paragraph 2 a , of the Optional Protocol, that the matters complained of by the authors had not been submitted to another procedure of international investigation or settlement. It observed that these allegations had remained uncontested and that the State party had not provided any information about remedies that would have been available to the authors. Tshisekedi, the Committee considered that they related to issues of substance and that they should, accordingly, be examined on the merits. In a submission dated 4 May , Mr. Tshisekedi was placed under arrest and taken to the State Security Court, where he was interrogated until midnight. The arrest is said to have been linked to his call for a boycott of the partial Elections held in Kinshasa on 10 April He is said to have subsequently been

transferred back and forth between various camps located in Upper Zaire and on the border between Zaire and Sudan, where frequent fighting between guerrilla forces is said to occur. Counsel points out that Mr. Tshisekedi suffers from various ailments, that he is without medical attention at the places of his detention, and that the climatic conditions in these places adversely affect his health. By letter of 18 August, counsel supplements this information with excerpts from statements, expressing concern about Mr. On 1 September; the Secretariat was informed by the representative of the U. Wodia Mutoabo, that Mr. Tshisekedi was under detention at the military camp of Kota Koli, and that Mr. Birindwa had been released from detention on 27 July and was reported to be in his home province of Kivu. It adds that the author has returned to his family and "enjoys complete freedom of movement"; as a result, the State party suggests that the "file concerning what has been called the Tshisekedi case may be regarded as definitely closed". As to the fate of those who were arrested at the same time as Mr. Tshisekedi, the State party indicates that many have already been released, and that the rest would be freed shortly. It points out that the procedures initiated against those guilty of other offences would be conducted "with complete legality". Furthermore, the State party refers to its oral statement made in the Commission on Human Rights on 1 March, concerning the availability of domestic remedies in Zaire. Tshisekedi confirms and supplements much of the information contained in paragraphs 5. With respect to the availability of domestic remedies, he claims that the laws and the Constitution of Zaire, in their daily application, render any efforts to exhaust domestic remedies futile. If citizens complain about the practices of the security services, they are either accused of apostasy or considered to be mentally unstable. The author therefore asserts that the *Departement des Droits et Libertes du Citoyen* is no more than an instrument of the State destined to conceal the daily occurrence of human rights violations. Tshisekedi states that in the evening of that day he was due to deliver an address at the *Place du Pont Kasa-Vubu* in Kinshasa. Upon addressing the large crowd which had gathered in the square, he was seized by armed agents of the political police, while others attacked the crowd and violently suppressed the manifestation. The author was then taken into custody and brought to a secret place, where he was locked in a high security cell and deprived of food and drink for four days. It is submitted that during his detention, i. An electro-encephalogram was also carried out on him at the *Centre Neuro-Psycho-Pathologique* of Kinshasa. The author was assured by the doctors who examined him, Prof. Loseke, that all tests had produced satisfactory results. Notwithstanding, he was later informed that two days after his check-up, two agents of the political police broke into the office of Prof. Mpania, accused him of being a member of the U. They proceeded to do the same in Prof. Loseke was subjected to similar acts of intimidation and even kept in underground detention for some days, as he had attempted to oppose the police action. The commanding officer informed the author that, as he had been put under judicial supervision "surveillance judiciaire", he was not allowed to receive any visitors. As a result, the author was again transferred two thousand kms. Two months later, he was transferred to yet another place, located close to the presidential village of Gbadolite, where he was detained until 19 September. The author explains that during the latter period, he had to endure tremendous physical and psychological pressure and had to live in deplorable sanitary conditions, as the place of his banishment was situated in the Equatorial rain forest only after he had gone on a hunger strike for 13 days did President Mobutu order him to be released. From mid-June to the end of June, they were subjected to administrative measures of internal banishment, as a result of the views adopted by the Human Rights Committee on 26 March in communication No. On 27 June and 1 July, respectively, they were released following a presidential amnesty, and decided to travel abroad. Upon his return to Zaire in mid-January, Mr. Tshisekedi sought to organize a manifestation which met with the disapproval of the State authorities. On 17 January he was arrested and subjected to inhuman treatment, in that he was deprived of food and drink for several days and was placed in a high-security cell. From 16 March to the beginning of April, Mr. Tshisekedi was kept under house arrest at his home in Kinshasa -Gombo, and from 11 April to 19 September, he was intermittently subjected to renewed administrative measures of banishment, which included his intermittently in several military camps. During his internment, he had to live in unacceptable sanitary conditions. The State party has not, however, established how the authors could have effectively availed themselves of this remedy in the circumstances of their cases. The Committee reiterates that it is incumbent upon the State party to provide details of the remedies which it submits are available to the

authors, together with evidence that there would be a reasonable prospect for such remedies to be successful. In the light of the above, if the Committee concludes that there is no reason to review its admissibility decision of 4 April. It is implicit in article 4, paragraph 2, of the Optional Protocol that States parties have a duty to investigate in good faith all the allegations of violations of the Covenant made against them and their authorities, and to furnish to the Committee all the information available to them. In the communications under consideration, the information provided by the State party addresses only some aspects of the allegations made by Mr. The Committee takes the opportunity to reiterate that while partial and incomplete information provided by States parties may assist in the examination of communications, it does not satisfy the requirement of article 4, paragraph 2, of the Optional Protocol. The Committee notes that these serious allegations have not been commented on by the State party. The period from mid-June to June. In respect of the other allegations made by the authors for the period of mid-June to June, the Committee lacks sufficient information to make specific findings. The period from January to September. Tshisekedi and that of Mr. Tshisekedi, it observes that he was kept in detention for close to two months following the break-up of the demonstration of 17 January. The State party has not contested his claim that during this period, he was not brought before a magistrate, contrary to article 9, paragraph 3, of the Covenant. Tshisekedi further suffered administrative measures of internal banishment for intermittent periods between 11 April and 16 September as a result of his call for a boycott of the partial elections held in Kinshasa on 10 April. Birindwa, the Committee observes that he has not provided any information about his situation following his return to Zaire. Accordingly, the Committee is not in a position to make any findings in this respect for the period from 17 January to September. The Human Rights Committee, acting under article 5, paragraph 4, of the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, is of the view that the facts of the communications disclose violations of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights:

Section 4[edit] Bush did not assume the presidential powers and duties as Acting President. Reagan had been rushed into surgery with no opportunity to invoke Section 3; Bush did not invoke Section 4 because he was on a plane at the time of the shooting, and Reagan was out of surgery by the time Bush landed in Washington. On the death of William Henry Harrison , John Tyler became the first vice president to succeed to the presidency. It had previously been suggested that the vice president would become Acting President upon the death of the president, [28] but Vice President John Tyler asserted that he had succeeded to the presidency, instead of merely assuming its powers and duties; he also declined to acknowledge documents referring to him as acting president. Although Tyler felt his vice presidential oath obviated any need for the presidential oath, he was persuaded that being formally sworn in would resolve any doubts; after taking the oath he moved into the White House and assumed full presidential powers. Though Tyler was sometimes derided as "His Accidency", [29] both houses of Congress adopted a resolution confirming that he was president. The "Tyler precedent" of succession was thus established. Prior to , the office of vice president had become vacant sixteen times due to the death or resignation of the vice president or his succession to the presidency. In , Johnson was impeached by the House of Representatives and came one vote short of being removed from office by the Senate. Had Johnson been removed, President pro tempore Benjamin Wade would have become acting president in accordance with the Presidential Succession Act of However, this agreement did not have legal authority. Each time, until Eisenhower was able to resume his duties Nixon presided over Cabinet meetings and, along with Eisenhower aides, kept the executive branch functioning and assured the public that the situation was under control. However, Nixon never made any effort to formally assume the status of Acting President or President. Proposal, enactment, and ratification[edit] Keating&Kefauver proposal[edit] In , Senator Kenneth Keating of New York proposed a Constitutional amendment which would have enabled Congress to enact legislation providing for how to determine when a President is unable to discharge the powers and duties of the presidency, rather than, as the Twenty-fifth Amendment does, having the Constitution so provide. In case of the inability of the President to discharge the powers and duties of the said office, the said powers and duties shall devolve on the Vice President, until the inability be removed. The Congress may by law provide for the case of removal, death, resignation or inability, both of the President and Vice President, declaring what officer shall then be President, or, in case of inability, act as President, and such officer shall be or act as President accordingly, until a President shall be elected or, in case of inability, until the inability shall be earlier removed. The commencement and termination of any inability shall be determined by such method as Congress shall by law provide. Senators raised concerns that the Congress could either abuse such authority [34]: The assassination of John F. Kennedy demonstrated to policymakers of the need for a clear procedure for determining presidential disability, especially in the context of the Cold War. Johnson , had once suffered a heart attack [36] and " with the office of vice president to remain vacant until the next term began on January 20, " the next two people in the line of succession were the year-old Speaker of the House John McCormack [35] [37] and the year-old Senate President pro tempore Carl Hayden. Their proposal specified the process by which a President could be declared "unable to discharge the powers and duties of his office", thereby making the vice president an Acting President , and how the President could regain the powers of his office. Also, their proposal provided a way to fill a vacancy in the office of vice president before the next presidential election. This was as opposed to the Keating&Kefauver proposal, which neither provided for filling a vacancy in the office of vice president prior to the next presidential election nor provided a process for determining presidential disability. On April 22, it was returned to the Senate with revisions. It was years ago, in the closing days of the Constitutional Convention, that the Founding Fathers debated the question of Presidential disability. John Dickinson of Delaware asked this question: It is hard to believe that until last week our Constitution provided no clear answer. Now, at last, the

The Twenty-fifth Amendment (Amendment XXV) to the United States Constitution deals with issues related to presidential succession and disability. It clarifies that the vice president becomes president (as opposed to acting president) if the president dies, resigns, or is removed from office; and establishes procedures for filling a vacancy in the office of the vice president and for responding.

The Fifth Monarchists were one of many groups of Christian believers during and after the English Civil War whose theological beliefs challenged the more mainstream ideas of the day. Specifically, they believed in a geopolitical theory which maintained that four world rulers had already come and gone according to the prophecies of Daniel 2 in the Old Testament. This text recounts a prophetic dream by Nebuchadnezzar. The previous empires of which he dreamed were interpreted to have been Babylonian , Persian , Grecian and Roman ; the last empire, the Monarchists concluded, would be established by the returning Jesus as King of Kings and Lord of Lords to reign with his saints on earth for a thousand years. The Fifth Monarchists saw themselves as those saints of that soon to be dawning millennium. Fifth Monarchists believed that the timing of the events of the Interregnum were significant because the calendar year loomed large on the near horizon. The number had been identified in the Book of Revelation with the ultimate human despot to rule the world, who would be replaced by the Second Coming of the Messiah ; this only added to the belief that the Fifth Monarchy was about to begin.

English Commonwealth and Protectorate[edit] A number of Fifth Monarchists took a leading part in the events of the time. Cromwell had not intended it but, not long after establishing the Commonwealth, he dismissed the Parliament and became, in effect, a military dictator. However this was not completely the case as a large proportion of the assembly were conservative-minded gentry such as Sir Anthony Ashley Cooper. The Commonwealth 1653 was founded on the execution of Charles I in 1649, and was followed by the two Protectorates of Oliver Cromwell 1658 , and his son Richard Cromwell the first 1659 . The Commonwealth was briefly revived 1660 , before the restoration of the monarchy in the person of Charles II in May .

Nominated Assembly and Protectorate[edit] After the forcible dissolution of the Rump Parliament by Oliver Cromwell, the Grandees of the Army Council of Officers were reluctant to authorise free elections because they were aware that the traditional constituency would return Presbyterians and Royalists as well as their own sympathisers. They were not at all sure that the majority would be any more compliant than the Rump. Major-General Thomas Harrison, who had commanded the troop that aided Oliver Cromwell in dissolving the Rump, suggested that there be a ruling body based upon the Old Testament Sanhedrin of 70 selected "Saints", which was based on his beliefs, as a Fifth Monarchist, that the rule of the Saints would usher in the reign of Christ on Earth. A modified version of this proposal was accepted by Cromwell and the Council of Officers, and less than a month after the dissolution of the Rump, during May , letters in the name of the Lord-General and the Army Council were sent to Congregational churches in every county in England to nominate those they considered fit to take part in the new government. The total number of nominees was one hundred and forty, one hundred and twenty-nine from England, five from Scotland and six from Ireland. This assembly, which met from July until December , was the high-water mark of Fifth Monarchist influence on national politics. Fearing their ultra-radical ideas, which crystallised in an attack on tithes , the conservative faction led by Major-General John Lambert, supported by the use of troops to deny access to the radical factions, engineered a vote for the dissolution of the assembly, which was passed on 12 December . Two plots were uncovered and broken up in 1660 . The banner is a replica of that used by the insurgents at the time. He had been the seventeenth of fifty-nine commissioners judges to sign the death warrant of the king in 1649 . He was the first regicide to be hanged, drawn and quartered because he was considered by the new government to represent a continued real threat to the re-established order. This threat was realised when, on 6 January 1661 , fifty Fifth Monarchists, headed by a wine-cooper named Thomas Venner , from their alleged hideout in Norton Folgate [3] made an effort to attain possession of London in the name of "King

Jesus. Although some physical events such as the Great Plague of London and the Great Fire of London continued to encourage belief in "the end of the world" ruled by carnal human beings, the doctrine of the sect either died out or became merged in a milder form of Millenarianism.

To this end, the department shall maintain a record of arrests and commitments of its wards subsequent to their discharge from the jurisdiction of the department and shall tabulate, analyze, and publish biennially the data for use in evaluating the relative merits of treatment methods. All merit pay for department employees must be based on the system established under this section. A part-time juvenile correctional officer is subject to the training requirements of this section. Acts , 84th Leg. The rules shall provide for the award of contracts for the construction of buildings and improvements to the qualified bidder making the lowest and best bid. A construction contract may not be awarded for a sum in excess of the amount of funds available for the project. The department may reject any and all bids submitted. This section does not authorize the department to assume control of any other agency, institution, or facility in the state, or to require any agency, institution, or facility to serve the department in a manner inconsistent with the authority or function of the agency, institution, or facility or with any law or regulation governing the activity of the agency, institution, or facility. The department may not make use of any private institution or agency without its consent. The department shall make reasonable efforts to ensure that the expenditure of appropriations for the purchase of contract residential care for children, not including the purchase of care in foster family homes, be allocated to providers on a fixed monthly basis if that allocation is cost-effective and the number, type, needs, and conditions of the children to be served is reasonably constant. Every public and private institution and agency shall allow the department reasonable opportunity to examine and consult with children who have been committed to the department and who are in the custody of the institution or agency. No child placed in an institution or under an agency by the department may be released by the institution or agency without the approval of the department. If the department does not receive a proposal that meets its needs, the department may request funds from the legislature for the development of a halfway house to be operated by the department. The department may contract with another entity for the provision or use of services at the center. The security and privacy procedures may not be designed to deny an advocacy or support group access to children confined in department facilities. In the performance standards, the department shall include outcome measures for evaluating the quality of services provided under the agreement. The department may provide services to a child not committed to the department if the department contracts with a local juvenile probation department, the Health and Human Services Commission, or the Department of Family and Protective Services to provide services to the child. When funds are available, the department may: In computing the daily costs of a residential facility operated by the department, the department shall use a standard method that is: The department may enter into agreements with the federal government to accept children from the federal court for an agreed compensation. The proceeds shall be used to pay the actual expenses of maintaining and operating the canteens and vending machines. The board shall adopt rules governing the administration of the trust fund. The department shall notify each child committed to the department that the possession of contraband money is subject to

confiscation by the department under this subsection. The department shall ensure that a chaplain is employed or formally designated for each department correctional facility that is an institution. The department shall provide education in violence prevention and conflict resolution that includes discussion of domestic violence and child abuse issues to all children in its custody.
